Application forms can be collected from the office and will close on 12 March 2018. Within 24 hours 151 application forms had been collected and we look forward to processing all applications in due time. Our aim is to ensure we finalize the process asap.

Even with the drought our facilities are neat and well-kept while keeping a balance between new developments and maintaining the current resources. As we previously invited all parents to be part of leaving a legacy I can never ignore the obligation to constantly remind all children and parents about it.

Since 2013 major changes were undertaken on all levels of our school. We created more opportunities on academic, sport and cultural levels than ever before while balancing it carefully to ensure continued availability. With our cultural and sport sections competing on provincial and national levels our academics never stayed behind and also joined in on these levels.

With our staff and learner attendance well over 97% for 2017 and a pass rate of 99,7% we still believe that there is room for even more improvement. It is not about a pass rate but rather about preparing all our learners to cope with all aspects of life on a higher level when leaving Sunridge.

With this in mind it is the “positive” legacy we try to achieve and which we demand because it will make the difference. You are granted only one life and living it to the full is not an option but a no brainer. We only spend time on what we can change; leaving a legacy at our school is something you can be part of. 51 Jaar van Bou aan die Toekoms

Die toekomstige geslag sluit binnekort by ons aan op ‘n reis na uitnemendheid. Ons huidige Gr 1-leerlinge is volstoom aan die gang en terwyl ons uitdagings op vele verskillende fronte moet trotseer, maak ek graag bekend dat aansoek vir Gr 1 2019 op 12 Februarie 2018 oopgemaak het.

Vorms is by die kantoor beskikbaar en die sluitingsdatum is 12 Maart 2018. Die eerste 151 aansoekvorms is binne 24 uur afgehaal en ons sien daarna uit om binnekort deur al die dokumente te werk. Ons doelwit is om die proses so gou moontlik te finaliseer.

Selfs te midde van die droogte lyk ons fasiliteite netjies en **goed versorg, terwyl ons ‘n balans handhaaf tussen nuwe ontwikkelings en die instandhouding van huidige bronse.** Aangesien ons ouers reeds voorheen genoeg het om deel te **word van die proses om ‘n nalatenskap agter te laat, kan ek nie die verpligting ignoreer om ouers en kinders voortdurend daaraan te herinner nie.**

Grootse veranderinge het sedert 2013 op alle vlakke van ons skool plaasgevind. Ons het meer as ooit tevore geleenthede op akademiese, sport- en kultuurgebied geskep, **terwyl ons ‘n balans handhaaf om voortdurende beskikbaarheid te verseker.** Ons kultuur- en sportafdelings ding op provinsiale en nasionalevlak mee en terselfdertyd het die akademiese program nie agtergelyk nie en het ook al hierdie vlakke bereik.

Met ons personeel- en leerlingaanwesigheid op meer as **97% vir 2017 en ‘n slaagsyfer van 99,7%, glo ons steeds** dat daar ruimte vir verbetering is. Die slaagsyfer is nie ons prioriteit nie, maar wel om ons leerlinge voor te berei om alle aspekte van die lewe op hoëvlak die hoof te kan bied wanneer hulle Sunridge verlaat.

Hiermee in gedagte is dit die “positiewe” nalatenskap waarna ons streef en wat ons vereis omdat dit die verskil maak. **‘n Mens leef net een keer en om voluit te lewe is nie ‘n opsie nie, maar ‘n gegewe. Ons bestee slegs tyd aan dit wat ons kan verander; om ‘n nalatenskap aan ons skool agter te laat, is iets waarvan ons almal deel kan wees. Wat het u **vandag vir u skool gedoen?** Hetsy dit ‘n gebed is of miskien ‘n positiewe woordjie van aanmoediging, dit sal ‘n verskil maak en dit sal ‘n nalatenskap agterlaat.**

Mense floreer op negativiteit, daarom daag ek alle ouers uit om u kinders en ons skoolgemeenskap met u positiewe ingesteldheid te beïnvloed en om positief te lewe. Dit sal nie maklik of interessant wees nie en dit sal ook nie deur ander **aanvaar word nie, maar ek kan u verseker dat dit ‘n verskil** sal maak en dat u dit sal voel!

Om helder te skyn vir Sunridge terwyl ‘n positiewe nalatenskap agterlaat word, is alles deel van 51 jaar van saamgroei.


