School Closure from Wednesday, 18 March 2020 until after the Easter Weekend

We respect and support the matters as put forward by our President. Irrespective of all personal views we will comply and we believe that it is important to work together in these very difficult times. We understand that this will cause tremendous stress on parents to juggle work and children at home.

With our contingency plan in place we had to wait for official information to be able to address parents correctly. This is the time to work together and to support one another.

The school will be closed from Wednesday, 18 March 2020 as announced. Therefore, tomorrow, Tuesday, 17 March 2020 will be the last day for this term. The school will close at 13:00 for all learners to support parents from Grade 1 - 7 with transport. Transport problems - children can wait in the waiting area till 14:30.

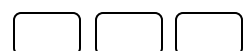
For tomorrow 17 March 2020 we will only allow children on the premises, hand sanitizer will be available at the gates for all children entering the premises. Please keep your child at home if any signs of illness are detected. Please encourage handwashing on a regular basis. The elbow greet is now the only one allowed and we need to practice these measures at all times.

No extra mural activities will be allowed at school and we are cancelling and postponing all activities as needed. The tours to Knysna, Paarl, Bloemfontein and Wildeklaar have been postponed or cancelled. Mr and Miss Sunshine and any activity at Sunridge Primary School have been postponed. All dates, as in the homework diary, from 17 March 2020 to 1 May 2020 are compromised and changes will be communicated as we complete planning.

Academic

With our contingency plan we anticipated the measures from the President. Our staff worked extra hours last week and over the weekend to ensure we can hand out all reports on Tuesday, 17 March 2020. Should your child not be at school, you may fetch their report at the **front office** from 13:15 - 14:30. Hand sanitizer will be available at the front door and will be compulsory for entering our building.

We have also worked very hard to ensure we can hand out additional work which can be done at home in support of our academic progress. This should not cause pressure and must be seen as support. This will be constructive work in support of academic skills. The teachers will also start with preparation for the worst case academic scenario



- please consult your e-mail regularly as work and exercises will also be made available. As you will see, we will work from home and will also plan on how we will catch up and ensure our learners are properly prepared. Teachers are also parents and we respect the fact that they will also be under pressure.

Although this work is not compulsory it will benefit your child and will ensure less pressure when the term starts. Please support us - get your child to read and have fun while testing comprehension, asking questions and playing games in support of academic skills.

Moving forward

The second term will start on 14 April 2020 and we will also start our extramural activities on the first day. We are, however, postponing all activities for Saturday 18 April 2020 and even more might follow.

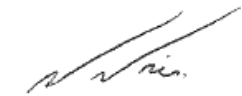

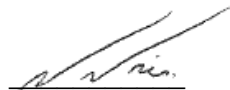
