



Geagte Ouers

Afwesighede

Baie dankie aan ons ouers vir hul samewerking – afwesighede het afgeneem en ons kon 90% van die leerders wat gedurende skooltyd huis toe gaan, besnoei. Dit bly 'n netelige kwessie, maar die kern van die saak is dat ons nie wil hê ouers moet siek kinders skool toe stuur nie. Indien dit 'n grensgeval is, moet ouers asseblief per brief of e-pos met die klasonderwyser kommunikeer. Dit is nie 'n opdrag aan die onderwyser nie, maar net 'n nota aangaande 'n siek kind.

Kinders wat gedurende skooltyd siek word, bly 'n probleem aangesien dit dikwels net voor 'n toets of aktiwiteit waarvan die kind nie hou nie, gebeur. Dit skep 'n probleem by assessering en ons sien ook soms 'n uur of twee later kinders saam met hul ouers in winkelsentrums of langs die sportveld.

Soos reeds genoem, het ons kinders wat huis toe gaan met 90% besnoei deur net 'n bietjie strenger op te tree. Dit is nie 'n maklike taak nie, hoe later in die kwartaal, hoe meer die afwesighede, tot die laaste week van die kwartaal, wanneer afwesighedsgetalle die hoogte inskiet. By Sunridge is die beleid dat die onderwysers tot die heel laaste dag met werk moet voortgaan.

Kanale

Hoewel ek u kind se skoolhoof is, kom maak baie leerders 'n draai in my kantoor om te kom gesels, my iets te wys of 'n drukkie te gee. Hulle weet my deur staan altyd vir hulle oop. Wat ouers aanbetref, is die oop-deurbeleid eenvoudig.

Die personeel werk met die leerders en daarom moet enige saak deur hulle hanteer word. Ek is nie 'n boodskapper nie en ek respekteer hul professionele hantering van 'n saak. Indien hulle die probleem of versoek nie kan hanteer nie, sal hulle die korrekte kanale volg en die saak word dan na die Afdelingshoof, die Departementshoof en uiteindelik die Adjunk-Skoolhoof verwys. Indien hulle nie 'n oplossing kan bewerkstellig nie, sal ek dan die betrokke dokumente bestudeer, 'n antwoord of aanbeveling voorberei en dan die ouers spreek en die saak afhandel.

Dit is belangrik dat prosedure gevolg en gerespekteer moet word. Indien dit nie die geval is nie, sal ek nie 'n onderhoud toestaan nie en net my oplossing of aanbeveling kommunikeer.

My opregte dank aan 99% van ons ouers wat hierdie prosedure respekteer en wat nie die skool aanval nie, maar daarop fokus om probleme met respek op te los. Twee maal verkeerd is nie reg nie en dit is wonderlik om te sien hoeveel ouers met ons saamwerk en nie stroomop swem nie.

Dear Parents

Absenteeism

Thanks to parents who have assisted us in this regard; our daily absenteeism has decreased. We have managed to cut 90% of learners going home during school hours. This remains a very difficult matter and request that parents don't send sick children to school. Should it be a borderline case, parents should send a letter or e-mail to the class teacher. This is not an instruction to the teacher but a note regarding the illness.

Children who fall ill during school hours create a difficult situation as it often happens before a test or activity the learner would like to avoid. This compromises assessment and we sometimes find these learners with their parents in shopping centres or next to the sport field an hour or two later.

By being much stricter in who we allow to go home we have cut down, as mentioned, 90% of these cases. This is not easy due to the fact that closer to the end of the term, and especially the last week of a term, there is a very high absenteeism. The policy at Sunridge is that teachers continue with work till the very last day.

Channels

I am your child's principal and I must say that many learners come to my office for a chat, to show me something or just to ask for a hug. They know that my door, when open, is always open for them. With parents the open door policy is simple.

Teachers work with the learners and any matter must therefore go through them. I am not a messenger and respect my staff's professional conduct. Should the teacher not be able to deal with a problem or request, they will follow the correct channel and the matter will be referred to the head of the division, the HOD and finally to the Deputy Principal. Should they still not be able to resolve the matter, I will study all relevant documentation and prepare a solution or recommendation and then see the parents and deal with the matter.

It's important that this procedure is followed and respected. Should this not be the case I will refuse an interview and just communicate my solution or recommendation.

My sincere thanks to the 99% of our parents who respect the procedure, and do not attack the school but focus on resolving matters with respect. Two wrongs never make a right and it's wonderful to see how many parents work with us and not against us.

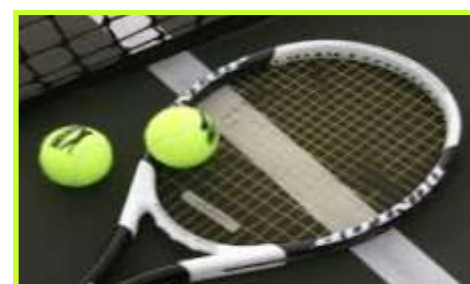
