



Geagte Owers,

Ons sien baie uit na ons Derbydag teen Westering Primêre Skool eerskomende naweek. Dit is steeds ons doel om geleenthede te skep en ons stuur soveel moontlik spanne op die veld as wat ons gasheer kan akmommodeer.

Ons het ouers reeds voorheen per brief herinner aan die belangrikheid daarvan om binne 'n gedragskode op te tree wanneer hulle hul kinders by buitemurse bedrywighede ondersteun. Ons het begrip daarvoor dat baie ouers nie die nuusbrief lees nie, maar dit is nie 'n verskoning nie by die reëls te hou nie. Sommige skole het reeds buitemurse bedrywighede opgeskort as gevolg van die ondersteuners se gedrag. Dit word nou 'n kwessie wat die beskikbaarheid van sportkodes kan beïnvloed, aangesien afrigters/skeidsregters sal weier om deur ondersteuners geboelie te word.

Ons het almal verskillende menings en ons glo miskien dat ons 'n beter afrigator sal wees of 'n ander speler sou kies en miskien sou u meer sukses behaal het. Dit is alles goed en wel, maar terwyl u nie die afrigator is nie, mag u nie immeng nie en moet u die afrigator se besluit respekteer, selfs al stem u nie saam nie.

Dit is die afrigator se voorreg om spelers vir 'n span te kies, 'n speler uit 'n span weg te laat, 'n speler gedurende 'n wedstryd te vervang, te besluit wie die speler van die wedstryd is en alles wat daarmee gepaard gaan. Ongeag wie ons is of watter prestasies ons behaal het, ons het geen reg om in te meng nie.

Ondersteuning langs die speelveld moet ook positief wees en moet die spelers en afrigters onderskraag. Afrigting vind voor 'n wedstryd plaas, nie gedurende 'n wedstryd nie. Opdragte kom van die afrigator gedurende 'n wedstryd en nie van ondersteuners nie. Ons is op die punt om alle ondersteuners tot 'n pawiljoen of toegewyde deel van die veld/baan te beperk. Help ons asseblief om dit te verhoed deur by die reëls en gedragskode wat aan u gestuur is, te hou. Miskien is dit ook nou die tyd vir ondersteuners wat by die reëls hou, om die saak te bespreek met diegene wat dit nie doen nie. Daar is alreeds 'n reël in plek geplaas wat ondersteuners tot 5 meter van die kantlyn beperk, asook dat 'n ondersteuner wat negatiewe kommentaar lewer, gevra kan word om die terrein te verlaat. Strafmaatreëls kan teen sodanige ondersteuner ingestel word en hy/sy kan verbied word om die skoolterrein te betree. Dink asseblief voordat u kommentaar lewer en bly liewer stil as u nie iets positiiefs kan sê nie.

Ons het met Gr 3- tot 7-leerlinge gesels oor die speel van werklikheidspeletjies: waagspeletjies, fisiese en verbale speletjies en wie weet wat nog? Dit gebeur omdat u kind daaraan blootgestel word d.m.v. 'n onbeperkte sosiale media-wêreld. U sal verstom wees om te sien hoe hulle speel — **hulle gil, wys vingers, gryp mekaar en stoei fisies met 'n verbale aanval** terwyl ondersteuners hulle aanmoedig — ons was absoluut stomgeslaan.

Ons het leerlinge in kennis gestel dat alle fisiese of verbale speletjies van hierdie aard verbode is en ook dat personeellede en prefekte aan diens dit onmiddellik moet anmeld. Die **verskoning dat hulle nie 'n personeellid of prefek kon sien nie, is nie geldig nie. Hulle is beskikbaar en met 87 volwassenes wat op enige stadium op die Sunridge-terrein werk, is dit 'n koers van 12:1.**

Dit is uiterst belangrik dat die saak onmiddellik aangemeld word, sodat die proses in werking gestel kan word om ondersoek in te stel en te bepaal watter stappe geneem moet word. Die **uitkoms moet nooit voorgeskryf word nie en met 'n uiters bekware SBS word 99% van sake blitsvinnig opgelos.** Wanneer sake laat aangemeld word, word die ondersoek in gevaar gestel en weergawes is geneig om te verskil. Dit is die weergawes van verskillende leerlinge en **soms ouers wat in hierdie gevalle te veel verskil om tot 'n verantwoordelike en billike gevolgtrekking te kom.** Die weergawe wat aan ouers voorgehou en dan aan die skool gekommunikieer word, skep selfs meer probleme.

