Geleenthede

Terwyl ek ons jong hokkie-, netbal- en rugbyspelers ondersteun het, het ek net weer besef watter ongelooflike geleenthede ons vir ons kinders skep. Hoewel dit nie aan almal se verwagtinge voldoen nie, is dit belangrik om van die geleenthede gebruik te maak.

Ek het selfs gesien hoe Gr 2-leerlinge wat vir o/9A rugby speel, die Gr 2-bulletjies ondersteun. Afrigters aanvaar die uitdaging om sonder die meer ervare spelers te speel, sodat meer geleenthede geskep kan word om aan die sport deel te neem.

Hoewel die eindtelling nie belangrik is nie, was dit baie positief – dit is altyd goed om te wen, maar dit is ook baie belangrik om te leer hoe om met grasie te verloor. Om hierdie geleenthede te skep, is 'n uitdaging vir die afrigters en ons moet ook verdraagsaam en ondersteunend wees.

Ek het afrigters wat 8 uit 9 naweke per kwartaal vir ons kinders werk en nog boonop gehalte-onderdig lewer. Aan die ander kant is daar personeel in die kultuur- en akademiese ondersteuningsafdelings wat op hul beurt diens van dieselfde standaard lewer.

Ons beweeg vorentoe:

Ons O/11A-rugbyspan volg in die voetspore van ons O/13A's deur as weners uit die stryd te tree in die Oostelike Provinsie Super Rugby-toernooi. Hierdie jong spelers het met deernis en 'n positiewe ingesteldheid die voorbeeld gestel en die sege was 'n welverdiende prestasie wat die kroon gespan het op hul harde werk reg deur die jaar.

Baie dankie aan die afrigter en ouers wat ons kinders ondersteun het. Dit neem niks weg van ander pragtige sport- en kultuurprestasies nie. Julle is almal weners en Sunridge is trots op 'n ieder en 'n elk.

Dit is onaanvaarbaar en dit is nie ons verantwoordelikheid nie, ons word deur ouers misbruik en dit laat my geen ander keuse as om regstellende maatreëls toe te pas nie. Sodanige maatreëls mag behels om die owerhede in kennis te stel, hoewel dit nie daartoe beperk is nie.

Ons begryp dat dit af en toe vanweë onvoorsiene omstandighede mag gebeur, maar herhaalde oortredings sal ons verplig om regstellende maatreëls in te stel.

Help ons asseblief deur binne ons reëls en beleide op te tree – dit is die regte ding om te doen.

Fetching learners from school

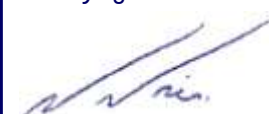

Please help us and act within our rules and policies - it is the right thing to do.

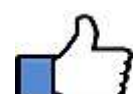
