



Dear Parents,

"I think parenting is the most important job in the world." – Dr Ben Carson

Godwin Khosa of NECT made the comment that they know that the children who are most likely to be successful at school are those who are supported by their parents and caregivers. You need knowledge and skills in order to provide support for your child's schooling.

This starts by building trust, encouraging your child, communicating with him/her, showing that you care, building a learning environment at home and by getting involved in your child's life.

Hovering over your child and controlling your child's life is not the answer. Supporting wrong doing and questioning the teacher or school will not help either. Your child must take responsibility for their actions and learn to deal with challenges while knowing you love them unconditionally.

At school we deal with all aspects and we never condemn any learner. The outcome on matters is not always what parents want but represent the educational solution and decision.

Teachers are bound by a code of conduct from SACE, the professional education body. SGB members are also bound by a code of conduct as prescribed. Working with schools, DOE and SGB's we are now in the process of finalizing a code of conduct for parents.

DRAFT CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PARENTS

1. To conduct ourselves in a way that does not harm the school's reputation or embarrass staff members or learners.
2. To not exhibit disruptive behaviour which interferes or threatens to interfere with the operation of a classroom, an employee's office, office area or any other area of the school grounds, including team matches.
3. The use of loud and/or offensive language, swearing, cursing, using profane language or displaying temper is prohibited.
4. To not threaten to do actual bodily harm to a member of the school staff, Principal, visitor, fellow parent/carer or learner, regardless of whether or not the behaviour constitutes a criminal offence.
5. To not make use of abusive or threatening e-mails or text/voicemail/phone messages or other written communication.
6. To not make use of defamatory, offensive or derogatory comments regarding the school or any of the learners/parents/staff at the school on Facebook or other social media sites. Any concerns that I have must be made through the appropriate channels by speaking to the grade teacher, HOD, Deputy Principal, so they can be dealt with fairly, appropriately and effectively for all concerned.
7. That the use of physical aggression towards another adult or child is prohibited. This includes physical punishment against my own child on school premises.
8. That I may not approach someone else's child in order to speak to them or chastise them because of the actions of this child towards my own child. (Such an approach to a child may be seen to be an assault on that child and may have legal consequences).
9. To apply self-restraint and show respect, courtesy and tolerance towards each other, educators, learners, fellow spectators, coaches, referees, judges and opponents.
10. To not intimidate educators, participants, coaches, referees or judges.
11. To conduct ourselves in accordance with the code of ethics required by a particular cultural activity or sporting code.
12. That physical violence, defamatory and offensive language or indecent signs during sport matches or other activities is strictly prohibited.
13. To refrain from making negative remarks or using improper language when interacting with referees, other officials, judges, players or their opponents' supporters.
14. When attending any school activity we shall comply with the requests and arrangements of the school concerned and/or the organizers.
15. That the use of alcohol and illegal drugs during any school activity is strictly prohibited.
16. That no weapons or dangerous objects may be brought onto the school grounds, unless intended for official work purposes, such as in the case of SAPS officers.
17. That parents may only smoke in the designated smoking areas, and only if this does not interfere with the learners' education or activities. Consult the school's smoking policy, which stipulates the designated smoking areas.
18. That parents, supporters and spectators are requested to maintain the indicated distance from the side lines of any particular sports field or court, and not go into the play area or any other demarcated areas on the school grounds or during an activity.
19. That parents are requested to keep school grounds neat and tidy, and that littering is prohibited.

Geagte Ouers,

Ek dink ouerwees is die belangrikste werk ter wêreld.” – Dr Ben Carson

Godwin Khosa van NECT het opgemerk dat kinders wat deur hul ouers en versorgers ondersteun word, die meeste sukses op skool behaal. ‘n Mens het kennis en vaardighede nodig ten einde jou kind op skool te ondersteun.

Dit begin deur ‘n vertrouensverhouding te bou, die kind aan te moedig, met hom/haar te kommunikeer, te wys dat jy omgee, ‘n doel-treffende leer-omgewing te skep en by u kind se lewe betrokke te raak.

Om u kind die hele tyd dop te hou en sy/haar lewe te beheer, is nie die antwoord nie. Om u kind te ondersteun wanneer hy iets verkeerd doen en die onderwyser en skool te bevraagteken, gaan u ook niks in die sak bring nie. U kind moet verantwoordelikheid vir sy/haar dade aanvaar en leer om uitdagings die hoof te bied met die wete dat u hom/haar onvoorwaardelik liefhet.

