Dit is al amper September, wat beteken dis amper lente met al die wonderlike someraktiwiteite waaraan ons kinders in die nabye toekoms gaan deelneem. Vir die mense wat lief is vir **die winter, is die goeie nuus dat daar seker darem nog 'n paar koue dae voorlê.**

Soos die seisoene verander, vind daar ook verandering in ons lewens plaas – **en wat 'n voorreg is dit om ons kinders te sien grootword en deur die lewensfases gaan. Een fase waarmee ons gereeld te doen het, is die verskillende menings en verskillende beskouings.**

Dit lui 'n nuwe fase binne die huise in en ons wil gesonde wedywering aanmoedig en respek en pret tydens deelname verseker. Die puntestelsel en aankondigings van punte tydens saalbyeenkoms skep 'n gesonde omgewing vir ons kinders.

Ons doelwit is om een huis-gholfhemp GRATIS aan elke kind te gee. Ons kinders het met die briljante idee vorendag gekom om borge vir elke huis te kry en hierdie proses is nou aan die gang.

Borgskappe is oop vir almal en diegene wat eerste aansoek doen, kry eerste keuse. Teen die bedrag van R30 000 kry die borg sy/haar naam op die gholfhemp van sy/haar huis - keuse. Dit salregs voor op die hemp wees, met die Sunridge -logo links voor. Hierdie hemp, met die naam van die borg, word vir die volgende 7 jaar gebruik. Indien 'n kind 'n nuwe of groter hemp moet koop, moet hy/sy self daarvoor betaal. Die skool sal hemde in voorraad hou en teen kosprys verkoop. Hierdie hemde kan slegs by die skool gekoop word. **Ons sal ook 'n ruilwinkel vir tweedehandse hemde in goeie toestand bedryf, indien kinders in die toekoms hul hemde vir groter hemde moet ruil.**

Alle nuwe leerders sal hul eerste huis-gholfhemp gratis van die skool ontvang. Indien u dus sou belangstel om die borg van 'n huis te wees, is dit nou u geleentheid om ons te skakel. Ons hoor graag van u. Soos aan die kinders gestel, sal die sukses van die projek van die verkryging van borge afhang.

It is almost September which means it's almost spring with all the wonderful summer events awaiting our children. For those who love winter I do believe we will still encounter a couple of cold days.

As seasons change so does life and what a privilege to see our children grow and go through the phases of life. One phase we deal with every day is the one of different opinions and different views.

We have considered phasing in a Golf Shirt for each house since 2014. Donkin – Royal Blue, Algoa - Emerald Green and Diaz - Orange. **Algoa's name badges will stay the same colour for now - we will phase in the change of colour starting with grade 1 in 2017. The light blue Phys Ed Golf shirt remains for Phys Ed and Sport. This change is to give each house their own identity seeing that Algoa shares light blue with the rest of the school.**

This will ensure a new phase within the houses and we want to encourage healthy competition and firmly establish respect and fun when competing. The point system and announcements during assembly sets a healthy environment for our children.

Our aim is to issue each child with one free house Golf Shirt. Our children came up with the brilliant idea to get sponsors for each house. This is now in progress.

We offer this sponsorship to all on a first come first serve basis. For R30 000 a sponsor will get their name on the Golf Shirt of the house of their choice. This will be on the right front of the shirt and the Sunridge logo on the left front. This house shirt will be used for the **next 7 years with the sponsor's name on it. Should a child need a new or bigger size it will be for their own cost.** The school will stock shirts and sell the shirts at cost price. The house shirts can only be bought from the school. We will also run an exchange for second hand shirts in good condition, at our discretion, should children need to swap sizes in the future.

Every new learner will receive their first house Golf Shirt from the school at no cost. 


