Just after five staff open up our school and get everything ready to receive our children. This is not only support staff but also includes secretaries and teaching staff so that everything is ready by 07:00 to welcome learners from 07:15. School only starts at 08:00 but the "care" we give starts way earlier. With the last children leaving our premises at 14:00 the very same team starts to clean, sanitize and disinfect the school while teaching staff start with preparation, marking and planning to be ready for the next day.

We are so used to this routine that we forget that it is not normal - it is beyond what is required and expected. A Sunridge family recently brought it to my attention again that they see staff working 9 to 13 hours daily. This commitment, compassion and attitude sets us apart from many.

I believe we need to be grateful that Sunridge staff put in many more hours than they need to because they care. We chase them out of school at 14:00 because we need to clean but they still need to work and that I can see as they log into our Staffroom management system and Portal from home.
