Ons het beleide in plek by die skool wat enige persoon verbied om die skool gedurende skoolure binne te kom. Met die beleid probeer ons dieselfde doen met ons geboue ná skoolure. Ongelukkig is daar sommige ouers en nasorgdames wat ons **reëls en beleide ignoreer. U sal gekonfronteer word wanneer u reëls oortree en moet asseblief nie 'n vriendelike oproep verwag nie**. As u geen respek vir ons reëls/beleide toon nie, sal dit na u terugkeer.

Dit is 'n feit dat ons verskillende menings sal hê, maar dit is hoe ons sake hanteer wat saak maak. Op sosiale media is niks vertroulik nie en toe die ouers dit met ons gedeel het, was ons verstom oor die voorbeeld wat gestel word. Soos voorheen genoem, is dit 'n tydbom wat vroeër of later buite beheer gaan ontploff.


LOOPBAAN: Ek het gematrikuleer in 2017 by Framesby en studeer tans by Unisa en is besig met 'n internskap by Sunridge.




