



Geagte Ouers

Terwyl universiteite kreatief aan maniere werk om die 2016-akademiese jaar te red, is daar net meer en meer skokke wat ons binne die hoëronderrys tref. Die punt van die ysberg is iets wat ons nie graag sal **wil hoor of lees nie. Die ekstra R17,6 miljard is 'n klein pleistertjie wat nie die bloeiende wond in hoëronderrys so maklik gaan stop nie.**

In ons TVET-**kolleges, waar studente toegerus moet word met 'n NCV** (nasionale beroepsgerigte sertifikaat), slaag slegs 10,6% van studente. Die vierjaar-sertifikaat beloop R454 260 per student.

**Hier op laerskoolvlak neem ons 'n kind vanaf basiese kommunikasievaardighede en kennis na 'n vlak waar nie alleen gevestigde kommunikasievaardighede nie, maar bogemiddelde syfervaardighede, lees, begrip en lewensvaardighede op 'n vlak vir verdere ontwikkeling met gemak kan plaasvind. Dit alles binne 'n veilige en liefdevolle omgewing teen 'n fraksie van die prys. Ons slaagsyfer op nasionale vlak is 99% en ons suksessyfer vir kinders wat wel skolastiese probleme ondervind, is bo 85%.**

Ons onderwysers werk nie met akademies uitgesoekte kinders nie - ons **lewer 'n diens aan al die kinders wat ons binne ons fasiliteite kan akkommodeer** sonder om dit te kompromitteer. Hierdie druk raak jaarliks **hoër weens die huidige sigbare "gratis" siekte wat meer en meer kop uitsteek.** Onrealistiese verwagtinge wat so kwaliteit onderwys vernietig, bedreig juis die afdeling waar die fondasie vir alle onderwys gelê word, ons laerskool.

Laerskoolonderwys is nie alleenlik die swakste befondste en voos geëksperimenteerde afdeling nie, maar die hoogs werksbelaaide afdeling. Proefkonlyne vir nuwe idees, onderwysmetodes en vele meer wat kreatief deur positiewe en pligsgetroue onderwysers jaarliks getrotseer moet word om die beste vir ons kinders te gee.

Die respek wat hulle verdien, word deur die negatiewe verswelg terwyl soveel kinders se puik prestasies en vordering misgekyk word. Ek **verkies onteenseglik om na 'n helder toekoms te kyk en die uitdagings saam met God en ons onderwysers aan te pak.** Alle prestasies op alle vlakke na skool en op alle fronte van die lewe, is te danke aan die fondasie wat deur pligsgetroue en hardwerkende onderwysers gelê word. Onteenseglik ook die gewilligheid van kinders om te wil leer

Universiteitstudente twyfel aan die moontlike verlies van hulle akademiese jaar en ons matrieks is reeds volstroom aan die afsluit van hulle hoërskoolloopbane met onsekerhede oor die toekoms wat nog steeds **dreig. In our TVET college where students should be equipped with an NCV (national career directed certificate) only 10,6% of students pass. The four year certificate costs R454 260 per student.

At primary school level we take a child from basic communication skills and knowledge, to a level where not only established communication skills but above average numerical, reading, comprehension and life skills can be easily achieved. This all happens within a loving and safe environment at a fraction of the price. Our pass mark at national level is 99% and the success rate for children who are scholastically challenged is above 85%.

Our teachers do not work with children who are selected for their academic excellence, we deliver a service to all the children we can accommodate without compromising our facilities. The pressure gets more and **more every year because of the current visible "free" disease which is rearing its head more and more.** Unrealistic expectations are destroying quality education and threatening the area where the foundation is laid for all education – our primary school.

Primary school education is not only the area which receives the least funding and is experimented upon the most but also the area which is burdened with the most work. Guinea pigs for new ideas, teaching methods and much more have to be braved every year by positive and conscientious teachers who only want to give the best to our children.


Let us brave the challenges on all levels with the core values of Respect, Integrity, Compassion and Honesty.


