Geagte Ouers

Veiligheid

Dit is jammer dat sommige ouers nie die nuusbriewe lees nie en in die proses word ons kinders se veiligheid in gevaar gestel. Onthou asseblief dat die wet baie duidelike riglyne stel oor die besoeke van ouers aan die skool en die wyse waarop dit moet geskied. Alhoewel ek as Skoolhoof ouers versoek om nie die geboue binne te kom wanneer u u kind kom haal of aflaai nie, jammer dat daar sommige ouers is wat dit ignoreer. Dit is eintlik nie 'n versoek nie en ek herinner ouers vriendelik daaraan dat dit onaanvaarbaar is en my in die netelige posisie plaas waar ek gedwing sal word om die Veiligheidsregulasies vir besoeke aan Openbare Skole in werking te stel.

Ons laat wel ouers op die terrein toe, dit is die uitsondering op die reël, maar ons versoek vriendelik dat ouers naby die heining en die hek bly. Geen ouers word waar die kinders aantree of by die klaskamerdeure toegelaat nie. Alhoewel ons verdraagsaam teenoor die Gr 1's is, bly dit die uitsondering op die reël en ouers moet ná die einde van die eerste kwartaal hulle daarvan weerhou om dit te doen. Oom Boerie sal vra dat u gaan en dit is sy werk om dit te doen.

"Ouers mag die openbare skool waar hul kinders skoolgaan, besoek, maar sodanige besoeke mag geen skoolaktiwiteite ontwrig nie." Lees asseblief bl.2.

Indien u kind ná die gewone skoolure, d.w.s ná 14:00, aan sport deelneem, mag u die terrein binnekom om u kind te ondersteun. U word vriendelik versoek om die skoolreëls te gehoorsaam en nie met die oefening of wedstryd in te meng nie. Indien u iets met die afrigter moet bespreek, moet u asseblief deur die korrekte kanale 'n afspraak reël, aangesien dit nie aanvaarbaar is om met die afrigter te praat terwyl hy/sy met afrigting besig is, kinders groet of toerusting wegpak nie.

Dear Parents

Safety

It is sad that some parents do not read the newsletters and as a result put the safety of our children at risk. Please note that the law is very clear on parents visiting the school and the way a parent must go about it. As Principal, I kindly requested parents not to enter our premises when dropping off or fetching their child - sadly it is being ignored by some parents. I kindly remind parents that it is not acceptable and I am being put into the predicament that I might be forced to call on the Safety Regulations for visiting a Public School to enforce this.

To be fair, we do allow parents to enter the premises. This is an exception to the rule, but kindly ask that parents stay on the perimeter close to the gate. No parents are allowed where the children line up or at classroom doors. Although we are tolerant with the grade 1's, it remains an exception to the rule and parents should refrain from doing this after the first term. Uncle Boerie will ask you to leave - it is his job to do so.

"Parents have the right to visit the public school where their children have been admitted but such visits may not disrupt any of the school activities." Please read page 2.

Should your child participate in sport after normal school hours (14:00), you may enter the premises and support your child. I kindly remind you to abide by the school rules and not to interfere with any practices or matches. Should you need to discuss anything with the coach, please set up an appointment through appropriate channels. It is not the appropriate time during the extra mural session or while the teacher/ coach is still seeing children off or packing away equipment.

Published under Government Notice 1040 in *Government Gazette* 22754 of 12 October 2001 and amended by: GN R1128 in *Government Gazette* 29376 of 10 November 2006

Access to public schools premises

(1) Subject to the Constitution, laws and national and provincial policies, the HOD or principal of any public school may and for such timeframes as may be necessary -

(a) take such steps as he or she may consider necessary for the safeguarding of the public school premises, as well as for the protection of the people therein; and

(b) direct that the school may only be entered in accordance with the provisions of subregulation (2).

(2) No person shall without the permission of the principal or HOD enter into any public school premises in respect of which a direction has been issued under subregulation (1)(a), and for the purpose of the granting of that permission the principal or HOD may require of the person concerned to -

(a) furnish his or her name, address and any other relevant information required by the principal or HOD;

(b) produce proof of his or her identity to the satisfaction of the principal or HOD if necessary;

(c) declare whether he or she has any dangerous object or illegal drugs in his or her possession or custody or under his or her control;

(d) declare what the contents are of any vehicle, suitcase, attaché case, bag, handbag, folder, envelope, parcel or container of any nature which he or she has in his or her possession or custody or under his or her control, and show those contents to him or her;

(e) subject himself or herself and anything which he or she has in his or her possession or custody or under his or her control to a search by a person of the same gender, an examination by an electronic device, sniffer dogs or other apparatus in order to determine the presence of any dangerous object or illegal drug; and

(f) hand to the principal or HOD anything which he or she has in his or her possession or custody or under his or her control for examination or custody until he or she leaves the premises.

