Ons beweeg nou vorentoe – al ons Gr 1-leerders moet vanaf **2017 'n Tweede Addisionele Taal neem en ons sal "IsiXhosa" instel om aan dié vereiste te voldoen. Vanaf** 2017 sal die skoolweek vir Gr 1 langer wees en ons sal die **nodige akademiese maatreëls in plek stel om professioneel** daarvoor voorsiening te maak.

Dit raak geensins ons huidige Gr 1- tot 7-leerders nie en sal ook nie ons skoolure vir Gr 2 tot 7 in 2017 beïnvloed nie.

Vakansie




