Dear Parents

It's also imperative to understand that it is a privilege to have staff still willing to undertake these tours in the best interest of our learners.

We wish them all the best with their tours and hope they enjoy it. Most staff have been doing this for a few years and they know how to deal with it. This is the time for parents to let go and trust your child and understand to let the staff take care of them on their terms.

In most cases the children cannot wait to get away and we experience how they strive to be left alone to enjoy their tour. Please remember it's their tour and let them be.

They will make contact when needed and it is amazing to see how they actually forget about mum and dad and all the instructions from home. Not something mum and dad take easily, but after so many years on tour I can assure you that they need the space and also your trust.

What a learning curve and unbelievable opportunity for our children and for parents. Our Grade 4's will also do a day trip while Grade 1 - 3 will step up the academic work while enjoying the school for themselves.

Rather follow the SMS' coming from the tour and only phone in an emergency.

While on the topic, cell phones are a powerful tool putting children under your ID in contact with the world. When last did you check your child's phone for possible dangers such as bullying, verbal abuse, insensitive remarks, unsafe sites and many more. Facebook, Twitter, etc. and just to be sure their access to DSTV and age restricted programmes or movies.

We were informed by an attorney, with four degrees, who specializes in Social Media Law that it is our responsibility as parents as to what our children say and do on this platform. A friendly word of advice to please check and inform your child on the must and must not's. This is your responsibility as a Social Media footprint cannot be erased.

Just a reminder that reports will only be handed out to the children on the last day of school this term - 29 September 2017 at 10:45. We continue till the last day of school and no early holidays please. The school will close at 11:00.

Hierdie is 'n uitstekende geleentheid vir ons kinders en ouers om ervaring op te doen.

Ons Gr 4's sal op 'n daguitstappie gaan en terselfdertyd kan Gr 1 tot 3 die krane op akademiese gebied oopdraai terwyl die skool vir 'n rukkie net aan hulle behoort.

Selfone is 'n magtige wapen wat u kind met behulp van u ID in kontak met die wêreld plaas. Wanneer laas het u saam met u kind na sy/haar foon gekyk vir moontlike gevare soos boelie, verbale mishandeling, onsensitiewe aanmerkings, onveilige webtuistes en vele meer, Facebook, Twitter, ens. en net om seker te wees toegang tot DSTV en programme of fliks met ouderdomsbepelings.

'n Prokureur met vier grade, wat spesialiseer in Sosiale Media-wetgewing, het ons ingelig oor ons verantwoordelikheid as ouers met betrekking tot wat ons kinders op hierdie platform sê en doen. 'n Woordjie van raad – maak asseblief seker dat u u kind inlig aangaande die moets en moenies. Dit is u verantwoordelikheid, aangesien 'n Sosiale Media-voetspoor nie uitgewis kan word nie.

Ons wil u net herinner dat rapporte om 10:45 op die laaste skooldag - 29 September 2017 – aan die kinders uitgedeel sal word. Ons onderrig tot die laaste skooldag, dus asseblief geen vroeë vakansie nie. Die skool sluit om 11:00.

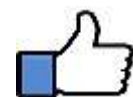

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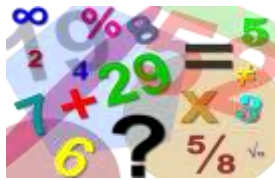
