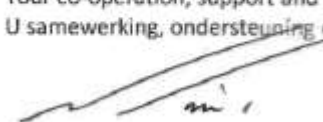

The prefects of Sunridge would like to support the Cheshire Home in Sydenham during the week of 2 - 6 September 2019. This forms part of Sunridge's outreach program for the less privileged.

More about Cheshire Home in Sydenham

This institution cares for 43 disabled adults and children who come from very poor homes and communities. Our residents are **profoundly disabled** as a result of motor vehicle accidents, illness, strokes, acts of violence. They are almost all **wheel-chair bound** and dependent on care for their existence. Our Home is a **residential one** and people come to us from the age of 18 on a **permanent basis**. We do all we can to make life as comfortable as possible for our residents. We also have a **Daycare facility called Happy Feet** for **20 severely disabled children** from the local community.

The top 3 projects include the residential home, daycare Centre for children (called Happy Feet) and the **Charity Shop** which is the main source of funding for the Home.

Cheshire Homes needs list:

- Books, furniture, clothes, household items, kitchen ware, toys, clothes, etc for the Charity Shop.
- Adult Nappies
- Donations of any types of food
- Linen for single beds
- Any adult clothing or children's clothing.

The prefects will basically try to collect items for the Cheshire Charity Shop at Bloomingdales in Main Road, Walmer. The Charity Shop sells a wonderful selection of good quality second hand items at very reasonable prices. All household items, books and clothing are donated by the community.

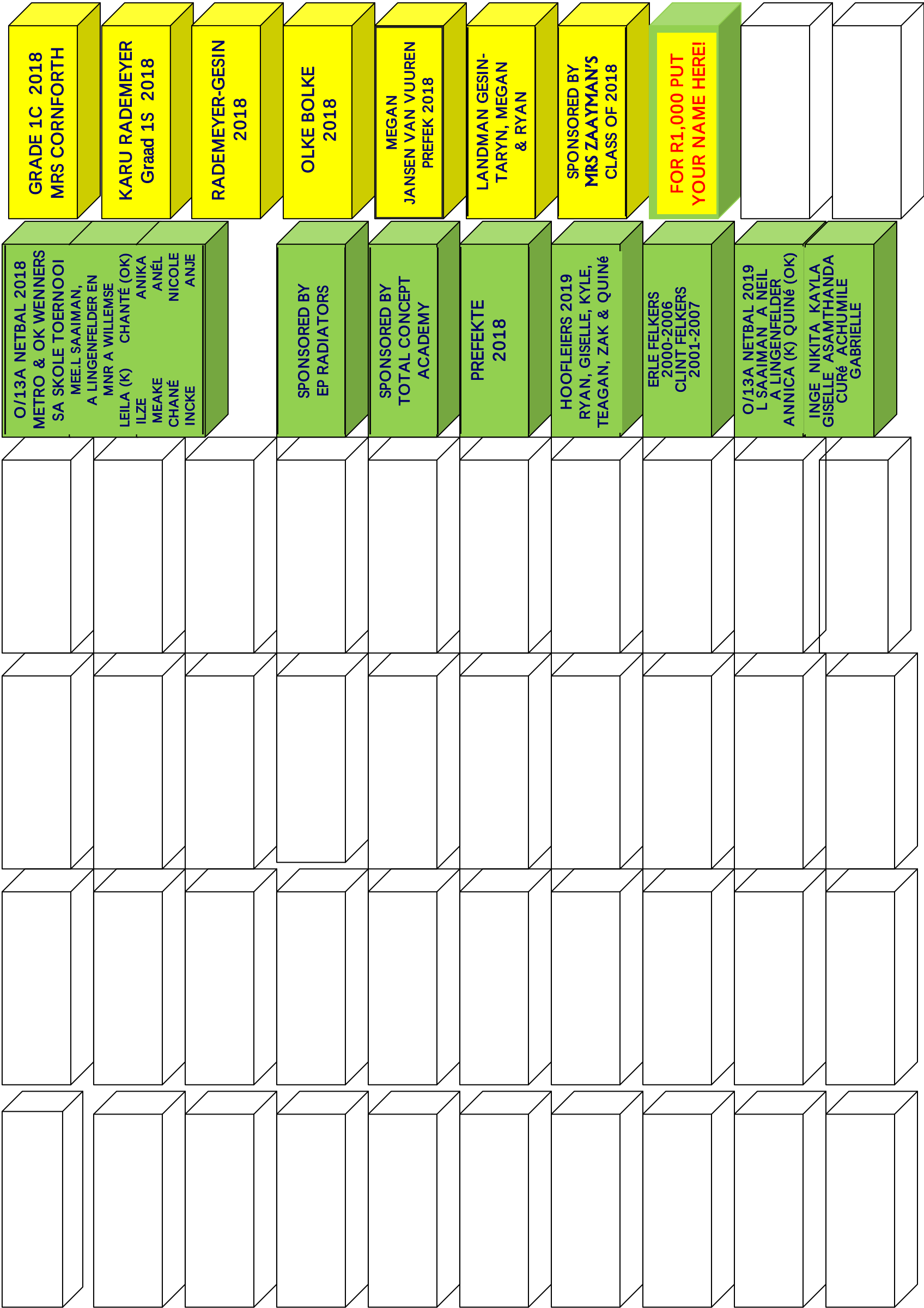
