

Geagte Ouers

Omvattende Seksopvoeding-kurrikulum

Ons is deeglik bewus van die bohaai wat rondom hierdie kwessie in die media en sosiale media woed. Sunridge sal altyd teenoor u as ouers verantwoordelik wees en ons bly getrou aan ons beleid as waardegedrewe skool. Hierdie kwessie sal, wanneer nodig, met ouers bespreek word en ons SBL sal die besluit neem wanneer ons met die implementering van hierdie kurrikulum gekonfronteer word.

Ons glo dat ouers inspraak moet hê en dat u u grondwetlike reg om u standpunt in hierdie verband te stel, moet uitoefen. Ons sal die OSO-kurrikulum nie sonder u toestemming implementeer nie; tot tyd en wyl dit gebeur, sal ons die huidige kurrikulum gebruik en ons kan u verseker dat ons onderwysers die beskikbare bronne en inhoud deeglik sal bestudeer met inagneming van ons waardes. Ons waardes is in klip gegiet en dit word deur die meeste van ons ouers ondersteun.

Ons SBL sal in die beste belang van ons kinders optree en met u skakel indien nodig. Indien die Departement van Onderwys ons volgens wet verplig om aan hul vereistes te voldoen, sal ons weer daarvoor besin.

My raad aan ouers is om alle moontlike middele tot hul beskikking te gebruik om, wanneer die geleentheid hom voordoen, teen hierdie OSO-kurrikulum by die betrokke owerhede beswaar aan te teken. Doen dit asseblief altyd met respek en met behulp van die korrekte platform.

Selfbesering

Dit is 'n nuwe ding wat by skole kop uitsteek. Die beweringe dat dit by die skool gebeur het, is egter van alle waarheid ontbloot en geen bewyse kon gevind word nie. Ons ondersoek het duidelik bevind dat sommige kinders van Gr 5 – 7 selfbesering by die huis toedien. Daar was geïsoleerde voorvalle op toer, maar in 99% van gevalle gebeur dit tuis en ouers is skynbaar salig onbewus daarvan. Ons wil sterk aanbeveel dat ouers aan die saak aandag skenk en hulp verkry. Die grootste probleem kom tans by vroulike leerlinge voor. Ons voorsien 'n veilige plek vir kinders om met ons te kom praat en ons bied berading aan, maar aan die einde van die dag is dit die ouers se verantwoordelikheid.

Bakleier

Dit is nou komkommertyd (silly season) en al hoe meer leerlinge dink probleme kan met die vuiste opgelos word. Dit gebeur as 'n reaksie en is nie altyd moontlik om te voorkom nie. In 99% van gevalle is dit nie afknouery nie, maar suiwer gebrek aan dissipline. Ons hanteer hierdie kwessies binne die reëls van die beleid, maar ouers moet hul kinders leer dat dit nie reg is om 'n ander persoon te slaan of te skop nie. Meld probleme liever aan en ons sal dit hanteer. Die uitkoms sal dalk nie alwys wees wat die ouers verwag nie, maar dit sal gebeur met al die inligting tot ons beskikking. Daar is altyd drie kante aan 'n storie. U kan seker wees dat ons daadwerklik optree en dat voorsorgskorsing 'n werklikheid is.

Dit is ook belangrik om u kind te leer om nie ander mense te teister en 'n reaksie te probeer ontlok nie. Tergery en ander maniere om 'n reaksie te probeer kry, sal hokgeslaan word. Kinders maak die lewe soms ondraaglik en beland in die moeilikheid. Ons sal streng stappe neem teen leerlinge wat aanvallend optree.

Haarstyle

Ons merk op dat sommige leerlinge se hare nie volgens gewone skoolreëls en –beleid gesny word nie. Ons is ook daarvan bewus dat sommige “ateljees” hiervoor vra wanneer kinders aan vertonings deelneem. Hulle verskaf selfs ondersteunende briewe. Dit is egter onaanvaarbaar en in stryd met die skoolreëls. Ons sal hierdie gedrag nie duld nie en sal daadwerklik optree. Dit is wel so dat ons Gedragskode vir uitsonderings voorsiening maak, **MAAR** ouers moet die prosedure volg soos duidelik in die huiswerkboek uiteengesit.

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Dear Parents

CSE Curriculum

We are well aware of this matter in the media and all the social media communication going around. Sunridge will always be responsible towards you as parents and to our policy as a value driven school. This matter will be communicated with all parents when needed and our SGB will take the decision when we are confronted with the implementation of this curriculum.

We believe that parents have a say and that you must use your constitutional right to speak up in this regard. We will not introduce the CSE curriculum without your consent; until such time we will only continue with the current curriculum and rest assured our teachers will carefully study the available resources and content against our values. Our values stay the same and it is guided by the majority of parents.

Our SGB will act in the best interest of our children and they will liaise with you when needed. Should the Department of Education, by law, force us to comply we will cross the bridge at the time.

My advice would be that parents use the means available to object with regards to the CSE curriculum with the appropriate authorities when the opportunity arises. Please always do it with respect and only on the correct platform.

Self-Harm

This is a new thing happening at schools. The rumors that it happens at school are not true and no evidence could be found. Our investigation clearly finds that some children from grade 5 to 7 are inflicting self-harm at home. Isolated incidents on tours also occur but in 99% of cases it happens at home, seemingly without parents knowing it. We strongly recommend that parent's pay attention to this matter and seek help. We can also confirm that currently the biggest problem lies with female learners. We avail a safe place for children to come and talk to us and we provide counseling but ultimately parents are responsible.

Fighting

Currently it is the silly season as more and more learners think they can use their fists to sort out issues. Again this happens as a reaction, prevention is not always possible and in 99% cases it is not bullying but pure lack of discipline. We attend to these matters within our policy but parents need to educate children that it is not "OK" to hit or kick another person. Rather report any issues and we will deal with them, the outcome might not always be what parents want but it will be done with all information at hand. There are always three sides to the story. Rest assured that we will take decisive action and that precautionary suspension is a reality.

It is also important to teach your child not to harass anyone and keep on looking for a reaction. Name calling and other forms of seeking reactions will be dealt with severely. They sometimes make it unbearable and then run into trouble. We will act against learners who act as aggressors.

Hair styles

We find that some learners are now cutting their hair outside of the normal school rules and policy. We are also aware that some "studios" ask for this on account of shows, they even provide letters in support. This is however not acceptable and in contradiction of the school rules. We will not accept this behavior and will act accordingly. Please note that to comply with the law our "code of conduct" makes provision for exceptions **BUT** parents need to follow the procedure as clearly spelt out. Please consult your homework diary.
