Update on current projects at our school

Bathrooms

Unfortunately this takes time and we hope to be finished by the start of the second term. The courts itself was done under the normal maintenance budget as planned; this aspect is fine with normal weather and bird dropping damage falling within the service plan of the construction company.


Cricket Nets

Badkamers

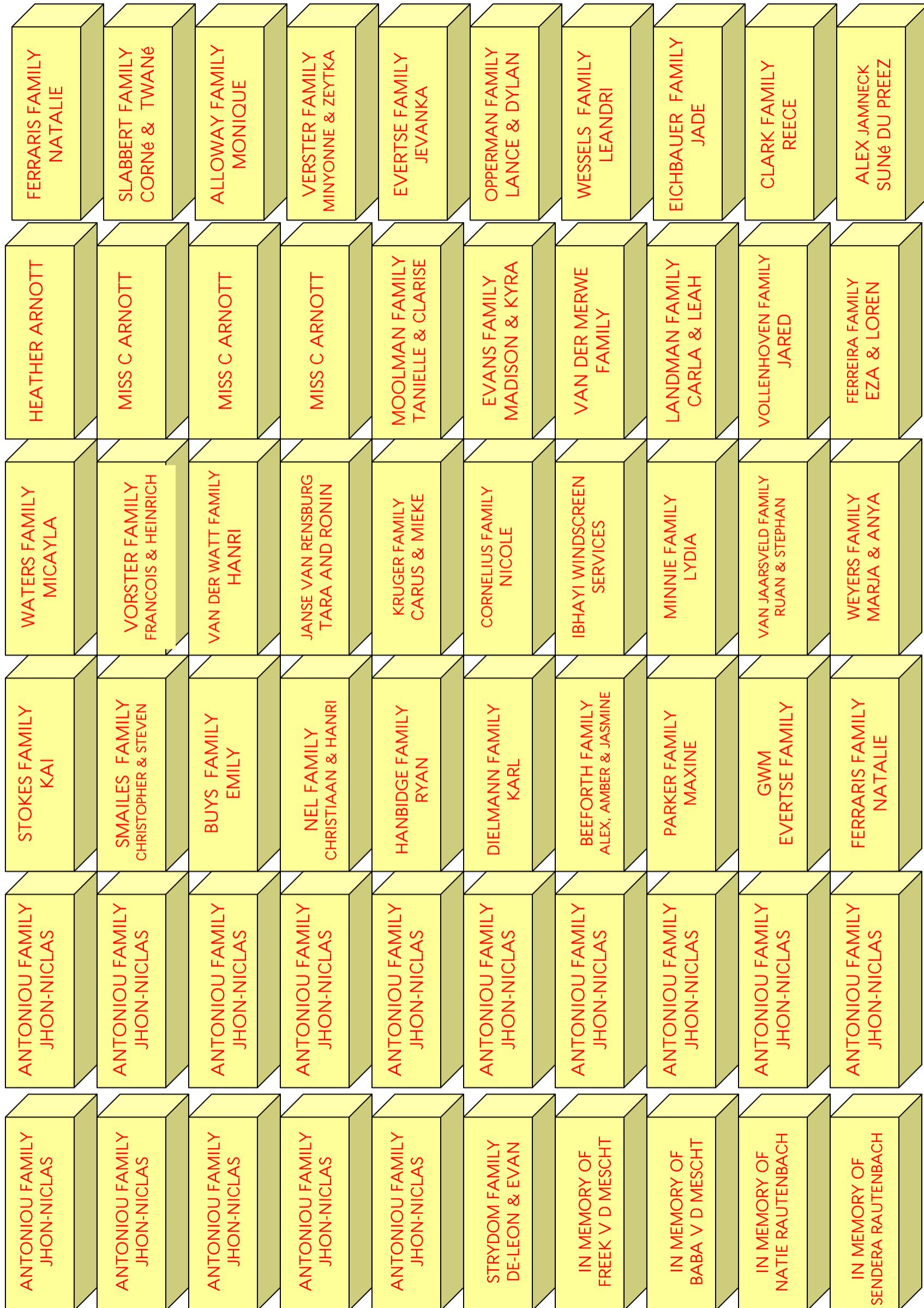