(3) Without derogation of the provisions of the Trespass Act, 1959 (Act No. 6 of 1959), the principal or HOD may at any time remove any person from any public school premises if

(i) that person enters the public school premises concerned without the permission contemplated in subregulation (2);

(ii) that person refuses or fails to observe any steps contemplated in subregulation (1)(a); and

(iii) the principal or HOD considers it necessary for the safeguarding of the public school premises concerned or for the protection of the people thereon.

(4) If it is not practicable to examine or keep in custody, on or in the public school premises concerned, anything which may be examined, or kept in custody under subregulation (2), it may be removed to a suitable place for that purpose.

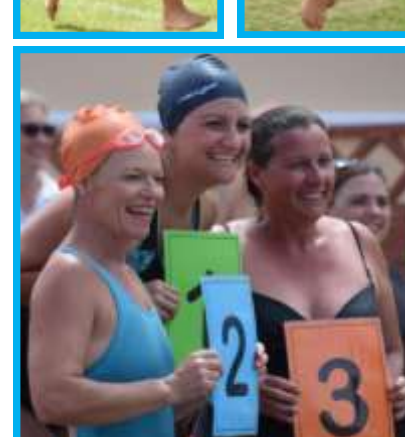

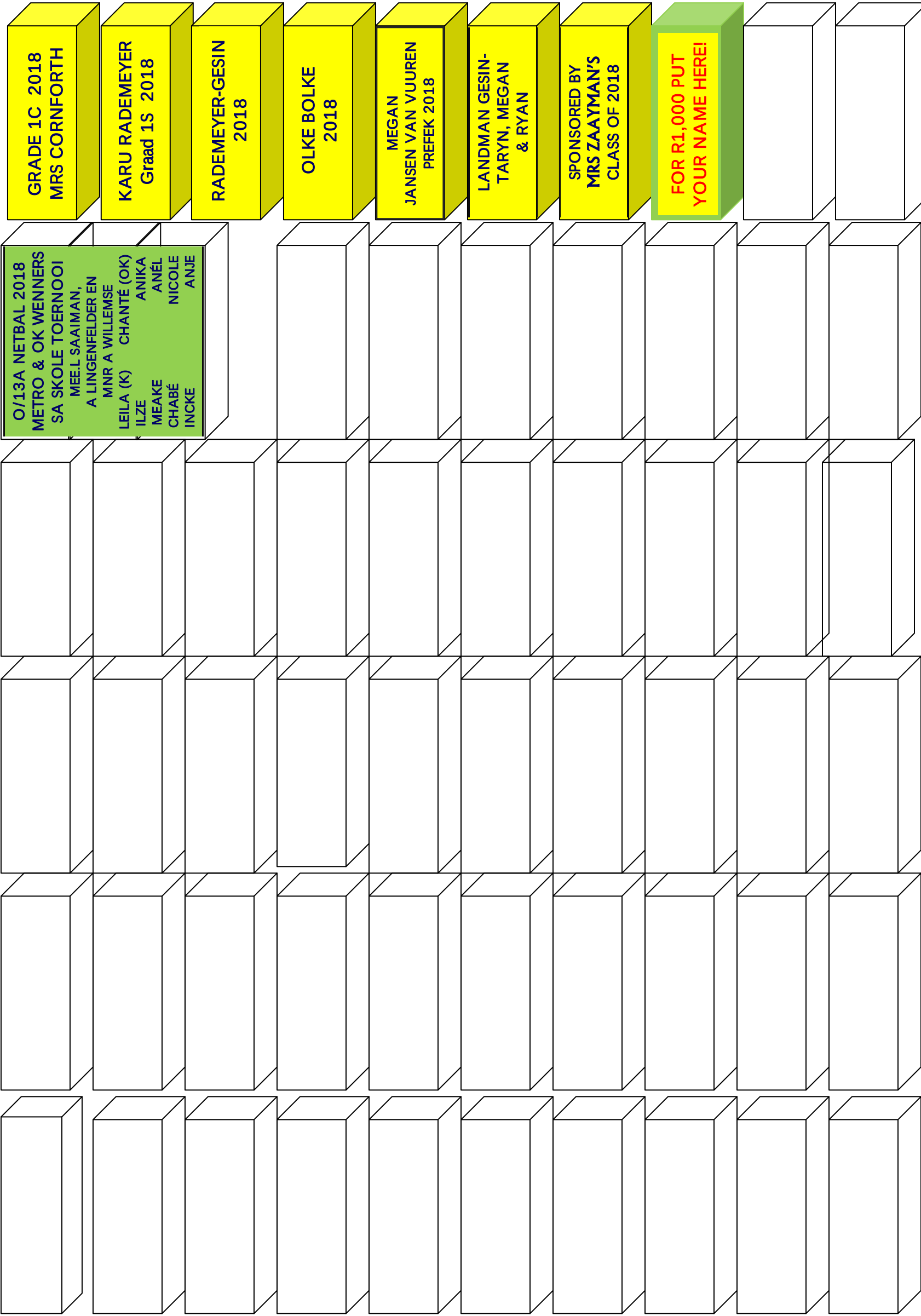
