

Geagte Ouers

Ons rig 'n vriendelike versoek aan ouers om nie suikerbelaaide kos en peuselhappies skool toe in te pak nie. Kinders ervaar 'n energiegolf en dit het 'n daadwerklike invloed op hul gedrag en akademiese prestasie.**

Ons snoepwinkel het opdrag gekry om nie hierdie tipe kos en koeldrank gedurende skoolure te verkoop nie en ons sal **gedurende die eksamen 'n spesiale inisiatief van stapel stuur om dit te monitor.** Ondersteun ons asseblief in die beste belang van u kind en dink mooi voordat u u kind se kosblik inpak.

Voorbereiding vir die eksamen moet in plek wees en ek glo **'n studierooster en goed beplande gesinstyd moet gebruik word om die beste resultate te lewer.** Ek begryp dat dit vir **werkende ouers 'n uitdaging kan wees, maar ek kan bevestig dat dit moontlik en haalbaar is.**

Ek wens elke huishouding die allerbeste toe, aangesien dit werklik belangrik is om u kind te ondersteun en opofferings te maak. Dear Parents

Following up on the service we deliver at Sunridge Primary School I need to thank our SGB for their planning and foresight to ensure we can deliver the quality service as we always do. The Department has cut our staff compliment once again - the norm of 1:36 is being enforced.

Irrespective of our appeals we are still left to deal with the challenge. I can assure you that it will be done in the best interest of all our learners.

I again want to put it out there that we need to thank the majority of our positive parents for paying school fees and making it possible. Comparing our school fees with schools delivering the same service and standard clearly shows that **we are actually 'cheap'. Should you be neglecting to fulfil these obligations, I kindly request you to do the right thing in the best interest of your child.**

The SGB finds it shocking to see how a few parents neglect to pay school fees, and try to bypass this obligation, while DSTV and other luxuries are paid and seen as essentials.

I do hope that these parents will reconsider this approach.

Sugar - this is a serious problem facing our children and a national initiative to cut down on it is not only essential but needs to be supported in the best interest of our children. We kindly request parents to refrain from packing sugar loaded food and snacks for school. Children get an energy rush and it drastically influences their behaviour and academic performance.

I have instructed our tuck-shop not to sell these types of food and cold drinks during school hours and we will have a special initiative during the exams to monitor it. Please support us in the best interest of your child and pay attention to what you pack in for break time.

Preparation for the exam should be in place and I believe a study time table and well planned family time should be enforced to ensure the best results. I understand that for **working parents this is a challenge but I can assure you it's possible and achievable.**

I wish each and every household all the best - it is truly important to support your child and make sacrifices. Mistakes will be made and in some cases expectations will not be met **but it's all part of learning. Please stay positive and calm during this time and enjoy the privilege of being able to write exams in a great environment.**




