



Geagte Ouers

Kleredrag

Gedurende 2018 is 'n versoek i.v.m. warm baadjies aan ons gerig. Die saak is deeglik ondersoek met betrekking tot koste-implikasies en duursaamheid.

'n Wollerige top is voorgestel, maar dit sou nie geskik wees vir reëndae nie. Dit was duidelik dat 'n warm/reënjas en warm/reënbroek 'n prioriteit vir sport sou wees. Ons het 'n veeldoelige materiaal nodig gehad en uiteindelik is op 'n "skeurvrye" materiaal, wat aan albei vereistes voldoen, besluit. Die broek en baadjie kan ook afsonderlik bestel en gekoop word.

Die SBL het voorlopige goedkeuring verleen dat hierdie baadjies en broeke slegs vir sport gebruik word. Dit sal dan die enigste warm/reënklere wees wat vir sport toegelaat word. Dit sal dan ook inlyn met ons geborgde eerstespansklore gebring word.

Aangesien 'n paar skoolsweetpakke steeds vir sport gebruik word, sal daar 'n oorgangstydperk wees, waarna dit uitgefaseer sal word.

Neem asseblief daarvan kennis dat **dit nie skooldrag is nie** en slegs vir sport bedoel is. Die skooltrui en kleurbaadjie is die enigste warm klere wat skool toe gedra mag word. Gr 1 – 3 mag egter steeds die sweetpakbaadjie vir saalbyeenkoms gebruik (hulle mag wel kleurbaadjies dra as hulle wil) en **slegs gedurende die winter** mag hulle die volle sweetpak skool toe dra wanneer dit baie koud is. Dit is egter nie netjies nie en 'n nagmerrie vir ouers om skoon te hou. Al hoe meer seuns dra langbroeke en die meisies mag sykouse dra.

'n Foto is vir u gerief aangeheg en 'n voorbeeld van die warm/reënbaadjie en broek is by die kantoor ter insae. Teen 'n bedrag van gemiddeld R300 per baadjie en R190 per broek is dit goedkoper as 'n volle sweetpak en ook veeldoelig.

Ten spyte hiervan streef ons steeds daarna om ons standarde te verbeter en wil meld dat ons in hierdie verband met geen laerskool in kompetisie is nie.

Dear Parents

Clothing

A request was made in 2018 for a warm/rain jacket. The matter was fully investigated with cost implications and durability in mind.

A fleecy top was suggested but it did not address the rain issue. The matter clearly indicates a need for a warm/rain jacket and warm/rain pants as a priority for sport. We needed to get a multi-purpose material - a very durable "rip stop" fabric was eventually selected which can serve both purposes. The jacket and pants can also be ordered and bought separately.

The provisional approval by the SGB is for these jackets and pants to be used for sport only. This will be the only warm/rain clothing allowed for sport. We will also align this with our sponsored first team clothing.

As a few school tracksuits are still in use for sport we will initiate a transition period and phase them out.

Please take note that **it is not school clothing** and is only intended for sport. The official school jersey and blazer is the only warm clothing to be worn to school (Grades 4 - 7). Grade 1 - 3 still use the tracksuit tops for assembly (they may wear blazers) and **only during winter**, when it's very cold, may they wear the full tracksuit to school. This is however not neat and a nightmare for parents to keep clean. More and more boys wear the long school pants and the girls may wear stockings.

We attach a photo for your convenience and a sample of the warm/rain jacket and pants can be viewed at the office. Should you disagree, please do so to info@sunridge.co.za by Friday 15 February 2019. With an average of R300 per jacket and R190 per pants it is cheaper than a full tracksuit and covers both aspects.

Safety and Security

Our sincere condolences to High School Driehoek, this was a tragic incident but also something which again underlines our responsibility to safety. We carry out yearly inspections of our facilities and 2019 will be no exception. Traffic around the school is currently our biggest threat and once again we kindly request parents to be careful.

We have, however, received many positive comments. Though only positive we still strive to better our standard and confirm that we are not in competition with any Primary School in this regard.


