



Dear Parents

The children are in the clouds being back on the sport fields and are co-operating with us to make sure we can keep this service running as planned. Their hunger for activities is visible and we will be hosting our inter-house athletics next Friday and Saturday. This is not a long weekend - Monday, 1 November is a public holiday for voting. So our staff, man and mouse, will be on the sport fields providing opportunities for the children.

Spectators are, unfortunately, not allowed and we will run the athletics meeting as earlier in the year.

Saturday will be the first time in nearly two years that we will travel, in the school buses, to Grahamstown for cricket matches. We wish the teams well and a safe journey.

With the exams/assessments coming up we kindly request proper planning as it is important for all our children to be well prepared, have sufficient time to study and be allowed to do their best.

After the exams we will be under pressure to moderate, control, prepare, print and ensure the handover of reports to parents. The final processing of reports will be completed on 14 December so as to be ready to hand them out on 15 December. We will also be under pressure to prepare the school buildings, facilities and all academic work for 2022. After exams the staff will start preparing their register classes for 2022 and will, at the same time, run an internal academic programme.

The majority of parents have thanked us for the measures put in place to ease the drop off and pick up around the school. With sport starting it also helps BUT it has been brought to our attention that some parents behave badly when using the road around the school. We investigated and with all due respect we must agree with them. We saw on the cameras how a gentleman, in front of the school, behaved so disrespectfully that we had to agree with the police that intervention is needed. Acting outside the law and using foul language cannot be tolerated. We do not have any jurisdiction outside our premises but we cannot sweep it under the carpet.

School Clothing

It was at the request of the majority of parents that we extended our date for the return of full school uniform. This was supported and we even went as far as sourcing school clothing to be sold on site. We have done what we can and we now remind parents on the agreed upon date for the compulsory wearing of school clothing.

Parents have started to order and buy clothing and some learners are wearing them to school on a regular basis. This is proactive and responsible. We need to kindly ask that parents not be caught out with the availability of school clothing for 2022. You need to act now as from 19 January 2022 learners will not be allowed to attend school if they are not wearing the correct uniform.

You are kindly advised to purchase clothing in timeously. Should you order from the school we will deliver in time and be accountable - please note that we cannot be held accountable for outside suppliers. Please buy all essential school clothing asap.

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Geagte Ouers

Die kinders is in die wolke om terug op die sportvelde te wees en hulle gee hul samewerking om te verseker dat ons die diens soos beplan kan aanbied. Dit is duidelik dat hulle uitgehonger is vir oefening en hulle sal genoeg daarvan kry tydens ons interhuis-atletiekbyeenkoms aanstaande week Vrydag en Saterdag. Dit is nie 'n langnaweek nie, want hoewel Maandag 1 November 'n openbare vakansiedag is, is dit stemdag. Ons personeel sal dus man en muis op die sportvelde wees om u kinders te dien en geleentheid te skep.

Toeskouers word ongelukkig nie toegelaat nie en die byeenkoms word soos vroeër vanjaar gereël.

Met die krieketwedstryde in Grahamstad oor die naweek, is dit die eerste keer in byna twee jaar dat ons met ons busse op reis gaan. Ons spanne word 'n veilige en aangename reis toegewens.

Met die naderende eksamen/assesserings rig ons 'n vriendelike versoek aan ouers om sorgvuldig te beplan, want dit is uiters belangrik vir al ons kinders om goed voorbereid te wees, genoegsame studietyd te hê en toegelaat te word om hul bes te doen.

Ná die eksamen gaan ons druk besig wees met die moderering, beheer, voorbereiding, druk en oorhandiging van rapporte aan ouers. Ons sal eers op 14 Desember die finale prosesse afhandel om die rapporte gereed te kry vir oorhandiging op 15 Desember, terwyl ons terselfdertyd onder druk sal verkeer om die skoolgeboue en geriewe saam met al die akademiese werk vir 2022 gereed te kry. Personeel sal dus ná die eksamen begin om hul registerklasse vir 2022 voor te berei, terwyl 'n interne akademiese program aangebied word.

Die meerderheid ouers is dankbaar vir die maatreëls wat ons in plek geplaas het vir die op- en aflaai van kinders rondom die skool. Dit is ook 'n groot hulp met die hervat van sportoefeninge, MAAR dit het ons aandag gekom dat sommige ouers hulle aan wangedrag skuldig maak wanneer hulle die straat rondom die skool gebruik. Ons het ondersoek ingestel en met alle respek moet ons met hulle saamstem. Ons het op kamera gesien hoe 'n pappa van die skool voor die hoofingang so ongemanierd opgetree het, dat ons met die Polisie moet saamstem dat ingryping nodig is. Om buite die wet op te tree en vuil taal te gebruik, kan nie toegelaat word nie. Ons het geen jurisdiksie buite ons skoolterrein nie, maar ons kan dit nie onder die mat invee nie.

Skoolklere

Op versoek van ouers het ons die datum vir die terugkeer na volle skooluniform uitgestel. Ons het dit ter ondersteuning van ouers gedoen en het selfs skoolklere bekom wat in ons skoolwinkel verkoop word. Ons het ons bes gedoen en ouers word nou herinner aan die datum waarop ons ooreengekom het om weer te begin skooluniform dra.

Ouers het reeds klere begin bestel en koop, terwyl sommige leerlinge reeds op gereelde grondslag skoolklere dra. Dit is proaktief en verantwoordelik en ons wil vriendelik versoek dat ouers werk daarvan maak om skoolklere vir 2022 aan te skaf, terwyl daar nog voorraad is, want leerlinge sal slegs op 19 Januarie 2022 by die skool toegelaat word indien hulle die korrekte uniform dra.

U word vriendelik aangeraai om betyds skoolklere te bekom. Indien u by die skool bestel, sal ons betyds aflewer en aanspreeklik gehou kan word – let asseblief daarop dat ons nie aanspreeklik gehou kan word wanneer buiteverskaffers gebruik word nie. Koop u noodsaaklike skoolklere onverwyld.
