



Dear Parents

Moving forward we can report that 10 of our athletes are going through to the EC Athletics Championships in Cradock. Thank you to all staff for attending events and supporting our learners during the week and over weekends.

Our staff avail their private time during weekends and holidays to support our learners, something we have become accustomed to and that we sometimes take for granted. From management and the SGB we thank them from the bottom of our hearts for walking the extra mile for our learners.

The following tours are coming up: girls and boys hockey, rugby and netball. Our cultural department is also planning a tour for the steel band. These are during the school holidays and long weekends in April. We truly appreciate the commitment of our staff in this regard.

Cell Phones

The policy is very simple, no cell phones are allowed. We, however, comply with an exception policy and these rules apply at all times. In the Code of Conduct point 1 we made provision for the exception to the rule that it must be switched off at all times. In 2018 too many learners were getting into trouble and the policy was amended. For any child to bring a cell phone to school the parent must write a letter to request permission to have a cell phone at school. The school will issue a permission card after all relevant documentation and agreements are signed by the parent. A parent cannot give a child permission to use a cell phone during school hours or to bring one to school without permission.

Without this card the child is not allowed to have a cell phone at school. Thank you to parents who support us and comply with the policy. We issue numbered cell phone permission cards and these numbers correlate with the name list and cell phone number. The cards cannot be transferred and if lost a new one can be issued at R50 per card. The permission number will however change and the old number will be discarded as invalid. These cards must be returned at the end of the **year and the application process will start again. Parents need to inform the school if a child's cell phone number changes** so that we can register it to the permission number.

Extra Mural Activities

Our policy is clear and has been part of our application for enrolment since 2014. All Sunridge learners must participate in at least one school extra mural activity in summer and in winter. We are currently following up on this requirement and have found a few learners are failing to comply. Please ensure that your child takes part and complies with this compulsory requirement. Please note that this is for extra mural activities provided by the school only and not for private extra mural activities.

Homework

We provide the backup for parents on the InTouch Portal to ensure you can support us by ensuring that homework is done **as required. A few learners, however, only rely on this "backup" and they neglect to write homework down in the homework books provided.** They neglect to listen to instructions and information as they know the homework will be available on the InTouch Portal. This is not supportive to the skill they need to learn and the responsibility they must develop. Our learners then struggle to adapt in high school. It is the primary responsibility of a child to write down homework and to follow instructions. Please support us and your child by checking that it is done.

Dangerous Games

More and more dangerous games are reaching our children through social media. They get exposed to games with serious health risks to children. We cannot take responsibility for this and kindly ask parents to monitor and inform your children in this regard. These games include verbal bullying and supporting wrong doing to other children. Children also play a game **where they purposely exclude some children because of They become vocal about it and emotions then tend to run high.**

Please support us by encouraging and teaching them to show respect, to be sensitive and watch what they say to and about others.

Geagte Ouers

Ons maak graag bekend dat 10 van ons atlete aan die OK-Atletiekkampioenskappe op Cradock gaan deelneem. Baie dankie aan al die personeel wat die byeenkomste bywoon en ons leerlinge gedurende die week en oor naweke ondersteun.

Ons personeel bestee hul vrye tyd oor naweke en gedurende vakansies daarvan om ons leerlinge te ondersteun, maar ons het so gewoond geraak daarvan dat ons dit as vanselfsprekend aanvaar. Van bestuurs- en SBL-kant wil ons u hartlik bedank dat u die ekstra myl met ons leerlinge stap.

Behalwe die komende hokkie-, rugby- **en netbaltoere stel die kultuurdepartement ook 'n toer vir die staaltromorkes in die vooruitsig.** Dit vind gedurende die skoolvakansie en langnaweke in April plaas. Ons stel die toewyding van ons personeel in hierdie verband werklik op prys.

Selfone

Die beleid is eenvoudig – **geen selfone word toegelaat nie.** **Ons voldoen egter aan 'n uitsonderingsbeleid en hierdie reëls** is te alle tye van toepassing. In die Gedragskode punt 1 maak ons vir uitsonderings op die reël voorsiening mits die foon te alle tye afgeskakel is. In 2018 het te veel kinders die reëls oortree en die beleid is gewysig sodat die ouers van enige kind wat 'n selfoon wil saambring skool toe, 'n brief moes skryf om toestemming te vra en die skool reik dan 'n toestemming-skaartjie uit nadat alle betrokke ooreenkoms en dokumentasie deur die ouers onderteken is. 'n Ouer mag nie 'n kind toestemming gee om 'n selfoon gedurende skoolure te gebruik of om een saam te bring skool toe sonder verlof nie.

Sonder hierdie kaartjie mag die kind nie enige selfoon by die skool hê nie. Baie dankie aan die ouers wat die beleid volg en ons ondersteun. Ons het genommerde selfoonkaarte uitgereik en hierdie nommers stem ooreen met die naamly en selfoon-nommer. **Die kaarte is onoordraagbaar en indien dit verlore raak, kan 'n nuwe een teen R50 per kaartjie uitgereik word.** Die toestemmingsnommer verander egter en die ou nommer word as ongeldig onttrek. Hierdie kaarte moet aan die einde van **die jaar terugbesorg word en die aansoekproses begin van voor af.** **Ouers moet die skool asseblief in kennis stel indien 'n** kind se selfoonnnummer verander, sodat ons die nommer in ons register kan wysig.

Buitemuurse aktiwiteite

Ons beleid is duidelik en sedert 2014 deel van ons aansoekvorms. Alle Sunridge-leerlinge moet aan minstens een somer- en **een winteraktiwiteit deelneem.** **Ons monitor tans hierdie aspek en daar is 'n paar leerlinge wat nie aan die vereistes voldoen** nie. Maak asseblief seker dat u kind deelneem en aan hierdie vereiste voldoen. Neem asseblief kennis dat dit slegs vir skoolaktiwiteite geld en nie vir private buitemuurse aktiwiteite nie.

Huiswerk

Ons laai die huiswerk op die Portaal as rugsteun, sodat ouers kan seker maak dat huiswerk soos nodig gedoen word. 'n Paar leerlinge maak egter slegs staat op hierdie "rugsteun" en laat na om hul huiswerk in die huiswerkboekies te skryf soos van hulle verwag word. Hulle luister nie na opdragte nie, want hulle weet die huiswerk is op die Portaal beskikbaar. Dit is geen hulp vir die vaardighede wat hulle moet ontwikkel en verantwoordelikheid wat hulle moet aanleer nie. Ons leerlinge pas dan **moeilik aan by hoëskool.** **Dit is die primêre verantwoordelikheid van 'n kind om huiswerk af te skryf en opdragte uit te voer.** Ondersteun ons en u kind asseblief deur te verseker dat dit gedoen word.

Gevaarlike speletjies

Al hoe meer gevaarlike speletjies bereik ons kinders deur middel van sosiale media. Hulle word blootgestel aan speletjies wat ernstige gesondheidsgevare vir ons kinders inhou. Ons kan nie hiervoor verantwoordelikheid aanvaar nie en versoek ouers ernstig om met u kind hieroor te praat en dit te monitor. Hierdie speletjies sluit verbale afknouing in en ook die ondersteuning van kinders wat ander kinders afknou. **Kinders speel ook 'n speletjie waar hulle ander kinders doelbewus uitsluit omdat Hulle raak uitgesproke daaroor en emosies ruk handuit.**

Help ons asseblief deur hulle te leer om respek te toon, om sensitief te wees en te let op wat hulle oor en aan ander mense sê.
