This bag would retail close to a thousand rand. It is very strong and has a two year warranty.**

We have also managed to source umbrellas branded with the Sunridge name. Ideal for a sunny or rainy day. Maybe **for Dad's golf day or Mum at the beach. We have 100 available at R180 each.**

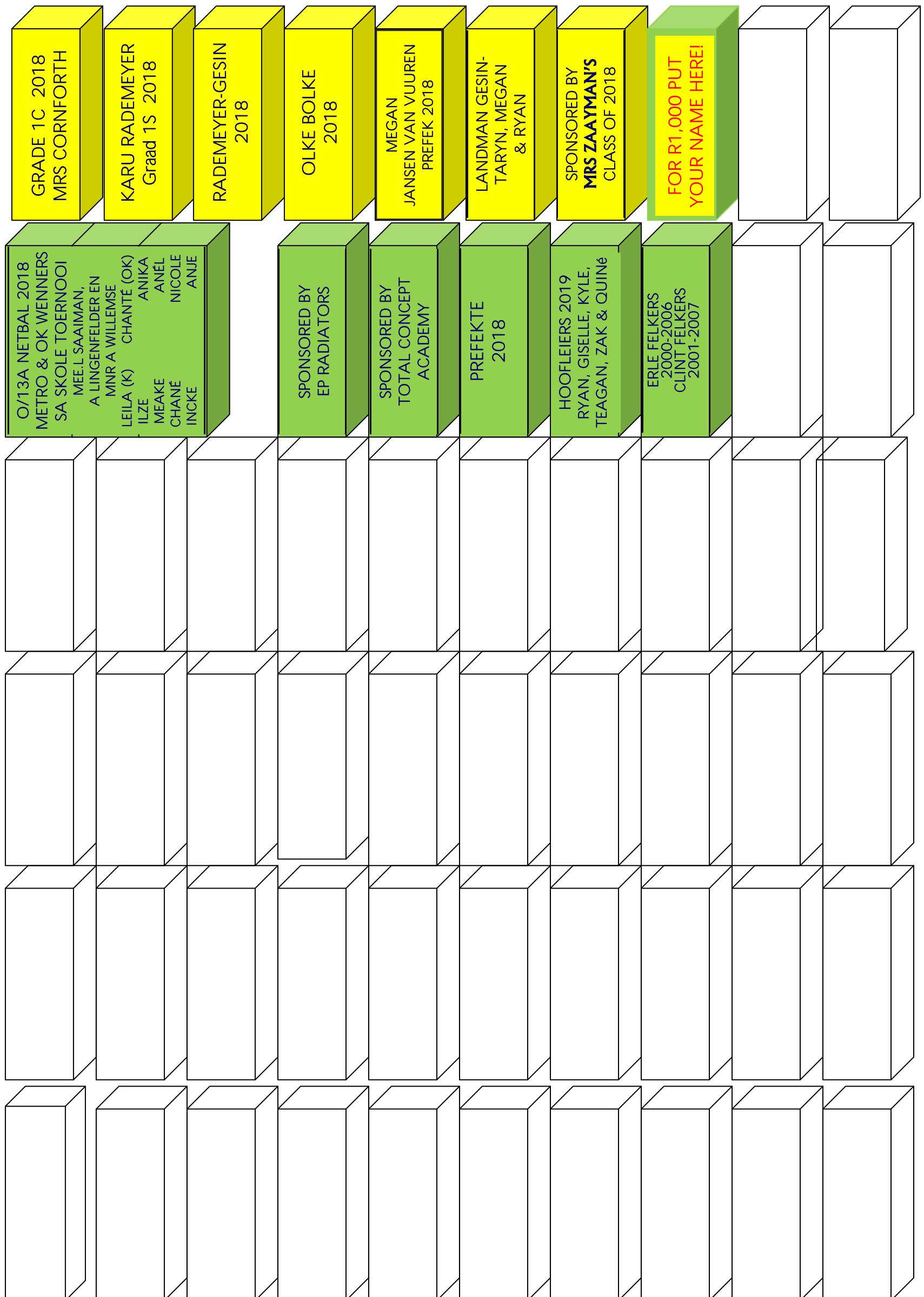
