



Dear Parents,

Revealing information on how children in schools experience the change in society and the influence of social media needs to be dealt with carefully. We need to acknowledge that social media will influence our children and education.

In our newsletters over the past four years, we have focused on a positive attitude and touched on matters that negatively influence our children on a day to day basis. Notwithstanding this the main influential aspect is attitude towards information. It is a fact that we will have different opinions and people will embrace change differently.

Although there will always be the exception to the rule our children see our school as a safe place; they feel loved and cared for by their teachers. Our children trust their teachers and although they do not need to like them, mutual respect is the key to the current success.

The way children speak of and to their parents and to some teachers reveals, in a few cases, a few issues threatening education. Social media and TV might be the culprit setting the example but after reading the Whatsapp's of two grades at Sunridge, where mothers were chatting, I was shocked by the way they were willing to disrespectfully deal with matters not to their liking.

Although another Whatsapp group's communication was very professional the first two raised alarm bells. If that's the example set we cannot expect any better from children. Although still within control at Sunridge, it has been confirmed by an informal enquiry that it is a factor at high schools. Looking at a more formal study done about this issue clearly supports the threat of our actions as parents.

Keep a watch on your words and attitude as your children follow your example!

E-mails and looking at what parents are willing to communicate to the school and teachers was shared with relevant authorities to obtain a so called "second opinion". Defamation of character and other aspects is a risk parents will soon face. The fact that teachers and secretaries have taken it on the chin up to now is fast changing as the older generation are getting fed up and are being replaced with younger ones.

Attending workshops, union meetings and a World Conference has revealed that we as parents will sooner than later face the first serious consequences in this regard.


The teachers changed four years ago and with assessment meetings, disciplinary hearings and other discussions we focus on the positive while dealing with matters related to our children. We distanced ourselves from negative and personal comments and set policies up to support teachers on how to apply corrective measures and to prevent misconduct. Although we accept that mistakes will still be made we are proactively dealing with it.

This is a friendly reminder to all parents and teachers alike to distance yourselves from these negative aspects. You are responsible for what you say and write. Thank you so much to parents for bringing this aspect to our attention and for providing us with access to information.

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Geagte Ouers

Wanneer besonderhede bekend gemaak word oor hoe skoolkinders die verandering in die samelewing en die invloed van sosiale media ervaar, moet dit met omsigtigheid hanteer word. Ons moet besef dat die sosiale media ons kinders en onderwys sal beïnvloed.

Gedurende die afgelope vier jaar het ons in ons nuusbriewe op 'n positiewe ingesteldheid gefokus en op 'n daaglikse basis aandag geskenk aan kwessies wat 'n negatiewe invloed op ons kinders kan hê. Desnieteenstaande is die vernaamste aspek wat 'n invloed het, ingesteldheid teenoor inligting. Dit is 'n feit dat ons verskillende menings sal hê en dat mense uiteenlopende opinies oor verandering sal hê.

Alhoewel daar altyd uitsonderings op enige reël is, ervaar ons kinders ons skool as 'n veilige plek; hulle voel dat hul onderwysers vir hulle lief is en omgee. Ons kinders vertrou ons onderwysers en hoewel hulle nie van hul onderwysers hoef te hou nie, is weder-sydse respek die rede vir die huidige welslae.

Wanneer 'n mens sien hoe kinders van en met hul ouers praat, asook in 'n paar gevalle met sommige onderwysers, is dit duidelik dat daar 'n paar sake is wat 'n bedreiging vir die onderwys inhoud. Sosiale media en TV is dalk vir hierdie gedrag verantwoordelik, maar nadat ek die Whatsapp-kletsboodskappe van twee grade by Sunridge gelees het, was ek verstom oor die oneerbiedige wyse waarop hierdie moeders sake waarvan hulle nie hou nie, bespreek het.

Alhoewel die kommunikasie op 'n ander Whatsapp-groep uiters professioneel was, het die eerste twee groepe die gevaarlike laat flikker. As dit die voorbeeld is wat ons stel, kan ons niks anders van ons kinders verwag nie. Alhoewel dit hier by Sunridge onder beheer is, is dit beslis 'n faktor by hoërskole en dit is deur 'n informele opname bevestig. Wanneer 'n mens na 'n formele studie kyk wat oor hierdie kwessie gedoen is, is dit duidelik dat ons optrede as ouers die bedreiging vererger.

Hou 'n wag voor u mond en waak oor u houding, want u kinders volg u voorbeeld!

E-posse en dit wat ouers bereid is om met die skool en onderwysers te deel, is na betrokke owerhede aangestuur vir 'n sogenaamde "tweede opinie". Naamskending en ander kwessies is 'n risiko wat ouers binnekort in die gesig sal staar. Die feit dat onderwysers en sekretaresse tot dusver die mokerhoue moes verduur verander vinnig, aangesien die ouer geslag keelvol raak en met die jonger geslag vervang word.

Wanneer 'n mens werkwinkels, vakbondvergaderings en 'n wêreldkonferensie bywoon, kom jy tot die gevolgtrekking dat ons as ouers - gouer as wat ons dink - die eerste ernstige gevolge in hierdie verband die hoof sal moet bied.


As onderwysers was ons reeds vier jaar gelede aan verandering onderworpe en met assesseringsvergaderings, dissiplinêre verhore en ander samesprekings fokus ons op die positiewe wanneer ons met sake rakende ons kinders te kampe het. 
