

Geagte Ouers

Ek het 'n paar oproepe van ouers gehad wat navraag doen oor die huidige toestand van onderrig en die negatiewe kwessies in hierdie verband. Dit beteken 'n mens** fokus op die probleem. As ons egter op die oplossings en die toekoms van kinders wat nog moet skoolgaan, fokus, sal ons meer waarde toevoeg. Dit is belangriker om waarde toe te voeg **en 'n nalatenskap agter te laat, as om daarop te fokus om ons** eie kinders deur hierdie moeilike tyd te kry.

Ek daag ouers met groot respek uit om deel van die oplossing te word. Dit begin daarby om u verantwoordelikhede teenoor Sunridge na te kom. Die eerste stap is om skoolfooie te betaal om volhoubaarheid en die lewering van gehalte-onderrig te verseker. Bottom line, it's all about attitude!




