**TRAFFIC**

With all due respect, monitoring traffic around the school is a very frightening exercise: drivers seem to ignore the fact that children are crossing the road and using walkways. This attitude make us spectators while it is clear that our children are at risk. The school cannot deal with this matter outside our premises but still need to take steps to protect our children.

We have been working at this for the past 5 years. Future plans, recommendations and solutions were communicated by us to the relevant authorities - it is now, with the school's support, in their hands.

Last week we had a very productive meeting with the local authorities - please take note that they will now monitor the traffic and steep fines will be issued. They will work on solutions but it will take time. Although this is out of our hands, we will protect our children and inform authorities about offenders. The school cannot act as messenger in this regard, please report offenders to the authorities.

Please drive carefully, obey road rules and use patience when dropping your child off or fetching him or her. Not everyone can park around the school, we need to use the parking space to drop off and move on. Do not drop your child off in the middle of the road. In support of the authorities please change your drop off time and please try and stick to the new allocated gates. Gate 8 is not currently being used enough. Two or more children - gate 8 is the safest option. After cares - gate 2 & 16.


