

Geagte Ouers

Ons kan die volgende i.v.m. die 'Omvattende Seksualiteitsonderrig (OSO) rapporteer':

"Die Departement het bevestig dat die kurrikulum nie verander nie en dat skole en opvoeders nie verplig kan word om die OSO-lesplanne of die Departementele handboek te gebruik nie. Die huidige stand van sake word dus gehandhaaf. Die skool besluit watter materiaal om te gebruik en die opvoeders bied die les volgens hul professionele bevoegdheid aan."

Ons ondersteun ouderdomsgerigte seksualiteitsonderrig wat binne ons waardestelsel val, soos in die verlede deur ons personeel onderrig en ons handhaaf dus die huidige stand van sake.

Die veiligheid van leerlinge word druk bespreek en dit is iets wat ons moet aanspreek. Sunridge het 'n uiters omvattende veiligheidsbeleid vir skoolaktiwiteite. Die beleid word toegepas om ons leerlinge te beskerm. Ons diensverskaffers word uiters sorgvuldig gekies en hulle moet aan ons risikobestuursbeleid voldoen.

Ons voldoen aan die Regulasies vir Veiligheidsmaatreëls by Openbare Skole (RVOS). In 99% van gevalle is dit ouers wat in stryd met die RVOS optree wat ons noodsaak om dit te monitor en toe te pas.

'n Ouer het onlangs verklaar dat sy op die skoolterrein mag wees, aangesien dit openbare gronde is. Haar verklaring is 'n direkte oortreding van die RVOS en ons kan haar en enige ouer wat die RVOS oortree, van die terrein verwyder. 'n Ouer mag die skool besoek, maar slegs binne die beleid soos vroeër aan ouers gekommunikeer. Om te sê jy het nie daarvan geweet nie, is geen verskoning nie en ons versoek ouers weer vriendelik om seker te maak dat hulle die nuusbriewe wat hiermee verband hou, lees.

Ingevolge Regulasie 8c(2) mag die skool nie kwytskeldingsvorme gebruik nie, MAAR 'n diensverskaffer mag ouers vra om die vorm te voltooi alvorens hulle die diens lewer. Ons sal slegs vir u toestemming vra en u in kennis stel dat ons alle redelike voorsorgmaatreëls tref om veiligheid te verseker. Indien u weier om toestemming te verleen of vir die skool wil voorskryf, sal u kind nie toegelaat word om aan die uitstap/ toer deel te neem nie en sal hy/sy skool moet bywoon waar die vereiste toesig in plek geplaas sal word.

Dissipline is een van die belangrikste aspekte en dit moet tuis gevestig word. Te veel leerlinge moet twee, drie of vier keer versoek word om iets te doen voordat hulle luister. Dit is 'n wesenlike uitdaging wat ons moet trotseer en u ondersteuning in hierdie verband is uiters belangrik.

Ons sal nooit sê dat ons nie kan foute maak en dit as 'n gegewe aanvaar nie. Foute moet erken en reggestel word en dan beweeg ons aan. Dit is ook op leerlinge en ouers van toepassing. Ons sal altyd daarna streef om in die beste belang van ons leerlinge en Sunridge Primêre Skool op te tree.

Samewerking is die enigste manier om 'n verskil te maak en die enigste pad vorentoe. Respek en Integriteit is die hoekstene wat daagliks by ons leerlinge ingeskerp moet word. Dit is nooit maklik om 'n ouer of onderwyser te wees nie, maar dit is ons keuse en ons roeping.

Dear Parents

We can report the following on the "Comprehensive Sexuality Education (CSE):

"The Department has confirmed that the curriculum does not change and that schools and educators cannot be compelled to use the CSE lesson plans or departmental textbook. The status quo can therefore be maintained. It remains the school's choice of materials used and educators' professional judgment on how lessons should be taught."

We support age-appropriate sexuality education within our value system as presented by our staff as in the past. We will therefore keep the status quo.

Learner Safety as a "hot topic" is something we need to clarify. Sunridge has a very comprehensive safety policy for school activities. We follow this to protect our learners. We choose our service providers very carefully and they have to comply with our risk management policy.

We adhere to the Regulations for Safety Measures at Public Schools (RSM). In 99% of the time it is parents who act against the RSM while it is left to us to police and apply it.

Recently a parent made the statement that she can be on the school premises as its public ground. Her statement is in direct violation of the RSM and we could have removed her or any parent in violation of the RSM. A parent may visit the school but within the policy as communicated previously. To say you did not know is not an excuse and we, again, kindly request parents to ensure you read the newsletters dealing with these issues.

