



Geagte Ouers

Ons herinner u net daaraan dat die towerwoordjies “goeiemôre”, “dis ‘n plesier”, “asseblief”, “ek is jammer”, “baie dankie” en vele meer tuis aangeleer moet word. Dis seker outyds, maar dit maak ‘n groot verskil.

Hiermee doen ons ‘n beroep op u om ons te help om dissipline by u kinders in te skerp. Dit klink dalk bietjie kwaai, maar dit is iets wat ons in die skool moet trotseer in die lig van aanmerkings oor hoe en wat ons onderrig. Hoe gee ons onderwys met leerlinge wat die klas ontwig en die gesag van onderwysers, studentonderwysers en fasiliteerders ondermyn?

Aan die ander kant sê ons ook dankie aan die meerderheid van ons leerlinge wat goed gemanierd, ondersteunend en ‘n plesier is om mee te werk. Vriendelike gesiggies en liefdevolle kinders maak ons lewe ook baie meer aangenaam terwyl ons die uitdagings trotseer.

Ek het hierdie week ‘n paar opmerkings van moeders gehoor: “Ek is lief vir kinders, maar ek sal nie een periode met hierdie klas uithou nie.” “Hoe bly onderwysers gesond?” En stof tot nadenke: “Nou weet ek hoekom God onderwysers geskape het en hoekom hulle lang vakansies nodig het.”

Kortom, dankie tog vir onderwysers – kom ons gee aan hulle die erkentlikheid wat hulle toekom.

Ons hartlike dank ook aan die Familieklub en alle betrokke ouers wat tot die reuse-sukses van die Sonskynfeeds verlede naweek bygedra het.

As a few mothers have said to me this week: “I love children but I will not last one period with this class?”, “How do the teachers stay healthy?” and maybe one to think about “now I know why God created teachers and why they need long holidays”

In short, thank you for teachers - let us give them the recognition gratitude they deserve.

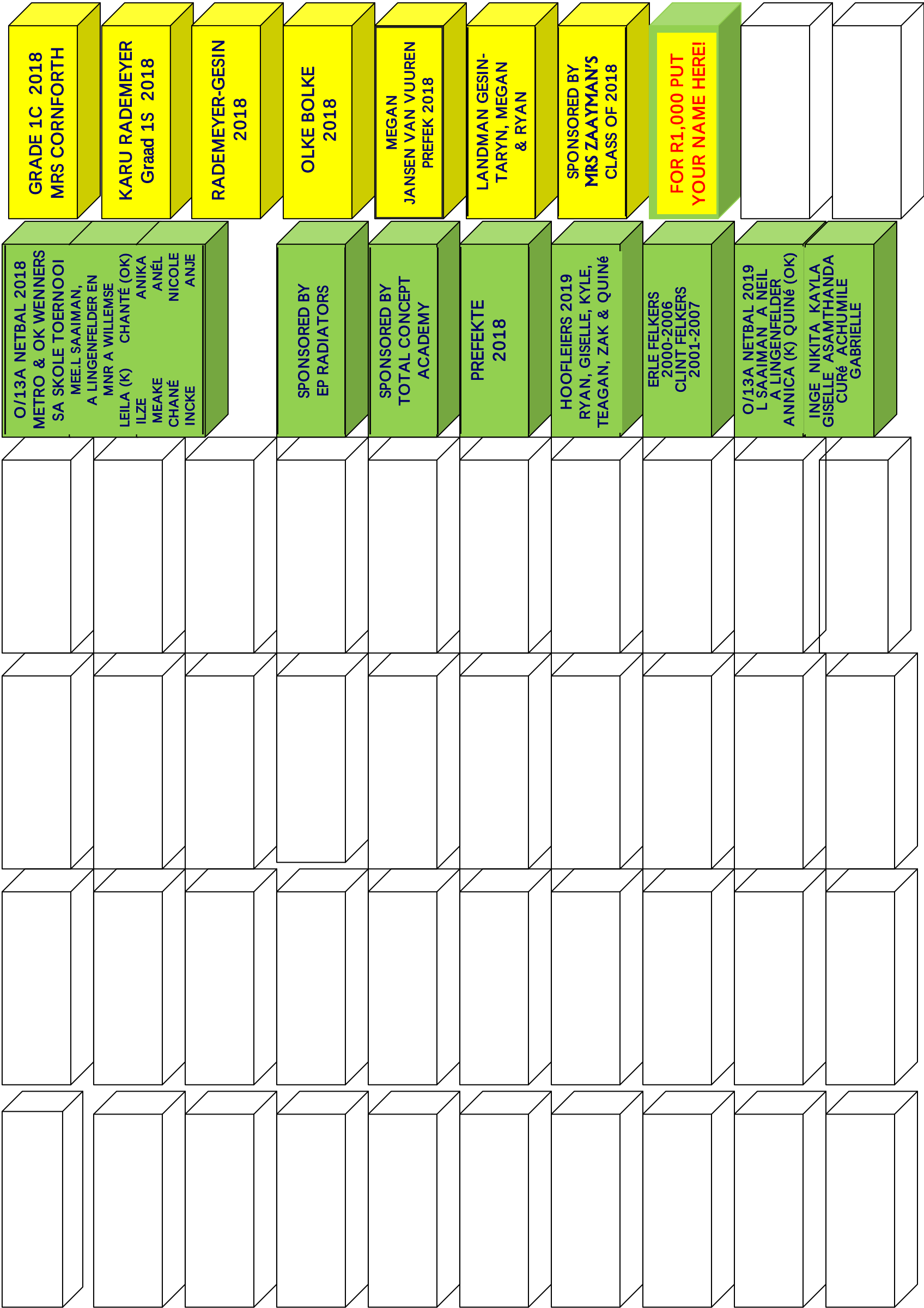
