Dear Parents

The gale force winds, stormy weather and fires have also played a role in the Sunridge family. We have family, friends, parents and children affected by these and we support the initiative to drop off any contribution at Bay West Mall or other designated places. Our gate and pillars were blown over, a reminder of the powers beyond our control.

Our prayers go out to everyone who has been affected and we also note the need for those who cannot speak for themselves. Prayers for rain are also needed - our government and leaders must also not be forgotten.

A positive spirit and outlook can make a huge difference in the lives of people, as educators we see this daily with our children. Reaching out with friendly words and attention, our staff make a difference. Six days a week I find staff creating opportunities and going the extra mile for our children.

Seeing the support and understanding from parents for staff, I again realise the value of letting the Sun Shine and to Shine Bright for Sunridge.

The exams are now over and I must compliment staff, parents and children alike for dealing with these professionally. Our late arrivals have dropped drastically and I believe that this can be maintained in the future.

#### Security

I have written many newsletters addressing this issue and kindly request parents to adhere to the rules. Thanks to the many parents who do so, sadly a few parents blatantly and aggressively ignore them.

One may ask why these measures are put into place – the answer is that it has always been the rule according to the Schools Act, but over the years it has been allowed to lapse. Unfortunately, incidents with serious repercussions are currently affecting schools in South Africa. We would rather be pro-active before we are forced to take action with an unfortunate incident. This has been brought to our attention repeatedly over the past two years and we have really tried our best to change the habit.

We had a very productive safety meeting with various authorities, addressing aspects of concern and also placing our safety measures under investigation.

They found it alarming that so many parents enter the school premises to drop off or fetch children. They recommend that gates open at 13:00 and then again at 14:00, the gates open for children to go out and not for parents to come in. They understand that sport is played in the afternoons but considering the serious incidents at schools I understand that certain things will have to change. We will do this gradually and this is a friendly request for us all to change our habits.

We were hammered on the traffic issues created by parents and a dramatic change might come about in the future. Law enforcement officers will soon start issuing fines. **Please watch your driving, parking and hand signs.**

It's with this in mind that, as recommended, we are forced to change a few things. What I however need to emphasize is the fact that by ignoring rules and policies, it is parents who put our children at risk and who will force us to introduce stricter controlling measures.

The basic aspect is that safety officials request parents to adhere to the rules, we might soon have to introduce measures to enforce it. Traffic around the school with not enough proper pavements is a serious problem that we have taken up with the authorities.

We have an open campus where children move from class to class or from one block to another between 08:00 and 14:00.

1. We recommend that parents stop at the gate and allow their child to walk on his/her own to the class or assembly point.
2. We recommend that parents wait at the gates for their children and refrain from going to the buildings.
3. Stay out of the building and away from classrooms at all times as this is fast becoming a major concern for authorities.

Children dropped off at school before 06:30 will only be able to enter at Gate 14. All drop off gates will only open at 06:30 in the mornings. They will in future close with our first bell at 07:55 sharp. We are now on official "Greenwich Time" and our bell rings accordingly. It is advisable to arrive at school 3 minutes early as times may change and our electronic bell rings automatically. We now check our times with the computer times twice a week in order to keep the difference to a minimum. We realise that it was not like that in the past, but with the new system in place we have been able to change this. Thank you for your patience in this regard.

After 07:55 only the front gate can be used and frequent late comers will be disciplined through our Discipline Policy. Be careful not to stop and drop off in the middle of the road as traffic authorities have warned about steep fines.

Gates will open 2 minutes before home time and will be locked again 15 minutes after the bell has rung. This time frame will be introduced gradually and the table below is for your convenience. We understand if parents move onto the school grounds and wait in the immediate vicinity of the gates for their children. The emphasis is on the immediate vicinity of the gates and not between or close to the buildings.

We will also adjust home times for 2018 so as to have fewer variations and simplify the system.

I have requested the relevant authorities to look into aspects like more parking space, drop off zones, sidewalks and other possible assistance to support a better flow of traffic. There will be officials monitoring these measures to evaluate our position.



## Geagte Ouers

Die stormsterk winde, stormweer en brande het die Sunridge-familie ook geraak. Ons het familie, vriende, ouers en kinders wat hierdeur geraak is en ons ondersteun die inisiatief om enige bydraes by Bay West Mall en ander versamelpunte af te laai. Ons hekke en pilare het omgewaai – 'n herinnering aan die magte buite ons beheer

Ons bid vir alle mense wat hierdeur geraak word en is ook bewus van die nood by diegene wat nie vir hulself kan praat nie. Gebede vir reën is broodnodig en ons moet ook onthou om vir ons regering en leiers te bid.

'n Positiewe gees en ingesteldheid is die een aspek wat 'n baie groot verskil in mense selewens kan maak; as opvoeders sien ons dit daagliks wanneer ons met kinders werk. Ons personeel maak 'n verskil met vriendelike woorde en aandag. Ses dae van die week sien ek hoe personeel geleenthede skep en die ekstra myl met ons kinders loop.

