KOM ONS OMRING ONSSELF MET GOEIE NUUS EN LOOP 'N WYE DRAAI OM DIE NEGATIEWE

Ons moes vandesweek 'n klas huis toe stuur om te monitor, want daar was een Covid-19 positiewe kontak in die klas. Ons ondervind dat kinders en personeel normale griepsimptome toon en slegs wanneer hulle getoets word, vind ons uit dat hulle positief is. Die personeel is onder beheer, maar ons rig 'n vriendelike versoek aan ouers om kinders met simptome asseblief huis te hou of 'n mediese opinie in te win. Ons weet dit is 'n opdraande stryd en dat daar verskillende menings is en ook koste aan verbone is. Kom ons probeer asseblief en doen dit vir die veiligheid van alle betrokkenes!

Ons verloor steeds familielede en bejaarde mense verkeer voortdurend in gevaar. Ons innige meegevoel aan Sunridge-families wat geliefdes aan die dood afgestaan het.

Hoewel ons besef dat sommige mense vir ons lag omdat ons die reëls eerbiedig, het ons geen beheer oor wat buite ons skoolterrein gebeur nie. Wanneer ouers dus sonder maskers buite ons terrein staan, die eenrigting rondom die skool ignoreer of in aflaai/oplaaiareas parkeer, kan ons ons slegs op hulle respek en integriteit beroep.

Hoewel ons steeds die reëls wil eerbiedig deur ons kinders te vra om buite die skool hul sosiale afstand te handhaaf en personeel steeds **saam met hulle uitstap, word dit deur sommige mense in 'n negatiewe lig gesien.**

Met die terugkeer van buitemuurse bedrywighede moet ons steeds die reël van aparte terrein en aparte hek soos deur elke sportkode voorgeskryf, volg. U kind moet ná skool die skoolterrein verlaat en weer by die sporthek binnekomm, want hul temperatuur moet weer gemeet word en hul name moet deur die betrokke personeellede afgemerk word. Ons staan gereed vir die nuwe vlaag van negatiewe kommentaar en klagtes waarmee ons gebombardeer gaan word, maar ons eerbiedig die reëls totdat die waarskuwingsvlak of spesifieke kodereëls gewysig word. Dit is so wonderlik dat ons weer met sport kan begin en al hoe nader aan normaal kan beweeg.

Ons het kennis geneem van die moontlike kansellering van die Oktobervakansie en na ons beskeie mening sal dit ons kinders en personeel in gevaar stel. Ons het skouer aan die wiel gesit en is 100% op koers, terwyl ons in sommige gevalle selfs verder voor is. Ons akademiese verslag toon duidelik dat die sogenoemde "gapings" vergeleke by vorige jare goed onder beheer is.

Ons bied hulp aan leerlinge wat dit nodig het en die kleiner klasse met 1 m sosiale afstand sal die norm wees ter ondersteuning van ons akademiese program in hierdie omstandighede.

Met ons dissipline skort daar niks en die meerderheid van ons leerlinge **en ouers openbaar 'n buitengewoon positiewe ingesteldheid.** Baie dankie vir u ondersteuning aan personeel in hierdie uitsonderlike tyd.

SPEND MORE TIME AROUND GOOD NEWS AND LESS TIME WITH THE NEGATIVE

We have had to send one class home to monitor due to a Covid-19 positive contact in the class. The risk we run is that children and staff have normal flu like symptoms and only when they test we find out that they are positive. The staff are under control but we humbly request parents to keep children at home or get medical attention should they **have any symptoms. We know it's a huge battle and that there are different opinions and costs.** Please let us try to keep the safety of all in mind!

We are still losing family members and elderly people are still at risk. Our deepest condolences to Sunridge families who have lost loved ones.

We know that some people find it amusing that we stick to the regulations at school. We, however, cannot control what happens outside our fence. When parents stand outside our premises without masks, ignore the one way around the school or park in the drop off/pick up zones, we can only call on them to show respect and integrity.

Even though we want to keep to the regulations by asking our children to social distance outside our premises and staff to still walk them out, we find this is received in a negative light by some people.

With extra mural activities returning we are still required to follow the separate venue and gate as prescribed by each sport code. We must release your child after school and require them to enter at the gate of the specific venue as they need to be scanned and marked off by the staff members responsible for the new venue. We know that negative comments and complaints will again be made but we will stick to the rules and regulations until they change the alert level or specific sport code rules. The good news is that we can at least start introducing **sport again and we cannot wait for the return as close to the 'old' normal as possible.**

We are fully aware of the planned scrapping of the October holidays and it is our humble opinion that it will put our children and staff at risk. We have been working hard and have caught up to such an extent that we are 100% on track and even ahead in a few areas. Our academic report clearly shows that the so called "gaps" are well under control in comparison to previous years.

We offer support to learners in need and the smaller classes with 1 meter social distancing will be the norm in support of our academic program under these circumstances.

Discipline is good and we need to mention the exceptionally positive behaviour of the majority of our learners and parents. Thank you so much for supporting and working with staff during these extraordinary times.

Please stay safe and let us live our values as a Sunridge Family.

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