Ons moet verskillende probleme die hoof bied, maar ons veroordeel nooit ‘n leerling nie. Die uitkoms van sake is nie altyd wat ouers wil hê nie, maar oplossings en besluite word altyd uit ‘n onderwysoogpunt bereik.

Onderwysers is onderworpe aan die SACE-gedragskode – dit is die professionele onderwysliggaam. SBL-lede is ook onderworpe aan die voor-geskrewe gedragskode. In samewerking met ander skole, die Onderwysdepartement en beheerliggame is ons nou in die proses om ‘n gedragskode vir ouers te finaliseer.

Die gedragskode behels dat ouers die volgende moet doen:

1. Hul gedrag moet van so ‘n aard wees dat dit nie die skool se reputasie benadeel of personeellede en leerlinge in die verleentheid stel nie.
2. Hulle mag hulle nie aan ontwrigtende gedrag skuldig maak wat inbreuk maak of moontlik inbreuk kan maak op die werksaamhede in ‘n klaskamer, ‘n personeellid se kantoor, kantoorgebied of enige ander deel van die skoolterrein, insluitend spanwedstryde, nie.
3. Die gebruik van harde en/of aanstootlike taal, vloek, swets of die gebruik van gekruide taal of om die humeur te verloor, word nie toege-laat nie.
4. Ouers mag nie dreig om personeellede, die Skoolhoof, besoekers, mede-ouers/versorgers of leerlinge aan te rand nie, ongeag of die ge-drag ‘n kriminele oortreding is of nie.
5. Ouers mag hulle nie skuldig maak aan beledigings of dreigemente in e-pos of teks/stempos/foonboodskappe of ander skriftelike kom-munikasie nie.
6. Ouers mag nie lasterlike, aanstootlike of neerhalende aanmerkings oor die skool of enige leerlinge/ouers/personeel van die skool op Facebook of ander sosiale terreine maak nie. Enige kwessies moet deur die gepaste kanale aangespreek word, m.a.w. klasonderwyser, Departementshoof, Adjunk-Skoolhoof, sodat dit op ‘n regverdige, toepaslike en doeltreffende wyse opgelos kan word.
7. Die gebruik van fisiese geweld teenoor ‘n ander volwassene of kind is ontoelaatbaar; dit sluit fisiese straf van ouers se eie kinders op die skoolterrein in.
8. Ouers mag nie iemand anders se kind aanspreek of tugtig as gevolg van die optrede van daardie kind teenoor die eerste ouer se kind nie (dit mag as aanranding beskou word en kan regstappe tot gevolg hê).
9. Ouers moet selfbeheersing toepas en respek, beleefdheid en verdraagsaamheid teenoor mekaar, opvoeders, leerlinge, mede-toeskouers, afrigters, skeidsregters, beoordelaars en opponente aan die dag lê.
10. Ouers mag nie opvoeders, deelnemers, afrigters, skeidsregters of beoordelaars intimideer nie.
11. Ouers moet optree ingevolge die etiese kode vereis deur ‘n bepaalde kultuur- of sportaktiwiteit.
12. Fisiese geweld, lasterlike of aanstootlike taal of onwelvoeglike tekens tydens sportwedstryde of ander aktiwiteite is streng verbode.
13. Ouers moet hulle daarvan weerhou om negatiewe aanmerkings te maak of onbehoorlike taal te gebruik wanneer hulle met skeidsreg-ters, ander beampies, beoordelaars, spelers of hul opponente se ondersteuners kommunikeer.
14. Wanneer enige aktiwiteit van die skool bygewoon word, moet almal voldoen aan die versoek en reëlings van die betrokke skool en/of organiseerders.
15. Die gebruik van alkohol en onwettige dwelms is streng verbode by alle skoolaktiwiteite.
16. Geen wapens of geværlike voorwerpe word op die skoolterrein toegelaat nie, tensy dit bedoel is vir amptelike werkdoeleindes, bv. in die geval van SAPD-beampies.
17. Ouers mag slegs in die aangewese rookareas rook, en slegs indien dit nie ‘n nadelige invloed het op die leerlinge se onderrig of ander ak-tiwiteite nie. Raadpleeg gerus die skool se rookbeleid, waarin die aangewese rookareas gestipuleer word.
18. Ouers, ondersteuners en toeskouers word versoek om die aangewese afstand van die kantlyne van enige betrokke sportveld of –baan te handhaaf, en om nie die speelgebied of enige ander gemerkte areas op die skoolterrein gedurende ‘n aktiwiteit te betree nie.
19. Ouers word versoek om die skoolterrein netjies en skoon te hou en moet onthou dat rommelstrooi verbode is.




