Dear Parents

Thank you to all staff, learners and parents for working as a team to overcome challenges and for being positive and making a difference in the future of our learners.

Although we were criticized about our choice not to do extra mural activities in the third term our prediction proved to be spot on. We have received the weighting of the final marks; Grade 4 - 7 is now 80% of the year mark and 20% for the final exam. It was previously 60% for the year mark and 40% for the final exam. Those who have worked diligently throughout the year and test series will reap the benefits.

These weighting changes will put a different sort of pressure on the exams and shift the challenges. With this in mind we are carefully planning our extra mural activities and the time table will run from the first day of the fourth term. We will keep to the regulations and stay within the protocols as prescribed. As the pool is still too cold we will focus on cricket, athletics and tennis. We will end the term's extra mural activities a week before exams start. An athletics meeting for all age groups will again be held at Sunridge and will be done over two days.

During break times we are slowly moving to the 'new' normal and will allow our learners to play - no touching and keeping social distance. Our learner's ability to respect the changes will be tested. The 'new' normal is to use break time to eat calmly and enjoy chatting and socialising while keeping the huge physical urge for extra mural activities. All ball games are prohibited. Playing away from learners who choose to stand or sit while eating and chatting in peace is part of the new normal. We will demarcate areas for active playing and running and the areas where those who choose to sit quietly must be respected.

We say good bye to Mrs Groom who will leave us at the end of the term to join her husband overseas. With the return to normal planning for 2022 we will do an internal staff allocation for the fourth term.

Our investigation into children's social media interactions and behaviour is an ongoing process. We can confirm that we have enough information from a recent disciplinary matter to show that the learner who misbehaved/ reacted badly had been provoked by three learners over a period of time.

The guilty learner immediately faced sanctions and appropriate remedial actions were applied. We can now also apply sanctions against the other three learners involved. It is a pity that it took a long time to get the information from class mates BUT we now know what we are dealing with and what to look for. In the future we will apply the same sanctions against learners who provoke others. Please note that "PROVOKING" will now be written into our disciplinary system and can lead to suspension.

If possible, please enjoy the holidays. and if not, try and catch your breath as the fourth term will start at a hectic pace. The prefects and head leaders will be announced before the end of the fourth term. Our prefect system is an open system and learners can work throughout 2022 to be added as a prefect. Internal prize giving's will be held and we will deal with changes as we move forward.

Sport and academic tours for 2022 have also been introduced back into the year planner and we recommend that parents plan carefully as 2022 seems to be a very busy and full year.

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Geagte ouers

Baie dankie aan alle personeel, leerlinge en ouers wat as 'n span saamgewerk het om struikelblokke te oorwin, positief te wees en 'n verskil aan die toekoms van ons leerlinge te maak.

Hoewel ons deurgeloop het omdat ons verkies het om ons buitemuurse aktiwiteite vir die derde kwartaal ter syde te stel, was ons in die kol. Ons het die gewig vir die finale punte ontvang en vir Gr 4 tot 7 tel die jaarpunt 80% en die eindeksamen 20%, terwyl dit in die verlede 60% vir die jaarpunt en 40% vir die eindeksamen was. Diegene wat gedurende die jaar en tydens die toetsreeks skouer aan die wiel gesit het, se harde werk het dus vrugte afgewerp.

Die gewigsverandering plaas druk van 'n ander aard op die eksamen en daar sal 'n aantal uitdagings voortspruit. Hiermee in gedagte word die buitemuurse aktiwiteite en rooster, wat vanaf dag een volgende kwartaal van krag is, sorgvuldig beplan. Ons sal binne die voorgeskrewe regulasies en protokol bly. Aangesien die swembad nog te koud is, sal die fokus op krieket, atletiek en tennis wees. Die buitemuurse aktiwiteite sal 'n week voor die eksamen ten einde loop. 'n Atletiekbyeenkoms vir alle ouderdomsgroepe sal weer oor twee dae by Sunridge plaasvind.

Tydens pouse beweeg ons stadig maar seker na die nuwe normaal – leerlinge mag met inagneming van die sosiale afstand speel, maar geen aanraking word toegelaat nie. Leerlinge se vermoë om die veranderinge te respekteer, sal op die proef gestel word, want binne die nuwe normaal moet pouse gebruik word om rustig te eet, te gesels en te kuier terwyl die kragte gespaar word vir die buitemuurse bedrywighede. Balsepele is verbode en volgens die nuwe normaal moet leerlinge wegbly van maats wat verkies om te staan of te sit en in vrede te gesels. Ons sal gebiede vir aktiewe speel en hardloop afbaken, terwyl die areas waar kinders rustig verkeer, gerespekteer word.

Ons groet mev. Groom, wat aan die einde van die kwartaal by haar eggenoot oorsee aansluit. Met die terugkeer na normale beplanning vir 2022 sal ons interne personeel vir die vierde kwartaal aanwend.

Ons ondersoek na kinders se sosiale media-gebruik en gedrag is steeds op dreef. Ons kan egter bevestig dat 'n onlangse dissiplinêre aangeleentheid toegeskryf kan word aan drie leerlinge wat een ander leerling oor 'n tydperk getreiter het, wat tot gevolg gehad het dat die betrokke leerling hom aan wangedrag skuldig gemaak het.

Die skuldige leerling is onmiddellik aan sanksies onderwerp en toepaslike remediërende maatreëls is toegepas. Nou kan ons ook sanksies teen die drie leerlinge wat aan treitering skuldig is, toepas. Ongelukkig het dit lank gevat om die inligting by klasmaats te bekom, MAAR ons weet nou waarmee ons te doen het en waarvoor om op die uitkyk te wees. In die toekoms sal dieselfde sanksies teen die treiteraars toegepas word. Let asseblief daarop dat "TREITERING" nou by ons dissiplinêre stelsel gevoeg sal word en dat dit tot skorsing kan lei.

Geniet asseblief die vakansie indien moontlik, en indien nie, skep 'n bietjie asem voor die vierde kwartaal op volle vaart afskop. Ons prefekte en hoofleiers word voor die einde van die vierde kwartaal aangekondig. Dit is wel so dat ons prefekstelsel oop is en dat leerlinge deur die loop van 2022 kan werk om as prefek bygevoeg te word. Interne prysuitdelings sal plaasvind en ons sal veranderinge hanteer soos dit oor ons pad kom.

Sport- en akademiese toere is reeds vir 2022 by die jaarbeplanner gevoeg en ons wil aanbeveel dat ouers hul beplanning doen, want 2022 gaan 'n bedrywige en vol jaar wees.