Ons werk met kinders en ongeag wie wat sê, het ons ná meer as 30 jaar in die onderwys **geleer dat alle kwessies drie kante het. Ons moet al drie aspekte ondersoek en tot 'n gevolgtrekking kom terwyl dit nie altyd duidelik is wat die waarheid is nie.** Dit moet regverdig **wees teenoor alle betrokke partye en die enigste manier om dit te bereik, is om 'n onbekende persoon te kry om die saak uit te sorteer.** Dit is tydwend en moet buite kontaktyd geskied, nadat emosies bedaar het — en die uitkoms sal nie almal tevrede stel nie. Volg asseblief die kanale en respekteer die onderwyser wat die saak ondersoek. Hy of sy kan **slegs 'n oordeel vel wanneer alle getuenis in oorweging geneem is.**

Dear Parents,

We look forward to our Derby Day against Westering Primary School this coming weekend. Again the purpose is to create opportunities and we include as many teams as our hosts can accommodate.

We have previously communicated to all parents the importance of acting within a code of conduct when supporting your child in extra mural activities. Some schools have stopped providing this essential service due to the behaviour of supporters. This is fast becoming an issue which will influence the availability of sport codes due to coaches/referees refusing to be bullied by supporters. We understand that many parents do not read the newsletters but that will, however, not excuse them from complying.

We all have different opinions and sometimes believe that we could coach better or select a different player and maybe, be more successful. That is all well and good, but while you are not the coach you may not interfere and must respect the decision of the coach, even if you disagree.

It is the coach's prerogative to select players for a team, drop a player from a team, to substitute a player during a match, to decide on the player of the match and whatever comes with the territory. Irrespective of who we are or what we might have achieved it is not within our right to interfere.

Supporting next to the field of play should also be positive and in support of the players and coaches. Coaching is done before a match and should not be done during a match. Instructions come from the coach during the match and not from supporters. We are very close to a point where all supporters will be confined to a pavilion or dedicated section of a field/court. Please help us and stay within the rules and code of conduct as sent to you so as to prevent this. Perhaps it is also time for supporters who comply to address the matter **with those who don't. The rule is already in place that supporters must be 5 meters away** from the touch line and that a supporter making negative comments can be asked to leave the premises. Such a supporter can be sanctioned and prohibited from entering a schools premises. Please think before you make a comment and rather say nothing if it is not positive.

We have spoken to the Grade 3 - 7 learners on the playing of reality games, dare games, physical and verbal games and who knows what else? This happens because your child is exposed to these via an unlimited social media world. Watching them play would shock most of you; screaming, pointing fingers, grabbing one another, and physically wrestling with a verbal attack while supporters cheer them on - we were absolutely dumbstruck.

We have informed learners that all physical or verbal games of this nature are forbidden and that staff and prefects are on duty and that it must be reported immediately. The excuse that they could not see or find a staff member or prefect is not valid. They are available and with 87 adults on the Sunridge premises at any stage, it's a mere 12:1 ratio.

It is most important to report the matter immediately so that the process can be put in place to investigate and determine what action should be taken. The outcome is never to be dictated and with a very competent SMT, 99% of all cases are swiftly resolved. When cases are reported late, the investigation is compromised and versions tend to vary. It is these different versions from learners and sometimes parents which differ too much to make a responsible and fair conclusion. The version told to parents and then communicated to the school creates even more problems.

We work with children and irrespective of who said what, after more than 30 years in education we have learnt that all issues have three sides. We need to look at all three sides, investigate and come to a conclusion, even though the truth is not always clear. It needs to be fair to all concerned and the only way to do this is to have someone without any conflict of interest to deal with it. This takes time and has to be dealt with outside contact time and allowing for emotions to calm down - and the outcome will not please all. Please follow the correct channels and respect the teacher investigating the case. They can only pass judgement once all the evidence has been taken into consideration.




