Our children are growing up in a technology advanced era and they are seemingly unable to live without it. Parents are quick to join them and our social media Footprint is spreading fast without us even being aware of the impact.

What's been said, published or shared remains there for a very long time. The "Del" button or erase option does unfortunately not work as we think it does. The speed at which this medium spreads this information and where it ends up and stored is mind boggling. This is a given but what's even more astonishing is what people and children are willing to say and how they are saying it on social media.

Should you look carefully at where and when our children and parents use cell phones you will be stunned. We have been hijacked by a device accompanying us all over and controlling our lives on many levels. A little box at your front door for all cell phones to be deposited into on entering your home will reveal the impact.

Without taking away any privacy I believe that it is imperative that parents should monitor not only the use but also the "what" is said, looked at or forwarded on the phone. Should you look at what is received even I am shocked to find what people are willing to forward to me. After sending "delete" does not work. As info travels and your cell number, e-mail, whatsapp, facebook, twitter, etc. are spreading so does the risk of others bombarding you with unwanted offers, calls, clips, etc. It's also here our children get "stuff" we would not actually want them to be exposed to.

The truth is that even on the trusted children's channels on DSTV this "stuff" reaches our children and I would not even try to establish how many children have free access to all DSTV channels. Trust is essential but a child will always be a child and discovering or exploring is a given.

I understand the fact that they need to be kept busy while parents still have to cook, work, etc. at the end of the day. Sorry to say, but you will reap what you sow. Carefully choose how and what you sow, we all make mistakes but minimizing them is essential.

Cook together, work at home together, watch TV together, play together and basically live together might seem far-fetched but it's essential. If not possible then ensure you know exactly what they are doing, watching and playing. Talking to your child and knowing him or her is the key. 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Geagte Ouers

Die beloofde opvolg op sosiale media en ander verwante sake is die vernaamste onderwerp vir die week, aangesien dit 'n immer toenemende bedreiging blyk te wees sonder dat ouers eers daarvan bewus is.

Ons kinders lewe in 'n tegnologies gevorderde era en dit lyk asof hulle nie daarsonder kan lewe nie. Ouers is vinnig besig om by hulle aan te sluit en ons sosiale media-voetspoor brei vinnig uit sonder dat ons eers die uitwerking daarvan besef.

Wat gesê, gepubliseer of gedeel word, bly daar vir 'n baie lang tyd. Die "Del"-knoppie of uitwis-opsie werk ongelukkig nie so goed soos ons glo dit doen nie. Die verspreiding van inligting op hierdie medium en waar dit eindig en geberg word, is verbysterend. Dit is 'n gegewe, maar wat selfs meer verbasend is, is wat mense bereid is om te sê en hoe hulle dit op sosiale media sê.

U sal verstom wees om te sien hoe en waar ons kinders en ouers hul selfone gebruik. Ons is gekaap deur 'n toestel wat oral saam met ons gaan en ons lewens op vele vlakke beheer. 'n Klein kissie by u voordeur waar selfone gelaat moet word wanneer iemand binnekom, sal die impak duidelik maak.

Sonder om privaatheid in te boet, glo ek dit is gebiedend noodsaaklik dat ouers nie net die gebruik van selfone monitor nie, maar ook wat gesê, waarna gekyk en wat aangestuur word. Wanneer 'n mens kyk na wat ontvang word, is selfs ek soms geskok oor wat mense bereid is om na my aan te stuur. "Delete" is nie meer 'n opsie wanneer iets gestuur is nie. Soos inligting gedeel word en jou selnr., e-posadres, Whatsapp, Facebook, Twitter, ens. bekend gemaak word, is daar die risiko dat mense jou gaan bombardeer met ongewenste aanbiedings, oproepe, beelde ens. Dit is ook hier dat ons kinders blootgestel word aan ongewenste materiaal.

Die waarheid is dat selfs die betroubare kinderkanale op DSTV ongewenste beeldmateriaal uitsaai en ek wil nie eers weet hoeveel kinders onbeperkte toegang tot alle DSTV-kanale het nie. Dit is noodsaaklik om u kind te vertrou, maar die feit is dat 'n kind altyd 'n kind sal wees en dat hulle beslis nuuskierig is.

Ek verstaan dat kinders besig gehou moet word terwyl ouers kos maak, werk, ens. aan die einde van die dag. Ongelukkig sal 'n mens maai wat jy saai. Wees versigtig met hoe en wat u saai – ons almal maak foute, maar dit is noodsaaklik om die foute tot die minimum te beperk.

Dit is belangrik om saam kos te maak, te werk, TV te kyk, te speel en saam te leef. Indien dit nie alles moontlik is nie, moet u tog seker maak dat u weet presies wat hulle doen en kyk en watter speletjies hulle speel. Die antwoord is om met u kind te gesels en hom of haar te ken. U sal dalk verbaas wees oor hoe min u regtig weet, of indien nie, is u dalk een stappie vooruit en goed op hoogte.

Hier by die skool weet ons soms meer, want ons sien hulle groepsgedrag, ons ervaar hulle op 'n manier wat u nie gewoonlik doen nie en ons sien hulle vir meer as ses ure wanneer hulle wakker, aktief en aan die gang is.




