Dear Parents,

We are very proud of our under 13A netball team who won the Eastern Cape Championships and will represent our province at the National School Championships for Primary Schools. We are looking forward to seeing them play at National level and we believe they have grown since the Wildeklaar tournament. Go Girls!

We have brought the dangers of social media to the attention of all parents; we recognize the advantages and possibilities it has but again need to point out that the responsibility to ensure it is used appropriately lies with you as parents.

It is within the same environment of change that an old phenomenon materializes. We refer to children acting outside the code of conduct, making up stories, adding to something and jumping to conclusions. This ends up with the blame being put on other learners, staff and eventually the school. After 30 years in education it is still the same and we need as adults, to carefully sift through this and, with respect, ensure we get behind the truth. My side, your side and then the truth!

This sometimes takes time to establish, as what is urgent for one is number 101 on the list at school. That is why it is important to follow the correct channels and to understand that it all takes time. The other old story is that people want to dictate the outcome. This will not happen and threats like "do you know who I am?" or "I'll report you" do absolutely nothing to support us.

Ultimately the child's behaviour is the parent's responsibility and SASA is very clear on this. Although we try to educate and deal with the day to day matters it is fast becoming an issue of which parents need to be aware. Discipline comes from home and is an essential part of parenthood.

We understand that both parents work long hours and try not to have negative aspects influencing their short time available at home with their children. They brand it the millennium parent issue. This is, however, of no advantage to the child and eventually causes more problems than you may imagine. Not easy to accept, and denial is plausible. Unfortunately it is a reality and we all need to support discipline as it essential to the well being of our children.

We are not blind to our mistakes nor to the mistakes our children and parents make. In the majority of cases we find that the old excuses of the "wrong story", an "honest mistake" or a matter of "perception" are the main enemies of discipline.

Let us again agree to disagree but let us do so with respect. Our children are precious but never allow them to try and catch us out by using one of the oldest tricks in the book - to play us adults off against each other.

Geagte Ouers

Ons is baie trots op ons O/13A-netbalspan wat die Oos-Kaap-kampioenskap gewen het en ons provinsie by die nasionale skoolkampioenskap vir laerskole gaan verteenwoordig. Ons sien daarna uit om hulle op nasionale vlak te sien speel en ons glo dat hul spel heelwat sedert die Wildeklawer-toernooi verbeter het. Staan sterk, Dames!

Ons het reeds die gevare van sosiale media onder die aandag van alle ouers gebring. Hoewel ons die voordele en moontlikhede daarvan wel deeglik besef, moet ons u net weer daarop wys dat dit die ouers se verantwoordelikheid is om te verseker dat sosiale media korrek gebruik word.

Terwyl die winde van verandering waai, is daar 'n verskynsel uit die verlede wat kop uitsteek. Ons verwys na kinders wat buite die gedragskode optree, stories versin, oordryf en hul eie gevolgtrekkings maak. Dan word die blaam op ander leerlinge, personeel en uiteindelik die skool geplaas. Ná 30 jaar in die onderwys bly dit steeds dieselfde – ons as volwassenes moet die saak versigtig en met respek ondersoek en seker maak ons kom agter die kap van die byl. My kant, die ander kant en dan die waarheid!

Dit neem tyd om agter die waarheid te kom en wat vir een persoon die hoogste prioriteit is, is dalk nommer 101 op die skool se lys. Dit is waarom dit so belangrik is om kanale te volg en om te begryp dat dit alles tyd verg. Dan is daar ook mense wat die uitkoms wil vooruitloop. Dit sal nie gebeur nie en dreigemente soos “weet jy wie ek is” of “ek sal jou rapporteer” doen absoluut niks om ons te ondersteun nie.

Uiteindelik is die kind se gedrag die ouer se verantwoordelikheid en die SASW is baie duidelik hieroor. Alhoewel ons onderlig probeer gee en die daaglikse probleme die hoof bied, word dit nou vinnig iets waarvan ouers bewus gemaak moet word. **Dissipline begin tuis en is 'n integrale deel van ouerskap.**

Ons het begrip daarvoor dat albei ouers lang ure wek en nie graag wil hê dat negatiewe aangeleenthede 'n wolk moet gooi oor die kort tydjie wat hulle met kinders deurbring nie. Dit word die millenniumouer-verskynsel genoem, maar ongelukkig is dit nie tot die kind se voordeel nie en veroorsaak dit uiteindelik meer probleme as wat 'n mens jou kan indink. Dit is nie maklik om te aanvaar nie en ouers kan dit dalk ontken, maar dit is ongelukkig 'n werklikheid en ons moet dissipline ten alle koste ondersteun, aangesien dit noodsaaklik is vir die welstand van ons kinders.

Ons weet dat ons wel foute begaan, maar terselfdertyd is ons ook nie blind vir die foute wat ons kinders en ouers begaan nie. In die meeste gevalle is dit duidelik dat verskonings soos “verkeerde feite”, “fout begaan” en “'n geval van persepsie” die vernaamste vyand van dissipline is.

Kom ons stem saam dat ons sal verskil, maar kom ons doen dit met respek en as volwassenes. Moet nooit toelaat dat 'n kind een van die oudste streke uithaal en ons as volwassenes teen mekaar uitspeel nie – daarvoor is ons kinders te kosbaar.

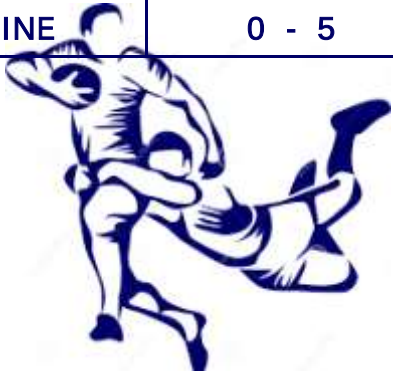
