Ons het kinders en personeellede wat sukkel om gesond te word want hulle het te lank gewag om 'n dokter te spreek.

Onthou asseblief om die klasonderwyser in kennis te stel en verskaf 'n mediese sertifikaat waar nodig. Waarom? Die Departement van Onderwys verlang dit van ons en indien 'n kind dikwels afwesig is, vra hulle daarvoor wanneer bevordering bespreek word. Ek weet die ouers sal ons in dié verband ondersteun.

Ons het navrae ontvang oor die beskikbaarheid van die ligblou sporthemp en ek kan bevestig dat die probleem opgelos is. Dit was slegs die ekstra klein en grootte 12 – 13 wat 'n probleem was. Om dieselfde aspekte rondom die skool te monitor, is 'n openbaring aangesien dit op 'n daaglike basis gebeur. Ek glo dat ons na ons gedrag in hierdie verband moet kyk en dit as 'n uitdaging moet beskou om 'n verskil te maak en 'n voorbeeld vir ons kinders te stel.

Tydens 'n onlangse besoek deur 'n vooraanstaande skool van Gauteng het ons komplimente vir ons geriewe en ons buitengewoon netjiese en funksionele fasiliteite ontvang. Ek was so trots op Sunridge en dit wat ons aanbied, en selfs meer op ons kinders wat in 'n goeie gees en met deernis en respek teenoor hul opponente deelneem.

Die son skyn helder en ons kinders se toekoms skyn selfs herderder.




