

Geagte Ouers

Die toekoms is nou! Sunridge bou die toekoms deur middel van ons kinders. Vergifnis verander nie die verlede nie, maar dit verruim die toekoms.

Towerwoorde soos hallo, goeiemôre, dit is 'n plesier, ek is jammer, dankie en asseblief word alles by die huis aangeleer. Eerlikheid, respek, integriteit, deernis, betyds wees, simpatie betuig, om ywerig te wees en die grootste respek aan ouer mense en alle onderwysers te toon, kom ook van die huis af.

Die ouerhuis is waar kinders leer om skoon te wees, nie met die mond vol kos te praat nie, vullis weg te goo, georganiseerd te wees, besittings mooi op te pas en dat 'n mens nie aan ander mense vat nie.

Aan die ander kant ontvang hulle hier by die skool onderrig in tale, wiskunde, geskiedenis, aardrykskunde, wetenskap en liggaamsopvoeding. Ons is net veronderstel om die onderrig wat kinders by die huis ontvang, vas te lê!

Neem asseblief kennis:

1. Die gedragskode en skoolreëls is in die huiswerkboekie – een van die eerste goed wat elke jaar uitgedeel word.
2. Ons stuur slegs e-posse uit om huiswerk te bevestig wat in die eerste plek deur elke leerling afgeskryf behoort te word.
3. Die Suid-Afrikaanse Skolewet (SASA) maak die verantwoordelikheid van kinders en ouers in hierdie verband baie duidelik in Artikel 5 en 6. Ouers, in die Wet word die woord "**moet**" gebruik vir ouers
 - (a) "om die skool te ondersteun en vereis dat leerlinge alle skoolreëls en regulasies nakom en verantwoordelikheid vir enige wangedrag aanvaar;" en
 - (b) "om 'n aktiewe belangstelling in hul kinders se skoolwerk te toon en dit moontlik te maak vir kinders om hul huiswerk te voltooi."
4. Dit is 'n gewigte opdrag wat soms nie ernstig genoeg opgeneem word nie.
5. Ons hou by die reëls, beleide ens. wanneer ons sake ondersoek of ondersteuning gee terwyl ernstige aantygings teenoor personeel en die skool deur ouers gemaak word. In 99% van gevalle is dit sonder voldoende bewyse, be-troubare getuienis, gebaseer op hoorsê, eie opinie, ens.

Afknouery is 'n realiteit, maar om dit te bewys is soms moeilik, om tasbare bewyse te kry moet ons eers ondersoek instel. Dit neem tyd aangesien ons moet optree sonder om op kinders se grondwetlike regte inbreuk te maak.

Dit is waarom ons in sommige gevalle aanbeveel dat ouers by die polisiekantoor 'n klag teen die beweerde oortreder lê.

Laat vir skool: Dit is verontrustend om te sien dat dit vinnig 'n gewoonte word vir sommige leerlinge en ons sal dit moet bestuur. Die skool begin om 08:00 en wanneer 'n kind laat kom, word onderrig ontwrig. Laatkommers sal buite die klas moet wag, strafpunte sal opgelê word en dissiplinêre stappe sal volg. Ons is nie meer bereid om 'n klas wat reeds begin het, te ontwrig nie, of om waardevolle tyd te mors om die leerlinge te help opvang nie. Klaskamerdeure sal aan die begin van die periode toegemaak word en slegs aan die einde van die periode weer oopgemaak word. **Ons verstaan as 'n leerling een keer laat kom, maar 'n tweede of derde keer is onaanvaarbaar.**

E-posse, Whatsapps, boodskappe in huiswerkboekies ens., wat eise stel en dreig, val buite die SA-Skolewet. Ons verdraagsaamheid in hierdie verband bereik nou vinnig versadigingspunt.

Werk asseblief saam met die personeel en respekteer hulle ongeag wat, dit is die regte ding om te doen!

"Kom ons stem saam dat ons sal verskil—dit is die manier hoe ons dit doen wat saak maak. Moet asseblief nie die uitkoms probeer voorspel nie, maar volg die kanale. As ons met geduld en respek saamwerk, sal daar altyd 'n beter uitkoms wees, in 'n beter gees, opbouend en nie afbrekend nie..."

Dear Parents

The future is now! Sunridge is creating the future through our children. Forgiveness does not change the past but it does enlarge the future.

Magic words such as hello, good morning, you're welcome, I am sorry, please and thank you, all begin at home. Honesty, respect, integrity, compassion, to be on time, to show sympathy, to be diligent and to have the utmost respect for their elders and all teachers also comes from home.

Home is where children learn to be clean, not to talk with their mouths full, to dispose of garbage, to be organized, to take care of their belongings and that it's not ok to touch others.

Here at school, on the other hand, we teach languages, math, history, geography, sciences and physical education. We are supposed to only reinforce the education that children receive at home from their parents!

Let's see:

1. The code of conduct and school rules are in your homework book, one of the first things given out on a yearly basis.
2. We only support with e-mails to confirm homework which is supposed to be written down by every learner.
3. The South African Schools Act (SASA) is very clear in section 5 and 6 on the responsibility of children and parents in this regard. Parents, the Act uses the word "will" for parents to:
 - (a) "support the school, and require learners to observe all school rules and regulations and accept responsibility for any misbehaviour on their part"; and
 - (b) "take an active interest in their childrens' schoolwork and make it possible for the children to complete assigned homework"

This is a mouthful and sometimes taken too lightly.

4. We follow rules, policies, etc. when investigating matters or providing support, while serious allegations towards staff and the school are made by parents. In 99% of the cases they are without sufficient proof, reliable evidence, based on hearsay and own opinion, etc.
5. Bullying is a reality but to prove it is sometimes difficult; to obtain substantive evidence we need to investigate, this takes time as we need to act without violating childrens' constitutional rights.

That's why we recommend in some cases that parents lay a charge at the police station against the alleged perpetrator.

Late for school:

It is shocking to find that this is fast becoming a habit for some learners which we need to manage. School starts at 08:00 and being late disrupts education. Late comers will have to wait outside the class, face demerit points and disciplinary proceedings. We are no longer willing to disrupt a class which has already started and to waste valuable time while trying to get these learners to catch up. Classroom doors will close with the start of the period and only open at the end of it. We understand a once off late comer but a second and third time is not acceptable.

Demanding and threatening e-mails, Whatsapp's, messages in homework books, etc. is not within the SA Schools Act. Our tolerance in this regard is fast reaching the point it should never reach.

Please work with the staff and respect them irrespectively, it is the correct thing to do!

"Let's agree that we will disagree. It's the way we do it that matters, please do not dictate the outcome and follow the correct channels. Working together with patience and respect will always end with a better outcome and in a better spirit - building up and not breaking down."

5. If you could have any one superpower, which would you choose? To have an extra set of hands and eyes in the back of my head :)