By regulation 8c(2) the school is not allowed to use indemnity forms BUT a service provider might ask parents to complete one before they render the service. The only thing we will ask is for your consent and to note that we will take all reasonable precautions to ensure safety. Should you refuse to give consent or prescribe your consent your child will not be allowed to go on the excursion/tour and must attend school while we will provide suitable supervision as required.

One of the most important aspects is discipline and that needs to be instilled at home. Too many learners need to be told a second, third and fourth time before they listen. This is the real threat we face and your support by correcting it is important.

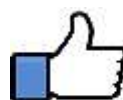

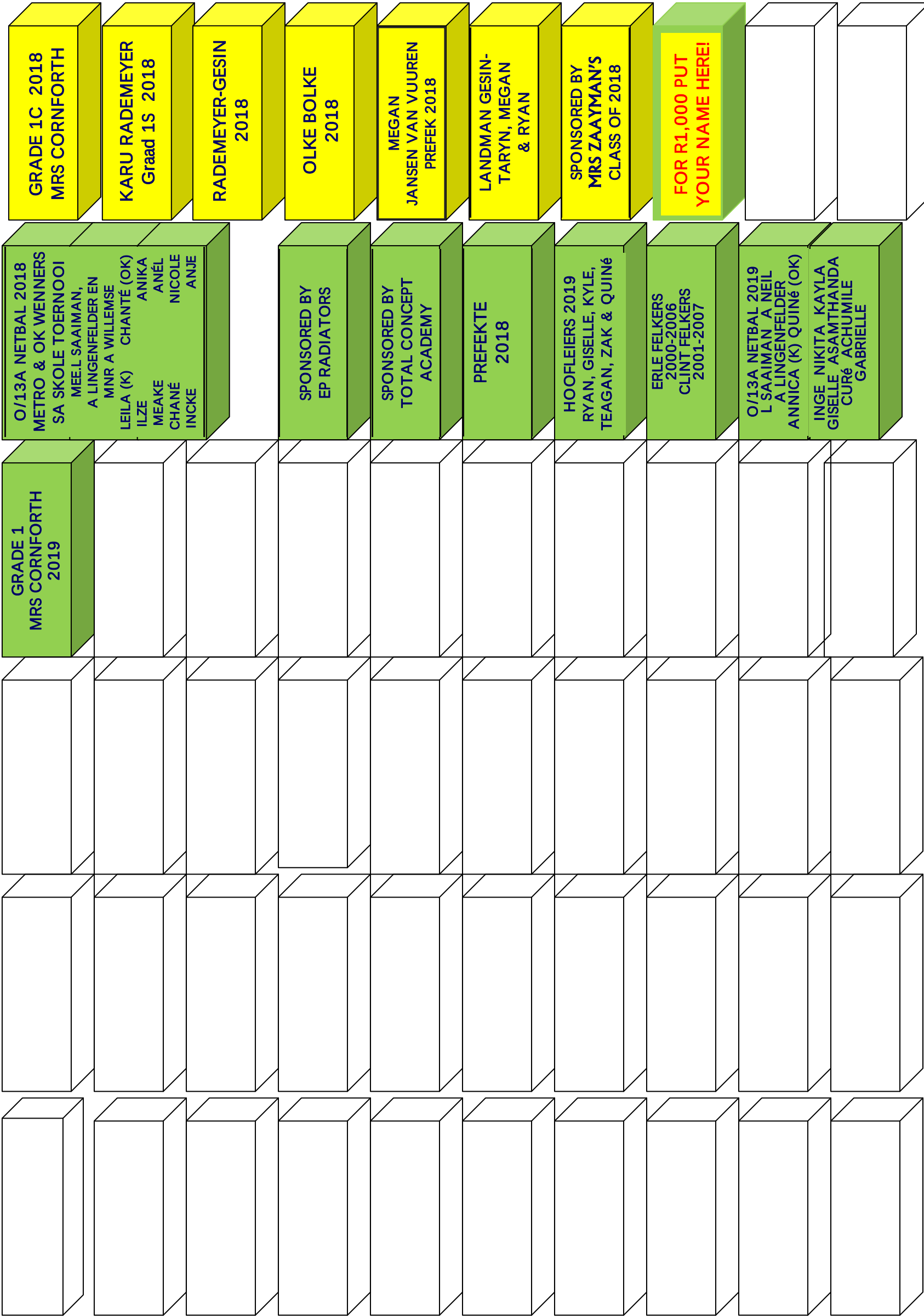
