Ons kan dit nie goedkeur of daarmee saamstem nie, want daar is slegs 31 skooldae oor voor die eindeksamen vir Gr 4 – 7 wat op 11 November 2021 begin, en slegs 34 dae vir Gr 1 tot 3 voor die finale assessering wat op 15 November 2021 volstroom afskop.

Thank you so much to parents who phoned in today, complying with our request. This assisted us in keeping the gates open and to put measures in place to support parents and staff facing traffic problems.

Attending School

We are encountering more and more parents requesting, for various reasons, to fetch their child early. Please note that it is inappropriate and we will refuse if it is not for a medical reason/emergency of which we will require proof thereof. You drop your child off at school to attend the full day - we do not offer "part of" a school day as a service.

We cannot close the school as we see fit and send learners home as we please and we must follow procedure and legislation. It is your choice to send your child to school or not BUT you can unfortunately not choose the duration thereof.

We are bombarded with parents wanting to steal a day or two during next week and the week before the school closes. We cannot approve nor agree to it as there are only 31 school days left before the final exams for Grade 4 - 7 start on 11 November 2021 and 34 days for Grade 1 - 3 before their final assessments on 15 November 2021. We are working at full steam.

We need to work hard to complete the fourth term's work. The pressure is on as we must submit our results by 6 December 2021 to the DOE and then produce schedules, plan for 2022 and finalise everything before handing out reports to parents on 15 December 2021.

Last day of term 3

From August we lengthened our Fridays so as to catch up time lost on staggering home times. The last school day was also lengthened and we could not close at 11:00 as prescribed.

To support parents school will close on 1 October 2021 at the following times: 10:00 for Grade 1 – 3; 10:30 for Grade 4 and 6 and 11:00 for Grade 5 and 7. This is to relieve the traffic congestion and to be able to maintain social distancing. Reports will be handed to learners in class just before they leave. This might not be to the liking of all but it is the only way we can assist you.
