Dear Parents

To have a positive attitude is not always easy nor is it glamorous but it is definitely rewarding.

Doing a "reality check" they found that with certain competitive schools the children stop participating in sport after school while with others they tend to continue. To the point it all comes down to the fact that these children never learnt to lose! In the environment after school they could not deal with losing, so they quit!

Studies also show that this concept can be applied to academic performance and that the hard worker in school tends to perform the best at University.

We need to teach our children how to lose gracefully. We need to encourage hard and regular work and to raise the bar to prevent mediocrity. In general we need to teach our children to deal with life - with success and failure.

As Principal I also have to follow channels. Before I can make a change, decision, recommendation or reinstating something I must follow channels. Consulting with the Head of Departments and SMT after they did the same with staff and other role players is all part of the process.

It's within these boundaries that I ask of parents to follow channels, send your correspondence first to the person in charge and allow them to follow channels as well. By contacting me directly on an academic, sport or cultural matter is making a postman of me. That I cannot accept and the "DEL" button follows or "P35" shredder applies. **The same when I am "cc" in an email.**

I wait for the person whose responsibility it is to follow channels, consult and table it if needed before I apply my mind to make an informed decision. They get paid to do the work and I trust them to manage their divisions professionally. Please do the same!
