Dear Parents

It's that time of the year again: budgeting for 2018 and preparing for the new academic year is a given at Sunridge. We do things well in advance and I have to thank our SGB for supporting us and helping to ensure we make decisions in the best interest of our school.

Looking and talking about finance always produce different opinions. Acting and having been a principal at four schools, representing a broad spectrum of society, changed my way of looking at it completely. Wherever you go, all parents want the best for their children and this is exactly the start of all positive or negative thoughts. Value for money and what service **delivery should be, differs from person to person. Putting the ever present "paying less for more" and the "for free" slogans** into the education system can only cause havoc.

I have learnt that nothing is "for free" and "paying less for more" will bite you in the end. I believe that no money can pay for good education but a good education cannot work without money. A teacher in front of a class and a class with the right number of learners costs money. With too many learners per class or a class without a properly trained educator, education will crumble. Losing a day of education is seldom caught up, substitute availability and planning is essential to prevent this and teacher absenteeism is a reality.

The condition of your facilities and keeping in touch with development and change is a reality that influences education. At Sunridge this is all positive and the delivery of education on all levels outperforms the average. With 95% of our parents and children being positive, we look forward to the future with a smile. We create the future and will leave a legacy for **generations to come. The opportunities for our children are endless and it's great to see and hear our children enjoying life to the full.**

Geagte Ouers

Dit is weer begrotingstyd en hier by Sunridge was ons druk besig om vir die 2018 akademiese jaar voor te berei. Ons doen dinge lank vooruit en ek wil graag ons SBL bedank vir hul ondersteuning en omdat hulle ons help om besluite in die beste belang van ons skool te neem.

Wanneer finansies ter sprake kom, is daar altyd uiteenlopende menings. Nadat ek as skoolhoof by vier skole, wat die breë **spektrum van die gemeenskap verteenwoordig, waargeneem en gewerk het, het my siening totaal verander. Waar 'n mens ook al gaan, wil ouers altyd die beste vir hul kinders hê en dit is dan ook die oorsprong van alle positiewe en negatiewe gedagtes. Waarde vir geld en die siening oor dienslewering verskil van persoon tot persoon. Die alomteenwoordige "betaal minder vir meer"- en "gratis"-slagspreuke binne die onderwysstelsel kan net chaos veroorsaak.**

Ek het geleer dat niks "gratis" is nie en "betaal minder vir meer" byt jou op die ou end aan die hakskeen. Ek glo dat geld nie vir goeie onderrig kan betaal nie, maar goeie onderrig kan nie sonder geld geskied nie. 'n Onderwyser voor 'n klas en die regte hoeveelheid leerlinge kos geld. Met te veel leerlinge per klas of sonder 'n behoorlik opgeleide opvoeder, sal die onderwys ten gronde gaan. 'n Verlore onderwysdag word selde ingehaal. Die beskikbaarheid van plaasvervangers en beplanning is noodsaaklik om dit te voorkom en onderwyserafwesigheid is 'n realiteit.

Die toestand van die fasiliteite en om tred te hou met ontwikkeling en verandering, is 'n realiteit wat onderrig beïnvloed. Hier by Sunridge is dit alles positief en die lewering van onderrig oorskadu die gemiddeld op alle vlakke. Met 95% **positiewe ouers en kinders gaan ons die toekoms met 'n glimlag tegemoet. Ons bou die toekoms en ons sal 'n nalatenskap agterlaat vir toekomstige geslagte.** Daar is eindelose geleenthede vir ons kinders en dit is wonderlik om te sien hoe hulle die lewe ten volle geniet.

Ouers uit ander provinsies wat hul kinders by ons inskryf, staan verstom omdat ons skoolfooie soveel minder is en hulle **soveel daarvoor kry. Hulle is baie tevrede dat hulle "waarde vir geld" kry by 'n skool waar hulle kinders voel dat mense vir hulle lief is en omgee.**

Ons ouerbegrotingsvergadering vind op 9 Oktober 2017 om 18:00 plaas en indien u die begroting vir 2018 wil besigtig, kan u dit elke weksdag van 28 Augustus 2017 tot 28 September 2017 tussen 07:00 en 13:30 by die skoolkantoor **doen. Ons publiseer 'n opsomming in aanstaande week se nuusbrief.**

My hartlike dank aan die personeel en SBL vir 'n uiters konserwatiewe begroting met 'n matige verhoging van slegs 7.3%, wat binne die laer raamwerk vir skole val.


