Facilities

In view of the very short holiday, we were not able to complete all work and upgrades. We are still working hard and barriers are up to indicate restricted areas. Please support us in educating the children to respect these and to understand that it is for their safety. We are moving forward and appreciate your assistance and support in ensuring that we can continue to develop and maintain our facilities.

Homework

It has been, and always will be, the responsibility of all learners to write down their homework. This skill is essential for any **child's High School career**. As part of our service we provide homework diaries to every learner. We originally introduced the homework e-mail to support parents in helping us to ensure the homework has been written down correctly and that it is done. We take pride in ensuring that we prepare our learners for High School and for life in general. Our task is to make sure they are equipped with all the necessary life skills.

The primary task of parents/ aftercare to sign the homework diary to confirm that homework has been done, has never changed.

We, however, have found that the purpose of the e-mail service has been misused, homework diaries were not signed anymore and some learners and parents rely only on the e-mail. This means we have basically failed the object of the exercise and did not achieve the outcome expected.

It was a challenge to find a better way to deliver this service so as to enable us to achieve the required outcome - the answer to this was to create a portal on our administrative system. Homework and information is now accessible to all parents and the history from day one will always be available. A late email or not sending it cannot be used as an excuse. Homework must be written down by every learner in their homework diary as provided and must be signed every day by the parent/ after care. Primarily the parent is responsible to sign the homework diary and must make sure that the child takes responsibility to do their homework. This will support the skill which is essential for the future and which needs to be taught and become part of the daily routine.

The portal is a back up for parents to monitor and check that the homework is accurate. Teachers will soon start a daily check to see the homework diary is signed. This will be recorded on our merit system and used within the progression requirements if needed.

The possibility for us to achieve the required outcome is now within reach as we have, hopefully, cut out the loopholes and short cuts.

After care facilities must use of the homework diary and support us in making sure that the responsibility stays with the child.

On 15 March 2019 the emails will stop and homework will only be available through the portal on staffroom. You need to make certain that your child understands their responsibility to write down the homework accurately.

Huiswerk

Dit is te alle tye die verantwoordelikheid van leerlinge om te verseker dat hulle hul huiswerk neergeskryf. Hierdie vaardigheid is **noodsaaklik vir enige kind se hoërskoolloopbaan. Elke enkele leerling kry 'n huiswerkboekie as deel van ons diens. Ons het** onderneem om huiswerk-e-posse aan ouers te stuur ten einde seker te maak dat huiswerk behoorlik neergeskryf en gedoen word.

Die vernaamste taak van ouers/versorgers/nasorg om die huiswerkboekie te onderteken om te bevestig dat huiswerk gedoen is, het nog nooit verander nie.

Ons het egter ondervind dat die doel van die e-posdiens misluk het, huiswerkboekies word nie onderteken nie en sommige leerlinge en ouers maak slegs op die e-pos staat. Ons het nie in ons doel geslaag nie en die diens wat ons gelewer het, het nie aan die uitkoms voldoen nie.

Dit was 'n uitdaging om 'n beter diens te lewer wat die gewenste uitkoms sou bereik, dus was die antwoord om 'n portaal in ons administratiewe stelsel te skep. Huiswerk en inligting is nou vir alle ouers toeganklik en die geschiedenis vanaf dag een **is altyd beskikbaar. 'n E-pos wat laat gestuur of glad nie gestuur word nie, is nou nie meer 'n verskoning nie. Huiswerk moet** deur elke enkele leerling in die huiswerkboekie neergeskryf word. Hierdie huiswerk moet elke dag deur die ouer/versorger/nasorg onderteken word. Uiteindelik is die ouer daarvoor verantwoordelik dat die huiswerkboekie onderteken word en om seker te maak dat die kind verantwoordelikheid neem om die huiswerk te doen. Die moontlikheid om die gewenste uitkoms te bereik, is nou beslis binne bereik, aangesien ons al die skuiwergate en kortpaaie uitgeskakel het.

Nasorgfasiliteite moet die huiswerkboekie gebruik en ons help om te verseker dat die vernaamste verantwoordelikheid by die kind berus.




