



Geagte Ouers

Ek was verstom om te hoor dat ouers weier om met ons oor hul kinders se akademiese vordering te praat en selfs enige ondersteuning van die hand wys. Waarom bring ek dit onder u aandag? Sodat u nie u kind se eie grootste vyand word nie – kom ons trotseer die uitdagings saam sonder negatiewe gedrag of om dit wat verkeerd is, te veroordeel.

Kinders leer uit hul foute en ons as volwassenes moet saamstaan met regstel, aanpas, beheer en bid in hierdie proses van die lewe.

Ons interne 50%-slaagsyfer het 'n verskil gemaak aan die verhoging van ons akademiese standaard en die feit dat ons seker van ons saak was as waarde-**gedrewe skool, het ook 'n verskil gemaak.** Ons fokus op die 95% positiewe ouers en gelukkige kinders, maar ons sal nie die 5% negatiewe mense verwerp of ignoreer nie.

Ons sal hulle met respek en waardigheid behandel, maar ongelukkig verwag ons dieselfde van hulle.

Hiermee in gedagte, moet ek vrae vra oor ons kinders se gewoontes op digitale en tegnologie-gebied.

Watter TV-programme kyk ons kinders? Beskerm ons ons kinders teen dit wat op DSTV beskikbaar is? Wie besluit oor **die ouderdomsperk van 'n program? Wie weet wat daagliks** aan ons kinders opgedis word met Whatsapp, Facebook, ens? En die magtige Google?

U sal verstom wees as u bietjie navorsing doen. U sal ontdek dat kinders programme kyk wat vir volwassenes geskik is, dat ouderdomsperke belaglik is, daar is afgryslike Whatsapp-taal en Facebook-boodskappe en Google-blaaie waarvan ek nooit gedroom het nie.

U moet deel word van u kind se lewe en 'n voorbeeld stel, want die jeug gaan vra: "Wat is op jou Whatsapp, Pa? En op jou Facebook-bladsy, Ma?"

Since 2013 I have touched on a variety of topics in the newsletters. Respect, however, has remained the main focus throughout. What are our children watching on TV? Are we protecting our children against what is available on DSTV? Who decides on the age restriction of a programme? Who knows what "WhatsApp", "Facebook" etc. has brought to our children daily? The mighty "Google"?

A simple check will stun you. It will reveal that children are watching programmes suitable for adults, it will reveal that age restrictions are a joke, it will reveal horrifying "WhatsApp" language and "Facebook" messages. It will reveal "Google" pages that you would never have thought of. You need to become a part of your child's life in a positive manner and set an example, because the question from the **youth will be: "What's on your WhatsApp dad and on your Facebook page mum?"**




