



Geagte Ouers

Ons het meer aansoek ontvang as wat ons kan plaas en ons is trots daarop dat ons skool op so 'n wyse dien dat wat ons aanbied, in aanvraag is. Ons sal nou die kriteria toepas soos in die toelatingsbeleid uiteengesit en suksesvolle aansoekers sal so gou moontlik in kennis gestel word.

Ons kinders geniet skool en lewe voluit. Ons ervaar dat die positiewe ingesteldheid wat ons aanmoedig, soos 'n veldbrand versprei. Kom ons bly helder skyn vir Sunridge!

Ná ons kommunikasie oor projekte wat onderneem of in die beplanningstadium is, het ons die geleentheid vir betrokkenheid geskep. Die LED-klasprojek vir veilige elektrisiteit het vlam gevat en 'n vriend van die skool het die koste met die helfte besnoei. Ons kan met trots bekend maak dat ons nou 'n klas met LED-ligte kan toerus teen R2 500.00, met 'n tweejaarwaborg.

Die Gr 6A-klas het eerste 'n borg gekry, ter herinnering aan Jayde. Die borgbord sal lees: "Shine bright for Jayde". Hulle is deur Gr 6D gevolg met 'n onderneming om 'n borg te kry. Kom ons raak betrokke en maak 'n verskil deur helder vir Sunridge te skyn. Ons grootste verbruik van elektrisiteit is die ligte in ons klasse. Met LED-ligte in al ons klasse geïnstalleer, sal ons meer lig hê, geen flikkering van ligte nie, en 'n besparing van tussen 40% en 60% op ons elektrisiteitsrekening. Ons toon reeds 'n afname in verbruik as gevolg van bestuur.

Ons eksamen duur van 4 tot 12 Junie en alle buitemuurse bedrywighede is vir hierdie tydperk gekanselleer. Soos reeds gemeld, sluit die skool om 13:00 en vanaf 17 Junie keer alles weer terug tot normaal. Soos voorgeskryf, skryf ons net oor 'n tydperk van 7 dae eksamen, geen kind mag tuis bly nie en vir laerskole word geen sogenaamde "blokdae" toegelaat nie.

Met skool wat vanaf die 17de normaal voortgaan, moet alle merkwerk, moderering en administratiewe werk tussenin deur personeel gedoen word. Dit is die tyd van die jaar wanneer laerskoolonderwysers tot laatnag werk om seker te maak dat korrekte rapporte op die laaste dag van skool uitgegee word. Weereens geen uitsonderings in hierdie verband nie, ons finale kontrole word op die laaste dag van die kwartaal gedoen, die rapporte word om 11:00 aan die kinders oorhandig en word aan ouers beskikbaar gestel om dit tussen 11:15 en 11:30 af te haal.

Ons ervaar nou dat kinders selfone skool toe bring: My ma/pa het gesê ek moet! Dit is teen ons reëls, en indien dit nodig is, is die reël baie duidelik. **Ouers moet 'n brief skryf om toestemming te vra en slegsanneer goedkeuring verleen is en die nodige dokumentasie in plek is, mag 'n kind sy/haar selfoon skool toe bring.**

Die nuwe neiging onder seuns is hare met 'n "trappie" (step) gesny. Kort aan die kante en lank bo. Die skoolreëls is baie duidelik. Indien dit gebeur, versoek ons dat die hare onmiddellik gelyk gesny word.

Dear Parents

Applications well exceed our available space and we are proud that our school can serve in such a way that what we offer is in demand. We will now apply our criteria as set out in our admission policy and successful applicants will be informed as soon as possible.

Our children enjoy school and life to the full. We do find that the positive attitude we encourage is like a veld fire. Let's keep on shining bright for Sunridge!

After our communication on projects undertaken or in planning we create the opportunity for involvement. The LED class project to save electricity caught fire and a friend of the school cut the cost per class in half. We are proud to announce that for R2500.00 we can now fit a class with LED lights with a two year guarantee.

Grade 6A was the first class with a sponsor and this in memory of Jayde. The sponsorship board will read: "Shine bright for Jayde". This was followed by Grade 6D with an undertaking to get a sponsor. Let's get involved and make a difference by shining bright for Sunridge. Our biggest usage of electricity are the lights in our classes. With LED lights installed in all classes we will have more light, no flickering of lights and a saving between 40% and 60% on our electricity bill. We have already seen a drop in our usage due to management.

Our examinations are from 4 to 12 June and all extra mural activities are cancelled for this period. School closes at 13:00 as communicated and from 17 June all is back to normal. As prescribed, we can only run the examinations over a 7 day time frame, no child may stay at home and no so called "block days" are allowed for primary schools.

With school continuing as normal from the 17 June, marking, moderation and all administrative work done by the staff needs to be done in between. This is a time of year for primary school teachers when they burn the midnight oil to ensure accurate reports are handed out on the last day of the term. Again no exceptions in this regard: our final control will be done on the last day of the term and reports will be handed to the children at 11:00 and made available for parents who need to collect them by 11:15 to 11:30.

We find that children are now bringing cell phones to school: my dad/mum said I must! This is against our rules and should it be necessary the rules are very clear. Parents need to write a letter asking permission, with a valid reason, and only on receiving approval and when the necessary documentation is in place may a child bring his/her cell phone to school.

The new trend under the boys is a haircut with a "step". Short on the side and long on top. The school rules are very clear. Should this happen we will immediately ask for the hair to be cut evenly.






