A very special thank you to everyone who worked with the PTA and Sunridge staff to ensure an extremely successful Sunshine Festival. Approximately 1 200 children enjoyed the day with us and it was our privilege to give them each something. The Sunridge team had everything cleared away by 15:00 and we were ready for the week ahead so we could continue with academic work. It is the second year where all available space was used for childrens' participation and it was a privilege to inaugurate the new Hockey Astro Turf (Die Rabiebaan) in a proper way. Thank you very much to everyone who contributed to the leaving of a legacy for the future. Once again I invite parents and friends to become a part of any of our projects and leave a legacy for others. Give something back to your school and for the future.

The incredibly positive comments about our school by visitors proved once again that we are on the right path. Ex-scholars and ex-parents agreed that we are moving forward and that we offer value for money. Not my words but still very pleasing to hear from so many people.

School bags: Gr 4 to 7

I have addressed this issue in the past and I have contacted other schools in this regard. Just to be sure I personally weighed some bags and it is amazing what children pack in their bags and how they pack it. We can also ascertain quite accurately what distance they have to walk. The average child does not walk far with his/her suitcase.

Children who have to walk long distances (bus children) to get to school set the example by packing strictly according to the timetable and in every grade we notice that planning plays a big role. Together with children who plan they represent the lowest counts. Of course a few chancers also came to light.

Gr 4 bags weigh between 3,12kg and 5,18kg if they pack according to the timetable. Injudicious packing brings the scale to a formidable 7,81kg.

Gr 5 bags weigh in at between 3,57kg and 5,95kg if they pack according to the timetable. Injudicious packing brings the scale to a massive 10,41kg.

Gr 6 bags weigh between 3,10kg and 5,55kg if they pack according to the timetable. Injudicious packing brings the scale to 8,80kg.

Gr 7 bags weigh between 3,56kg and 5,93kg if they pack according to the timetable. Injudicious packing brings the scale to a massive 12,63kg.

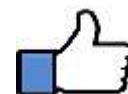
With approximately 2kg difference in all the grades I asked children to unpack the unnecessary items. The scale then easily falls within the 3 kg to 5 kg limit. When I focussed on bags and extras I found that the new school bags are much lighter than some brand name bags which weighed as heavy as 3,71 kg with nothing inside. Extras and huge pencil cases also make a difference. Add two x 750 ml water and it gets even worse. Free purified water is available at the school. Our Gr 6 learners are by far the most conservative packers and although it is a given that high school girls usually pack heavier it is definitely not the case with our average girl. Although a few strong young men in Gr 7 do not even consider the weight of their bags it is clear that the average child does not pack according to the timetable.

Teachers will remind children continuously to pack according to the timetable and we will also expect teachers to keep to the timetable.

'n Baie spesiale dankie aan een en elk wat hand gegee het om saam met die OOV en Sunridge-personeel van ons Son-skynefees weereens 'n reuse sukses te maak. Ongeveer 1200 kinders het die dag saam met ons geniet en dit was dan ook ons voorreg om aan elkeen van hulle ietsie te kon gee.

Die Sunridge-span het teen 15:00 alles opgeruim en ons skool was slaggeë vir 'n week waar akademie weereens ongestoord kon voortgaan. Dit is ons tweede jaar met die nuwe formaat waar ons alle spasie vir kinders se deelname gebruik en dit was dan ook 'n besondere voorreg om ons Astro-Hokkiebaan (Rabiebaan) op 'n gepaste wyse te kon open. Weereens dankie aan elkeen vir 'n bydrae om deel te wees aan die nalatenskap van 'n "legacy" vir die toekoms. Ek nooi weereens alle ouers en vriende uit om deel te raak van enige projek en sodoende u "legacy" vir ander te laat. Gee gerus so ietsie terug aan u skool en die toekoms.

Die ongelooflike positiewe kommentaar oor ons skool deur besoekers was weereens 'n bewys dat ons op die regte pad is. Oud-skoliere en oud-ouers was eenstemmend dat ons skool vorentoe beweeg en waarde vir geld bied. Beslis nie my woorde nie, maar besonders aangenaam dat soveel dit onder my aandag gebring het.

Skooltasse: Graad 4 tot 7

Ek het die aspek reeds in die verlede aangespreek en dan ook met ander skole in die verband geskakel. Net om seker te maak, het ek weer persoonlik tasse gaan weeg en dit is verstommend om te sien wat kinders inpak en hoe gepak kan word. Ons kan ook redelik akkuraat bepaal watter afstand gestap word. Ons deursnee kind stap nie baie ver met sy/haar tas nie.

Ons kinders wat langafstande moet stap (buskinders) om by die skool te kom, stel die voorbeeld en pak streng volgens hulle rooster en in elke graad kon ons sien dat beplanning 'n groot rol speel. Tesame met kinders wat beplan, verteenwoordig hulle die laagste lesings. Natuurlik was daar so 'n paar kansvatters wat ook uitgekom het.

Graad 4 tasse trek die skaal tussen 3,12kg en 5,18kg as hulle volgens die rooster pak. 'n Onoordeelkundige pakker laat die skaal op tot so swaar as 7,81kg kreun.

Graad 5 tasse trek die skaal tussen 3,57kg en 5,95kg as hulle volgens die rooster pak. 'n Onoordeelkundige pakker laat die skaal op tot so swaar as 10,41kg kreun.

Graad 6 tasse trek die skaal tussen 3,10kg en 5,55kg as hulle volgens die rooster pak. 'n Onoordeelkundige pakker laat die skaal op tot so swaar as 8,80kg kreun.

Graad 7 tasse trek die skaal tussen 3,56kg en 5,93kg as hulle volgens die rooster pak. 'n Onoordeelkundige pakker laat die skaal op tot so swaar as 12,63kg kreun.

Met 'n ongeveer 2kg interval by al die grade het ek kinders laat uitpak wat nie nodig is nie. Die skaal kom dan baie gemaklik binne die 3kg tot 5kg grens. As ek op tasse en ekstras fokus, is daar gevind dat die nuwe skooltasse baie ligter is as sommige "brand name"-tasse wat tot so swaar as 3,71kg op hulle eie weeg. Ekstras en uiters groot penbokse is ook nie baie vriendelik op die skaal nie. Sit twee 750ml bottels water by en dan raak dit rof. Gesuiwerde water is gratis by die skool beskikbaar. Ons graad 6-kindere pak verreweg die konserwatiefste en dat dogters in die hoërskool neig om swaarder te pak is dalk 'n gegewe, maar beslis nie die deursnee dogter by ons nie. Terwyl 'n paar sterk jongmense in graad 7 glad nie na gewig kyk nie, is dit duidelik dat die deursnee kind nie volgens die rooster pak nie.

Leerkragte sal deurlopend kinders daaraan herinner om volgens hulle roosters te pak en dan sal ons ook van leerkragte verwag om by die rooster te hou.

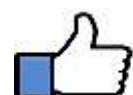

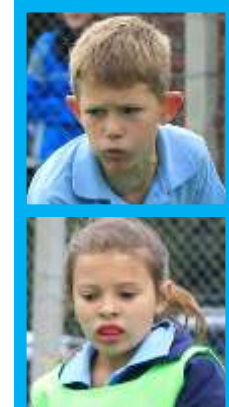
