Dear Parents

Reading in the newspapers about the 40% loss of class time due to educators not at work, makes me even more proud to be at Sunridge. It gives me great pleasure to inform you that over the past 4 years our teacher's average attendance is 98% (which includes all types of leave). The average loss of class time is less than 0,1% due to our very effective staff and risk management plans that are in place.

We are privileged to have dedicated staff which enables us to focus on effective teaching and planning for the future. Taking into consideration that our learners attendance averages 97% shows that we are a highly functional school delivering education on a different level.

The only real significance of this 40% loss of class time is that it unfairly questions the integrity of all teachers and lacks the critical aspect of putting the blame where it belongs - should it be a reliable study.

This however will not stop our hard work and we will continue to focus on the productive use of class time.

In my opinion we are looking at a much steeper climb to ensure our young upcoming teachers adopt and practice the same values as our more senior teachers. Respect, Integrity, Compassion and Honesty is not only seen differently but is under attack due to the influence of Social Media.

Should we take this aspect to our children we are left with a huge challenge to deal with in the future. We should never compromise our values!

The bottom line is that values need to be taught at home and that well-disciplined children are the direct result of what is being taught at home. All children are different and we understand the variety of challenges parents are facing but when we work together it becomes a team effort in the best interest of the child.

Our grade 4 to 7 children are looking forward to their scheduled outdoor education. This is an enormous undertaking arranged by staff to create opportunities for our children beyond the walls of the classroom. The classroom moves to the outdoors and they will be busy with education - for those who cannot join the tour, we continue with education on the same level and cover similar aspects and skills.

SGB by-election

We did not reach the 15% quorum needed at 07:00 on Monday, 28 August 2017 for the by-election meeting. Mr Gregg Richardson was nominated and we will now hold the meeting on Friday, 1 September 2017 at 07:00 in the School Hall at Sunridge Primary School. No quorum for voting required and the counting of the votes can then proceed.

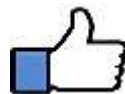

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Geagte Ouers

Toe ek in die koerant lees oor die verlies van 40% aan onderrigtyd vanweë onderwyserafwesigheid, was ek selfs meer trots op my verbintenis met Sunridge. Ek kan met genoeë verklaar dat ons onderwyserteenwoordigheid oor die afgelope 4 jaar 98% was, wat alle soorte verlof insluit. As gevolg van ons uiters doeltreffende personeelbestuur- en risikobestuurplanne wat in plek geplaas is, is die verlies aan onderrigtyd gemiddeld minder as 0,1%.

Ons is bevoorreg om oor 'n toegewyde personeel te beskik, terwyl ons op doeltreffende onderrig en beplanning vir die toekoms kan fokus.

Wanneer ons in ag neem dat ons leerlingteenwoordigheid gemiddeld 97% is, is dit duidelik dat ons 'n uiters funksionele skool het wat onderrig op 'n buitengewone vlak aanbied.

Die enigste werklike noemenswaardige betekenis van hierdie 40% verlies aan onderrigtyd, is dat dit die integriteit van alle onderwysers onregverdiglik bevraagteken en dat dit aan die kritiese aspek om die blaam te plaas waar dit in die geval van 'n betroubare ondersoek behoort te lê, ontbreek.

Dit sal ons egter nie verhoed om met die goeie werk voort te gaan en op die produktiewe benutting van onderrigtyd te fokus nie.

Na my mening het ons te kampe met 'n veel groter stryd, naamlik om jong ontwikkelende onderwysers te leer om dieselfde waardes as die meer senior onderwysers aan te neem en toe te pas. Respek, Integriteit, Deernis en Eerlikheid word nie net in 'n ander lig beskou nie, maar is ook in gevaar as gevolg van die invloed van Sosiale Media.

Indien ons hierdie aspek op ons kinders toepas, word ons in die toekoms deur 'n geweldige uitdaging in die gesig gestaar. Ons waardes moet altyd gehandhaaf word!

Die kern van die saak is dat waardes tuis aangeleer moet word en dat goed gedissiplineerde kinders die direkte resultaat is van waardes wat tuis aangeleer is. Alle kinders verskil en ons begryp die verskeie uitdagings waarmee ouers te kampe het, maar wanneer ons saamwerk, word dit 'n spanpoging in belang van die kind.

Ons Gr 4- tot 7-leerlinge sien uit na die buitelogopvoeding wat eersdaags plaasvind. Dit is 'n enorme taak wat deur personeel aangepak word om buiteloggeleenthede vir ons kinders buite die klaskamermure te skep. Die klaskamer beweeg buite-toe en die kinders sal met opvoeding besig wees. Diegene wat nie die toer kan meemaak nie, gaan op dieselfde vlak met onderrig voort en soortgelyke aspekte en vaardighede word behandel.

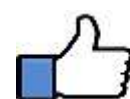
SBL-tussenverkiesing

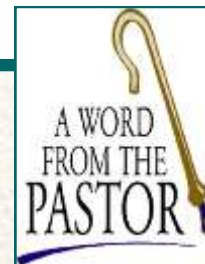
CAREER LIFE: I was a store controller at Nampak Polyfoil. I have worked in Receiving and Despatching, as a forklift driver, painting and maintenance.
