Dear Parents

School Rules

This is an old topic but maybe it's time to address it again. I must add that we are generally blessed with children who are well brought up and a pleasure to educate.

However, we still need to ask that all parents familiarise themselves and their children with the school rules as written in the homework book. The South African Schools Act (SASA) clearly asks that parents support the school in this regard. It also states that parents are ultimately responsible for their children's behaviour.

Discipline, respect, compassion, integrity, honesty, etc. all start at home. We encourage all parents to get behind us by laying a solid disciplinary foundation at home.

Stay in your line, wait until called upon, speak when spoken to, listen, keep quiet etc. are all matters we struggle with due to the foundation not being laid at home.

One parent's comment to me was the following: "It's the school's job to discipline my child, so do your job." How wrong can one be? I was shocked by this misconception that educators need to do the parent's basic job. SASA states that it is "ultimately the parent's responsibility" and I could not find it anywhere that it's the teacher's responsibility.

Our fences are the first line of defence and our rules state that nobody is allowed closer than one meter from the fence. It's impossible to provide staff to patrol fences, and with parents constantly pushing our boundaries by entering our premises and our building we are slowly losing patience.

The basic rule that children are not allowed to talk to strangers needs to be drilled in at home. We find from time to time that parents, children and strangers tend to push this boundary, and although we have sufficient staff on duty, the basic enforcement comes from safety education at home.

Games

Games come and go, should it be "marbles", "StickeeZ", "Cards" or whatever new game is the current trend. Parents sometimes have different opinions, but these games come from home and are introduced to other children at school. We are well aware of a specific game currently being played at school by a very small percentage of our learners. The majority of our learners are not aware of this game. The fact that young learners are playing this game with ignorance puts the school at risk.

Within the ambit of our authority we asked these learners to stop playing the game and to get permission from their parents if they want to play it. We will not allow them to play it should they not have your permission. We will contact parents to confirm consent should learners be found playing this game.

Through this action we are not taking away the children's right to play games, but we are granting you as parent the opportunity to educate your child and take responsibility. We have a moral responsibility to all learners.

Ultimately we will keep you as parent responsible for any consequences in this regard.

Geagte Ouers

Skoolreëls

Dit is 'n afgesaagde ou onderwerp, maar miskien is dit tyd om nou weer daaroor te besin. Ek moet byvoeg dat ons oor die algemeen geseënd is met kinders wat goed opgevoed en 'n plesier is om te onderrig.

Tog moet ons weer vra dat alle ouers hulle asseblief vergewis van die skoolreëls soos deur ons in die huiswerkboekie aangebring. Ingevolge die Suid-Afrikaanse Skolewet word ouers duidelik versoek om die skool in hierdie verband te ondersteun en daar word pertinent genoem dat ouers uiteindelik verantwoordelikheid moet aanvaar.

Net soos in die geval van dissipline, begin respek, deernis, integriteit, eerlikheid, ens. by die huis. Ons moedig ouers met respek aan om ons by te staan en 'n stewige dissiplinêre grondslag by die huis te lê.

Bly in jou ry, wag tot jy geroep word, praat wanneer met jou gepraat word, luister, bly stil, ens. is alles dinge waarmee ons sukkel wanneer die grondslag nie by die huis gelê is nie.

'n Ouer het die volgende vir my gesê: "Dit is die skool se werk om my kind te dissiplineer, so doen jou werk" – hoe verkeerd kan 'n mens wees? Ek was verstom oor die wanopvatting dat opvoeders die ouers se basiese werk moet doen. Ingevolge die Skolewet is dit "uiteindelik die ouer se verantwoordelikheid" en nêrens het ek gesien dat dit die onderwyser se verantwoordelikheid is nie.

Ons omheining is ons eerste verdedigingslinie en ons reël is dat niemand nader as een meter van die heining mag kom nie. Dit is onmoontlik om personeel te voorsien om die hele heining te patrolleer en met ouers wat voortdurend die grense oorskry om ons perseel en gebou binne te kom, is ons stadig besig om ons geduld te verloor.

'n Heel basiese reël is dat kinders nooit met vreemdelinge mag praat nie – maar dit moet by die huis by die kinders tuisgebring word. Ons vind dat ouers, kinders en vreemdelinge van tyd tot tyd die grense toets en hoewel ons genoeg personeel aan diens het, moet die basiese veiligheidsreëls tuis geleer word.

Speletjies

Ons ervaar dat speletjies kom en gaan, of dit nou albasters, "Stickee", kaartspeletjies ens. is, of wat ook al die nuwe gier is. Ouers het verskillende menings, maar hierdie speletjies kom van die huis af en kinders stel dit aan ander kinders by die skool bekend. Ons is bewus van 'n spesifieke speletjie wat tans deur 'n baie klein persentasie van ons leerders gespeel word. Die meerderheid van ons leerders is nie van hierdie speletjie bewus nie en die skool word in gevaar gestel as gevolg van die onkunde van die jong leerders wat die speletjie speel.

Dit was binne ons mag om hierdie leerders te versoek om nie meer die speletjie te speel nie en om toestemming van hul ouers te kry indien hulle dit wil speel. Ons sal hulle slegs toelaat om dit te speel indien ons u toestemming het en ons sal ouers bel om te bevestig.

Hiermee ontnem ons nie die reg van kinders om speletjies te speel nie, maar ons bied aan u as ouer die geleentheid om u kind op te voed en aanspreeklikheid te aanvaar. Ons het 'n morele verantwoordelikheid teenoor alle leerders.

Uiteindelik word u as ouer aanspreeklik gehou vir alle gevolge in hierdie verband.
