
Old Mutual 7's



FOCUS ON: Roneé le Roux

EARLY LIFE: I was born on the 11 February 1998. I was born in Kempton Park, Gauteng. I went to Summerwood Primary School. I did a lot of sport when I was younger. I did sprints, long jump, shot put, javelin, long distance running, swimming, netball and I played cricket with the boys' team up to the end of Primary School. I had to stop most of my sport in Grade 6 because I found out I had Marfan syndrome. I continued playing netball.

FAMILY Life: I have a twin brother, Johan. He is studying Logistics at NMMU. I have an older sister, Charine, 21 years old. She matriculated in 2014 because she had cancer in her matric year and couldn't graduate because she was sick at home most of the time. She is a beauty therapist and owns her own beauty salon, Philocaly Beauty Salon. She also has her own photography business, Charine's Photography. I am so proud of my brother and sister. My parents got divorced in 2010 (when I was in grade 6). I currently live with my mom. I see my dad now and then. My family means the world to me.

CAREER LIFE: I went to Summerwood Primary School and to Pearson High School. I matriculated in 2016 and obtained a Bachelors Pass. I have over 250 hours of childcare experience. I babysit in my free time and went to volunteer at Pre-Primary schools in Grades 11 and 12. I also did job shadowing at primary schools during that time. I am currently an Intern-Student at Sunridge and studying Foundation Phase Teaching through UNISA.

ACCOMPLISHMENTS: From Grade 2 - 6, I excelled immensely in my sport. I set records for sprinting, some of which are still standing. I represented EP in Grade 5 for sprints and relays. I stopped athletics due to medical conditions. In Grade 5 when I was 11 I played in the u/12A netball team. I received the "Best Junior Netball Player of the Year" award that year. In Grade 6 & 7 I played netball for the 1st team. I was a prefect in Grade 7. I was in the academic top 10 from Grade 4 - 7. In Grade 11 I received the "Player of the Year" award for netball, I was also asked to play in the 1st team but was not able to due to my health.

INTERESTING FACTS ABOUT YOURSELF: I had an aorta replacement in Cape Town in 2013 (when I was 15). I had to have the operation due to having an aortic aneurism. I had an aortic valve replacement in 2016 (when I was 18) due to my aortic valve enlarging due to the aortic aneurism. I now have a metallic valve that sounds like the ticking of a watch. My brother and I had the same classes and subjects for 11 out of the 12 years at school.




