Dear Parents

Welcome back to a very full and busy fourth term. With preparation for the exams running very close to the academic time-frame, ensuring all work is properly covered and that time for revision is allowed puts a huge burden on our teachers. Please be patient and support our staff by checking homework daily and ensuring revision is done at home.

Together we can ensure our children are not only well prepared for the final exam, but also able to face it with a positive attitude.

Three prize giving's will take place after the exam, this includes two prestigious events as well as our prize giving for all learners. We acknowledge every learner's participation. Please ensure information is forwarded to teachers when requested. We will never neglect to award a child on purpose and should a mistake be made, the focus should be on rectifying it in a decent and respectful manner.

For academic purposes we will only make use of the marks accumulated in the first three terms to determine our prize winners.

The fourth term mark and that of the final exam is very important as it contributes between 25 and 60 percent of the mark taken into consideration for promotion to the next grade.

It's also the time for us to have interviews with parents of children not meeting the minimum requirements to progress to the next grade. We follow prescribed procedures and always try to keep it professional and treat it with the respect and empathy it deserves.

This is also the time of year that "Detention" tends to catch some learners and parents off guard. Detention is not negotiable and there's no choice to attend or not to attend. Should you follow your child's transgressions and relevant correspondence you should be on top of it. By law you need to work with us in this regard.

"My mother says that I will not sit detention" or "the school can go to..." these remarks are not appropriate, nor will they be entertained. Should you ever need to contest "Detention" please do so in writing and keep it between you and the teacher.

Children will always try to get adults on their side by ever so slightly changing the facts. This is as old as the mountains and so often parents fall for it. We encounter gossip on what parents do and say at home daily. We take it with "a pinch of salt" and treat it with professional respect and courtesy. Should we believe everything we hear, you might find officials regularly pitching up at your front door.


Take the professional side of the teacher and accept his/her judgement. If you are in doubt, contact the teacher and treat the issue with the same professional respect and courtesy they extend to you.

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Geagte Ouers

Hartlik welkom terug vir 'n bedrywige vierde kwartaal aan alle onderwysfronte. Voorbereidings vir die eksamen binne 'n baie knap akademiese skedule en om seker te maak dat alle werk behoorlik behandel en tyd vir hersiening toegelaat word, plaas 'n geweldige druk op ons onderwysers. Wees asseblief geduldig en ondersteun ons personeel deur daagliks te verseker dat huiswerk en hersiening tuis gedoen word.

Saan kan ons verseker dat ons kinders nie net behoorlik vir die eindeksamen voorberei nie, maar dit ook met 'n positiewe houding tegemoet gaan.

Drie prysuitdelings vind ná die eksamen plaas – dit behels twee prestige-geleenthede asook 'n prysuitdeling vir alle leerders. Ons verleen erkenning vir deelname aan alle leerders, maak dus asseblief seker dat inligting na onderwysers deurgestuur word wanneer u daarvoor gevra word. **Ons sal nooit met opset nalaat om 'n kind te beloon nie en indien 'n fout begaan word, moet dit op 'n behoorlike wyse en met respek reggestel word.**

Vir akademiese doeleindes word slegs die punte wat gedurende die eerste drie kwartale behaal is, in aanmerking geneem wanneer die pryswenners bepaal word.

Die punte vir die vierde kwartaal en die eindeksamen is uiters belangrik, aangesien dit tussen 25% en 60% van die punt tel wat gebruik word om bevordering tot die volgende graad te bepaal.

Dit is ook die tyd wanneer ons onderhoude voer met die ouers van die kinders wat nie die minimum standarde behaal het om tot die volgende graad bevorder te word nie. Ons volg die voorgeskrewe procedures en poog altyd om dit op professionele wyse en met die respek en empatie wat dit verdien, te hanteer.

Ongelukkig is dit 'n feit dat sommige van ons kinders nie tot die volgende graad bevorder sal word nie en dat sommige leerders gedurende die eindeksamen nie goed sal presteer nie. Hulle is almal kinders, ons is baie lief vir hulle en ons verstaan. Kom ons hanteer dit met respek en waardigheid.

Dit is ook die tyd van die jaar wanneer detensie geneig is om sommige leerders en ouers onkant te betrap. Detensie is nie onderhandelbaar nie en daar is geen keuse om detensie by te woon of nie by te woon nie. Indien u op die hoogte is van u kind se oortredings en die betrokke korrespondensie, behoort daar geen probleem te wees nie. Volgens wet moet u in hierdie verband u samewerking gee.

"My ma sê ek sal nie detensie sit nie" of "die skool kan gaan doppies blaas....." sal nie geduld word nie. Indien u ooit detensie wil bewis of nie daarmee saamstem nie, moet u dit asseblief skriftelik aan die onderwyser rig.

Kinders sal altyd probeer om volwassenes te kry om diestrydbyl namens hulle op te neem deur die feite net so effens te verdraai. Dit is so oud soos die berge en ouers val daarvoor! Ons het daagliks met skinderstories te doen en dinge wat ouers by die huis sê en doen. **Ons neem dit met 'n knippie sout en hanteer dit met professionele respek en bedagsaamheid.** Indien ons dit nie doen nie, sal u dalk gereeld amptenare op u drumpel hê.

Onthou die onderwyser is 'n professionele persoon, aanvaar asseblief sy/haar besluite. Indien u twyfel, kontak die onderwyser en vra u vrae met dieselfde professionele respek en bedagsaamheid wat aan u betoon word.

Let asseblief daarop dat wanneer ons teen enige kind optree as gevolg van wangedrag, ons volgens strafmaatreëls wat ons as gepas beskou, optree en ons sal ons nie laat voorskryf in hierdie verband nie. Ons maak die strafmaatreëls slegs aan die kind en sy/haar ouers bekend. Ons veroordeel nie en hou dit ook nie teen 'n kind nie, want ons verstaan dat kinders foute maak en dat hulle deur hul foute leer – dit is deel van opvoeding!




