With all due respect, the ignorance in this regard creates conflict which is unnecessary. We also find that even when proved wrong by supplying the documents again parents seldom say "sorry". They grant themselves the right to act as they deem necessary.

We currently read in the newspapers about trouble in education and about the number of learners now enrolling in private schools. It's a pity the Department does not disclose the information that functional public schools, like Sunridge, provide for a much better quality education and that the results of functional schools outperform those of private schools.

The most important fact of the matter is discipline and support from parents. When children want to work and want to perform and then combine it with the support of parents, Sunridge can become even better. Currently a highly ranked departmental official from the curriculum division placed Sunridge Primary school as one of the two best primary schools in the Eastern Cape.

Coming from an official who is not that impressed with our type of schools it was more than a feather in our cap. We are delivering a far above average service and on the management side a similar report was also received.

We, however will not rest and will strive to become even better, keep up with change and apply our values.

Bags on Wheels

I understand that we will have different opinions in this regard and respect that. Our job is to take decisions based on the school as a unit. This was previously dealt with in a newsletter.

It's very simple, we have our policy in place and cannot allow learners to wheel their bags inside the school building. Our school was not designed or built to accommodate this. In cases based on merit we investigate properly and will then manage the weight ratio compared to the movement inside the building and distance covered by learners. Class changes only take a few minutes with short distances in most cases.

Outside the school building we allow the use thereof but also find that these bags do not last and that proper management is the better solution.

Only on merit and with a dual physical report and medical documents will we enforce our escape clause to allow it for a learner with challenges. This will be the exception and not the rule.

Geagte Ouers

Omsendbriewe en Nuusbriewe

Oor die jare het hierdie dokumente waardevolle inligting aan alle ouers deurgegee. Ons vind so dikwels dat ouers nalaat om hierdie belangrike inligting te lees en hul argumente dan baseer op dit wat hulle glo. Selfs die gedragskode in die huiswerkboekie verskaf waardevolle inligting aan alle leerders en ouers.

Met alle respek, die onkunde in hierdie verband veroorsaak konflik wat totaal onnodig is. Ons vind ook dat, selfs wanneer dokumente getoon en ouers verkeerd bewys word, hulle selde om verskoning vra. Hulle eien hulself net so effentjies die reg toe om op te tree soos hulle goeddink.

Weereens is dit net 5% van ons ouers, so kom ons wees positief oor die ander 95%. Baie dankie dat u skoolnuusbriewe en omsendbriewe lees en aandag daaraan skenk.

Ons lees tans in die koerante oor al die probleme in die onderwys en ook onlangs oor die hoeveelheid kinders wat nou by privaatskole ingeskryf word. Dit is net jammer dat hulle nie inligting oor funksionele openbare skole soos Sunridge bekend maak nie. **Ons bied onderrig van baie hoër standaard teen 'n baie laer prys en die uitslae van funksionele skole stel dié van privaatskole in die skadu.**

Die belangrikste aspek van die saak is dissipline en ondersteuning van ouers. Wanneer kinders wil werk en uitblink, sal dit **saam met die ondersteuning van hul ouers van Sunridge selfs 'n beter skool maak.** 'n Hooggeplaaste departementeel amptenaar van die curriculum-afdeling het Sunridge Primère Skool as een van die twee beste primère skole in die Oos-Kaap geplaas.

Komende van 'n amptenaar wat nie met ons soort skool beïndruk is nie, was dit vir ons meer as 'n riem onder die hart. Ons lewer 'n bogemiddelde diens en aan bestuurskant het ons 'n soortgelyke verslag ontvang.

Ons sal egter nie rus nie en sal daarna streef om selfs beter te wees, by verandering aan te pas en nie ons waardes in te boet nie.

Skooltasse op Wiele

Ek begryp dat ons verskillende menings in hierdie verband het en ek respekteer dit. Ons werk is om besluite gebaseer op die **skool as 'n eenheid te neem. Dit is reeds in 'n vorige nuusbrief bespreek.**

Dit is baie eenvoudig – ons beleid is in plek geplaas en ons kan nie toelaat dat leerders hul tasse op wiele in die skoolgebou rondsleep nie. Ons skool is nie ontwerp of gebou om dit te hanteer nie. Gevalle op meriete gebaseer word deeglik ondersoek en dan word die verhouding tussen gewig, beweging binne die gebou en afstand deur leerders afgelê, bestuur. Klaswisselings neem slegs 'n paar minute en in die meeste gevalle word kort afstande afgelê.

Ons laat wel gebruik daarvan buite die skoolgebou toe, maar ons ondervind ook dat hierdie tasse nie lank hou nie en dat behoorlike bestuur 'n beter oplossing is.

Slegs op meriete en met 'n verslag oor fisiese welstand en mediese dokumente, sal ons die voorbehoudsklousule in werking stel vir leerders met uitdagings. Dit sal die uitsondering wees, nie die reël nie.




