Indien ons met hierdie gedagte speel en die kind as die kliënt met net een versoek 'berei my voor vir die toekoms' sien, sal ons vind dat die onderwysstelsel tekort skiet. Hier by Sunridge is ons bevoorreg met 'n goed gebalanseerde akademiese, sport- en kultuurleerplan.

Ons skep geleenthede en ek besef hoe gelukkig ons is. Ja, soms gebeur dinge nie soos ons verwag nie, maar oor die algemeen tel ons onder die TOP-laerskole in Suid-Afrika. 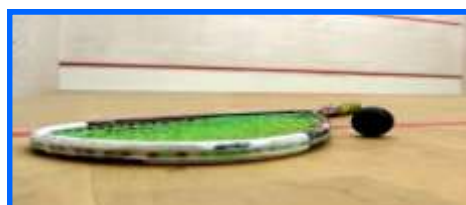
