Sad News

As Principals we get together to discuss the positive and negative aspects we share in our schools. It's astounding to see the similarity and when drawing a comparison it's like a "soapy" unfolding.

Hockey is one of the sports setting an example for all other sport codes. Discipline from the coach and parents allows for children to play the game within an atmosphere of sportsmanship.

Coaches are not allowed to chirp or make negative comments directed at the referee; this will end in the referee instructing the coach to remove him or herself from the premises. With parents it will mean that the captain of the team will be sent off the field and ultimately a parent can be denied entry to the premises. This is only for matches and is well supported. I do not have any other choice than to start enforcing this rule during hockey practices as well!

Some Sunridge parent's behaviour and language is to say the least, utterly disrespectful and shocking. To top this we had a netball parent misbehaving at another school to such an extent that the Principal had to phone me. Dit is weereens 3% van ons ouers wat hulle swak gedra en miskien wel diegene wat nie nuusbriewe lees nie en beleide ignoreer. Hierdie is ‘n vriendelike versoek aan alle ouers om hulle nie aan hierdie tipe gedrag skuldig te maak nie. Volg asseblief die kanale en maak seker dat u hierdie aspekte reg benader.

Plaas ‘n wag voor u mond, byt u tong vas en byt op u tande. As Skoolhoof mag ek nie hierdie ouers se name noem nie, ek moet sterk staan en hul kinders binne die beleid bedien. 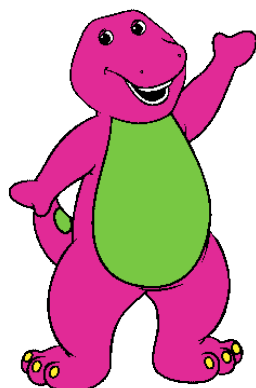
