Ons praat eerlik, maar met respek – vir sommige gesinne en vir die skool was dit ‘n moeilike jaar.

Ons moes meningsverskille, finansiële uitdagings, afdankings, herontplooiing, siekte, dood van geliefdes en emosionele uitdagings wat ons pad gekruis het, trotseer. Ongeag wie of wat ons is, het ons hierdie probleme op ons eie manier hanteer. Personeel moes ook hierdie uitdagings te midde van hul dagtake te bowe kom en steeds ons kinders dien deur gehalte-onderrig te lewer.

Ek is so trots om te sê dat dit gedoen is, nie altyd maklik en sonder probleme nie, maar dit is gedoen en die standaard was baie goed. Ons het ‘n paar besoeke van die Departement ontvang en by meer as een geleentheid moes hulle erken dat ons dienslewering van hoogstaande gehalte is, ver bo die gemiddeld en ver bo verwagting. Ons personeel het die ekstra myl gestap en al die opofferings gemaak wat van onderwysers verwag word.

Onderwys is ‘n roeping, ‘n roeping buite gewone werkure, ‘n roeping ver bo gewone verwagtinge en ‘n roeping om te gee eerder as te neem. Om persoonlike tyd en gevoelens op te offer, is alles deel van die dagtaak en ek lig my hoed vir elke onderwyser by Sunridge.

Baie dankie aan die meerderheid van ons kinders wat dit ‘n plesier gemaak het om ‘n onderwyser by Sunridge te wees en wat al die opofferings die moeite werd gemaak het.
