EARLY LIFE: I was born in Johannesburg but grew up in East London where I went to George Randall Primary School and then Stirling High School. I learned to play the trombone in high school and fell in love with big band music.

FAMILY Life: My family all live in Johannesburg- I have an older brother and a younger sister.

CAREER LIFE: I worked at the Nelson Mandela University as a researcher in education for 5 years. I worked with TVET college lecturers and students as well as adult learners and educators. I also lectured Foundation Phase students at the university. During this time I had private students learning to play the recorder, trumpet and trombone and continued to play in different orchestras and ensembles in the Eastern Cape, Johannesburg and Belgium.

ACCOMPLISHMENTS: I have a BA degree in Linguistics and an Honours degree in Psychology from the University of the Witwatersrand. The HSRC has recently published a book of ours called Learning for Living which is based on the large scale research project that I was part of while at the Centre for Integrated Post-School Education and Training (CIPSET). I have also been selected to attend the Dutch Bass Trombone Open in September this year. **50 bass trombonists from all over the world have been selected to attend of which only 9 are female. It's the first time that a South African will attend this exclusive event for bass trombone.**

INTERESTING FACTS ABOUT YOURSELF: I love brass instruments, especially lower brass. I enjoy reading and am particularly interested in gender studies - especially as this relates to music. I have two dogs called Tchaikovsky and Puccini.