Wanneer ek sien hoe ouers die personeel ondersteun en begrip vir hulle toon, besef ek net weer die waarde van die Son laat Skyn en Skyn Helder vir Sunridge.

Die eksamen is nou klaar en ek moet personeel, ouers en kinders komplimenteer met die professionele wyse waarop dit hanteer is. Ons laatkommers was aansienlik minder en ek glo dat ons dit in die toekoms ook kan verwag.

## Sekuriteit

Ek het hierdie saak reeds in talle nuusbrieke aangespreek en versoek ouers vriendelik om asseblief hul samewerking te gee. Baie dankie aan die talle ouers wat dit reeds doen, maar ongelukkig is daar 'n paar ouers wat dit op blatante en aggressiewe wyse ignoreer.

Die vraag mag ontstaan waarom hierdie maatreëls dan nou ingestel word – die antwoord is eenvoudig dat dit nog altyd die reël was volgens die Skolewet, maar dat dit oor die jare verslap het. Die ongeluk is dat insidente met ernstige gevolge tans skole en kinders in Suid-Afrika teister.

Ons wil eerder pro-aktief wees voor enige incident ons wel dwing om dit te doen. Dit word die afgelope twee jaar herhaaldelik onder ons aandag gebring en ons het werklik rustig probeer om die gewoonte te verander.

Ons het 'n uiters produktiewe veiligheidsvergadering met die owerhede gehad, waar kommerwekkende aspekte bespreek en ons maatreëls ondersoek is.

Owerhede vind dit onrusbarend dat soveel ouers die skoolterrein betree om kinders af te laai of te haal. Hulle versoek dat hekke om 13:00 en 14:00 oopgesluit word, so kinders kan uitgaan maar nie vir iuers om in te kom nie. Hulle verstaan die bywoning van sport, maar gemeet aan ernstige insidente by skole verstaan ek dat ons veranderings moet aanbring. Ons sal dit stelselmatig begin doen en versoek weer eens vriendelik dat ons die gewoonte moet wysig.

Daar is gehamer op die feit dat ouers soveel verkeersprobleme veroorsaak en daar sal straks dramatiese veranderinge in die toekoms plaasvind. Wetstoepassers sal boetes in hierdie verband begin uitreik. **Bestuur en parkeer versigtig en gaan stadig met die handgebare.**

Hiermee in gedagte is ons verplig om 'n paar aanbevole maatreëls in plek te stel. Ek wil egter beklemtoon dat ouers hul kinders in gevaar stel wanneer hulle reëls en beleide ignoreer en dit sal ons verplig om selfs strenger beheermaatreëls in te stel.

Die kern van die saak is dat veiligheidsbeamptes ouers op hierdie stadium versoek om reëls te gehoorsaam, maar ons sal dalk binnekort maatreëls moet instel om dit af te dwing. Verkeer om die skool met 'n tekort aan behoorlike sypaadjies is 'n daadwerklike probleem wat ons met die nodige instansies sal opneem.

Ons het 'n oop kampus waar kinders van 08:00 tot 14:00 tussen klasse en blokke beweeg.

1. Ons beveel aan dat ouers by die hek stop en hul kind toelaat om op sy/haar eie tot by die klas of versamelpunt te stap.
2. Ons beveel aan dat ouers by die hekke vir hul kinders wag en nie na die geboue toe beweeg nie.
3. Bly te alle tye buite die geboue en weg van die klaskamers, aangesien dit nou vir die owerhede 'n groot kwelling word.

Kinders wat voor 06:30 by die skool afgelaai word, sal Hek 14 moet gebruik. Alle aflaaihekke sal slegs om 06:30 oopgesluit word. Die hekke sal in die toekoms weer stiptelik om 07:55, wanneer die eerste klok lui, gesluit word. Ons is nou amptelik op "Greenwich-tyd" en ons klok lui daarvolgens. Dit is raadsaam om 3 minute vroeër te wees, tydspeling is 'n realiteit en die elektroniese klok lui outomaties. Ons vergelyk wel die tyd twee keer per week met die rekenaartyd om binne 'n redelike tydverskil te bly. Ons weet dat dit nie in die verlede so was nie en kon met die nuwe stelsel dit nou aanspreek. Dankie vir u geduld in die verband.

Na 07:55 mag slegs die voorhek dan gebruik word en gereelde laatkommers sal volgens ons dissipline-beleid gedissiplineer word. Wees versigtig om nie in die middel van die pad te stop en af te laai nie, want owerhede het gewaarsku dat stewige boetes opgelê sal word.

Hekke sal slegs 2 minute voor uitkomtyd oopgesluit word en weer 15 minute nadat die klok gelui het, gesluit word. Ons sal hierdie tydraamwerk geleidelik instel en die tabel is daar vir u gerief. Ons verstaan as ouers inbeweeg en binne die onmiddellike omgewing van die hekke vir u kind wag. Die klem is egter op die onmiddellike omgewing en nie tusssen of naby die geboue nie.


