### Test Series/Assessment

30 September 2020 - 9 October 2020

The weight value for the end of the year promotion for this test/assessment series is 40% - we cannot put more emphasis on the importance of this. We have done all we can to ensure we offer the opportunity and surely there will be sacrifices.

All question and answer papers will be decontaminated (4) four times during the process to ensure it reaches the children, parents and staff safely. The same is done for Grade 1 - 3 assessment documentation.

We clustered Grade 7 and 4 as well as Grade 6 and 5 to write on specific days. Grade 1 - 3 continue daily as their assessments take much longer.

Grade 1 will still go home at 12:45 and Grade 2 to 7 will go home at 13:00. Please support us with the pick-up as the staff need to get back into the school to start decontaminating and submitting papers for moderation while working within our policy to safe guard the process as well as also finishing in time.

Marked test papers will be sent home after moderation and decontamination. Parents can study them and follow up the process with any questions or issues. They must, however, be returned for our records. Please communicate accordingly with the teachers.

Learners with special arrangements, only those on the list, will use gate 4 to enter the grade 6 classes to write their tests or do assessments in the classes prepared for them. This will be during the same time slot as for all other learners.

Grades 6 and 7 will write on alternative days in the same venue - the same applies for Grades 4 and 5. During the series Grade 6 will use the Grade 7 drop off zones. Grade 6 English gate 11A and Grade 6 Afrikaans gate 16B. This is to accommodate the specific grades on specific days.

### Grade 1 2021

### Toetsreeks/Assessering

30 September 2020 tot 9 Oktober 2020

Die waarde van hierdie toets/assesseringsreeks vir die jaareindbevordering is 40%. Ons kan dit nie genoeg beklemtoon nie. Ons het alles in ons vermoë gedoen om die geleentheid te skep en daar sal beslis opofferings wees.

Alle vrae- en antwoordstelle word (4) vier keer gedurende die proses ontsmet om te verseker dat dit kinders, ouers en personeel veilig bereik. Dieselfde geld vir Gr 1- tot 3-assesseringsdokumentasie.

Ons het Gr 7 en 4, asook Gr 6 en 5 gegroep om op spesifieke dae te skryf. Gr 1 tot 3 gaan daagliks voort, want hul assessering duur veel langer.

Gr 1 verdaag steeds om 12:45, terwyl Gr 2 tot 7 om 13:00 verdaag. Help ons asseblief met die afhaal van leerlinge, want die personeel moet terug in die skool kom om te begin met ontsmetting, voorlegging van antwoordstelle vir moderering en om binne die perke van ons beleid veilig te werk terwyl die proses betyds afgehandel word.

Antwoordstelle sal huis toe gestuur word nadat dit gemerk, gemodereer en ontsmet is. Ouers kan dit bestudeer en die proses met betrekking tot vrae en probleme volg. Dit moet egter as bewys terugbesorg word. Hanteer dit asseblief d.m.v. kommunikasie met die onderwysers.

Ons leerlinge met spesiale reëlings, slegs diegene op die lys, gebruik Hek 4 om na die Gr 6-klasse te gaan waar hulle hul toetse of assesserings sal aflê in die klaskamers wat vir hulle voorberei is. Dit is gedurende dieselfde tydgleuf as vir alle ander leerlinge.

Gr 6 en 7 sal dieselfde lokaal op alternatiewe dae gebruik en dieselfde geld vir Gr 4 en 5. Gedurende die toetsweek sal Gr 6 die Gr 7-aflaaiplekke gebruik. Gr 6 Eng gebruik Hek 11A en Gr 6 Afr Hek 16B. Dit is om die spesifieke grade op spesifieke dae te akkommodeer.

### Gr 1 2021

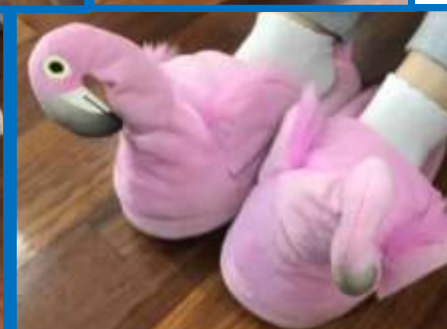
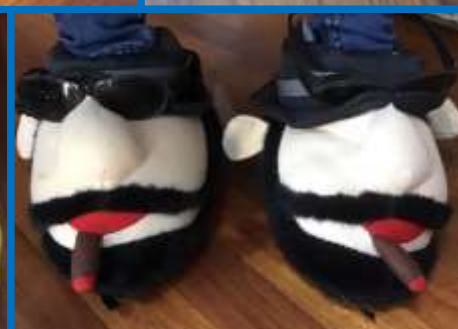
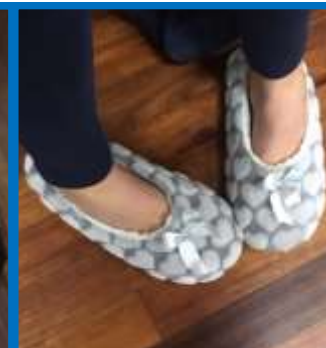
Please answer the following five questions:
